Day 1 Travel from Bangkok - Amnat Charoen Province – Phra Mongkhon Ming Muang Temple - Chitraphu Island

05:30 A.M. Depart from Bangkok to Amnat Charoen Province The travel time is approximately 8 hours.

At noon Have lunch at a restaurant.

In the afternoon Arrive at **Amnat Charoen Province**, take you on a journey to **Phra Mongkhon Ming Muang temple**. It is located at Dan Phrabat Hill, it is about 3 kilometers north of the city. The temple area is a natural shale rock with various plants. It has been adapted to be "Phuttha Park" as for Phra Mongkhon Ming Muang. Located at Dan Phrabat Hill Along Highway No. 212 (Amnat



Charoen-Yasothon), Bung Subdistrict, about 3 kilometers from the city. The temple area is a natural shady stone with many kinds of plants. Which has been modified to be "Buddha Park", while Phra Mongkhon Ming Muang or Big Buddha is a Buddha image in the subduing Mara posture with a lap width of 11 meters and a height from the ground level to the top of the flame 20 meters in radius. North India's Pala that spread to the northeast of Thailand more than 1,000 years ago and in the year 1965, Jit Buabut designed and built reinforced concrete to cover the original stucco Buddha image. Which is a stucco Buddha image with a base width of 8.4 meters, length of 12.6 meters, height of 5.2 meters, and decorate outside with gold mosaics. It is the royal amulet of the people of Amnat Charoen and Ubon Ratchathani provinces. Phra Mongkhon Ming Muang It is a Buddha image with beautiful characteristics of the northeastern region. Behind Phra Mongkhon Ming Muang, there are 2 more strange Buddha images wrapped in yellow robes, named "Phra Lahai" or what the locals call "Phra Kha Lai", meaning not beautiful or not beautiful. According to the appearance of the ancient Buddha image. Found in the swamp in 1962, when the surrounding area was renovated to

make a dam. It is believed to be a god that gives good luck. People always come to ask for blessings.

3:00 P.M. Take you to Check In and stay at Nakarin Hotel, invite you to store your luggage and go to your room to relax.

In the afternoon Then take you to **Chitralak Island**. It is a small island located in Bung Subdistrict, Mueang District, Amnat Charoen Province, in the middle of the Buddha Park Reservoir or Huai Pla Daek basin. It has now been developed as a tourist attraction, point including being a new landmark of the province. It also adjusts the area to be a heart shape when viewed from the top corner. From the shore, we can walk through a floating bridge to visit the island, three Temples of Thewalai are being built, which are enshrined sacred objects. Buddha's wish Bodhisattva Avalokitesvara and Goddess Parmita Devi There is also a holy well. The water from this well has been summoned to join the coronation ceremony. His Majesty in May 2019.



5 P.M. Have dinner at the restaurant.

7 P.M. Return to the hotel free time rest.

Day 2: Wat Tham Saeng Phet – Wat Si Yaek Saeng Phet – Damnoen Saduak Shop – Ban Na Mo Ma reed mat weaving group

In the morning Have breakfast at the hotel restaurant. After the meal, take you to **Tham**

Saeng Phet Temple. Tham Saeng Phet Temple or Sala Phanhong Temple. It is located on Amnat Charoen-Khemmarat Road Wat Tham Saeng Phet. It is a temple with a wide area, consisting of a sanctuary on a high hill. On the north side of



the viharn there is

a large cave. Inside the cave, there is a Buddha image with beautiful Buddhist characteristics. The reason was named Tham Saeng Phet because of the gleaming of the stone flakes when the sun shines like a diamond. At this temple, international monks regularly come to practice the Dharma. There is also a reclining Buddha image at Wat Tham Saeng Phet. (It is an amulet that is in the project to pay respect to 9

temples to enhance the power and prestige Amnat Charoen) is enshrined at Wat Tham Saeng

Phet. Nong Masao Subdistrict, Mueang District, Amnat Charoen Province. It is the 5th

branch temple of Wat Nong Pa Phong, Luang Pu Cha Suphatto, Wat Nong Pa Phong, Ubon

Ratchathani Province. Walked for a hike to the Saeng Phet Cave area and used the cave as a

place of meditation in 1968, it is quiet and

suitable for practicing dharma. Then take you

on a journey **Si Yaek Saeng Phet Temple** or

the villagers like to call it Tham Saeng Phet

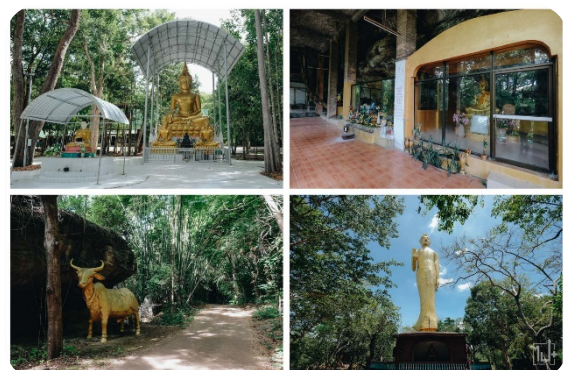
Temple (Top). It is located on Phu Hin Sand,

the same area as Wat Tham Saeng Phet

(bottom). All types of vehicles can drive up to

the top of the mountain. located in Muang

District Amnat Charoen Province Located not



far from Wat Tham Saeng Phet and Huai Si To Reservoir. Inside Wat Yi Yaek Saeng Phet the atmosphere is shady, spacious and has very beautiful buildings such as stupa, pagodas, shrines, large reclining Buddha images with beautiful Buddha images. It is another temple in Amnat Charoen that is worth visiting. The outdoor wooden ubosot has been restored to be beautiful. The appearance and atmosphere are like that of Wat Phu Prao, Chong Mek, Ubon, but this place is not decorated with fluorescent colors only. There is also a large golden chedi, inside there is a portrait of Luang Pu Cha Suphatto, a respected monk of the Isan people. This temple is also enshrined with a large reclining Buddha image, which is said to be built in the style of Buddhist art according to the description of Krom Phraya Damrong Rajanupap.

At noon Have lunch at a restaurant.

In the afternoon Take you on a journey **Damnoen Saduak**. Restaurants and cafes have a retro atmosphere of Amnat Charoen. The shop is located along the road in the city. Outstanding with many antique collectibles. There are many beautiful corners to take photos of. Passed by Amnat Charoen area, looking for a nice restaurant, coffee, nice atmosphere, recommended coming to this shop. It is the most beautiful shop in this



province that has it all. Food and beverage prices are not expensive. After relaxing with the atmosphere of the restaurant, take you to **Ban Na Mo Ma reed mat weaving group**. The weaving of reed mats is considered an art. The culture of the Isan people existed since ancestors. In the past, they were often woven for household use. Nowadays, it has become an incredible supplementary occupation, especially the handicraft group of Ban Na Mor Ma, Na Mor Ma Subdistrict, Mueang District, Amnat Charoen Province. Reed mat weaving is the group's featured product that generates quite a bit of income for its members. Originally, villagers brought reeds There are many in the village of Na Mo Ma. Let it dry in the sun, and then weave it into a mat but will have a short lifespan. Later, it was developed by bringing the reeds into strips and weaving them into pieces by using hemp fibers to make a spiral to make a standing line. This makes the mats have better quality and longer service life. Weaving with reeds with natural color. It has been developed by bringing the reeds to dye as needed to



enhance their beauty. Woven for its use as a souvenir used in traditional merit-making Making reed mat products become Mudmee widely known in the community and nearby localities until receiving compliments from the audience that It is a quality and beautiful mat. "In 1975, a group of people who weave reed mats were gathered to see a reed mat weaving event in Chanthaburi Province and started full production since the planting.

Maintenance for quality reeds Suitable for dyeing and weaving Then there are government agencies to support many agencies. The development of the province sends officers to take care of introducing new patterns all the time to meet the market needs." Vice President of the reed mat weaving group said

Highlights of reed products The product fibers are small, shiny, and have more than 200 beautiful patterns

and are diverse. by applying patterns from silk When weaving is finished, it will be smooth. The dye does not bleed and is a natural color such as the bark of the Keng tree, the red tree, the cassia tree, etc. As for the pattern, it will be a Mudmee pattern. The distinctive characteristics are 1. It has a local identity, such as the rain pattern, the glass flower pattern, the Sida basket pattern. And can be woven according to the needs of customers and various agency logos 2. Beautiful colors such as dark brown, light brown, and natural colors, and 3. Good quality and not moldy.

Day Three: A billion stone pagodas – Huai Si To Reservoir

– Bangkok (-/-/-)



In the morning Have breakfast at the hotel restaurant. After the meal, you can store your luggage for check out from the hotel. then take you on a journey **Billion stone pagoda**. It is located at Phu Phanom Dee Temple, Senangkhanikhom District, Amnat Charoen Province. A beautifully built stone chedi perched on Phu Hin Sai, Wat Phu Phanom Dee stands out from the bottom of the spire. Surrounded by large

and small trees, it is a complete community forest. This pagoda was built in 1999 with concrete mortar, and countless small gray and white stones have been decorated along the walls, ceilings, and statues to create beautiful patterns until becoming a billion stone pagodas Height over 30 meters, base over 20 meters. Surrounding the shady area with large and small



trees. It is both a place for religious activities and practice. At present, Wat Phu Phanom Dee has been developed as a religious tourist attraction besides a billion stone pagodas, it is also enshrined Phra Sri Rattana Trait. White Buddha statue on the cliff with many sacred reverences. Then take you on a journey to **Huai Si To Reservoir**. It is located at Mu 5, Amnat

Charoen-Khemmarat Road. Nong Masao Subdistrict is a small reservoir built for agriculture and irrigation to block the Huai Si To River. It is a recreation place for the Amnat Charoen people. Around the reservoir are viewpoints, swimming spots, and recreational spots. There is a visitor center in the park. If it's the summer, it's especially busy. The evening can be used as a place to exercise as well.





At noon Have dinner at a restaurant, then take you from Amnat Charoen back to Bangkok which takes about 8 hours.
