





- DAY1 Samui Betong Halabala Bridge Betong Tunnel Clock Tower Postbox Betong Airport (B/L/D)
- 23.00 Assemble at the meeting point, and on the way to Betong, Yala.
- 07.30 Arrive at Betong, Yala, and continue to have Dim Sum, a famous breakfast of Betong.
- Morning Then leave for Betong, stop to take beautiful photos with the beautiful river on Halabala Bridge. This bridge is the main route to Betong and is also a very popular viewpoint. It is recommended to stand in the middle of the bridge to see a large water inlet as far as the eye can see, both sides are embraced by the lush greenery of the evergreen forest that is still fertile. Before entering the city of Betong, we would stop and take some photos, you will get beautiful pictures with a beautiful atmosphere. After that, we will take you to Mongkhonrit Tunnel, the tunnel that created by drilling through the mountains in the middle of the city to reduce the distance to travel in downtown Betong.
- Noon Lunch
- Afternoon Take a photo with the Clock Tower, Betong Post Box. The largest mailbox in Thailand, it was built to use it as a radio station to spread the news of the country to the people of Betong to hear from the radio on top of the mailbox, and it is still serve as a mailbox until today. After that, we would travel to Betong Airport, located at Yarom Subdistrict, Betong District, Yala Province. It is about 10 kilometers in the northeast of Betong City. It is the 29th new airport under the Department of Airports, Ministry of Transport, and it is the 39th airport in Thailand.

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DAY2Ayer Weng Sea of Mist – Hot Spring – Tae Pu Chu Bridge - Muen Buppha Garden – PiyamitTunnel – Stadium in the Middle of the Valley – Betong Waling Street(B/L/D)

04.00 Go for a Skywalk to see the most beautiful Ayer Weng sea of mist, it is located in Ayer Weng Subdistrict, Betong District, Yala Province. It is a popular mist viewpoint of Betong that is easy to reach by car, and there is a sea of mist to watch all year round. The sea of mist at Ayer Weng is 2,038 meters above sea level, it is a large and beautiful sea of mist. In the morning, this vantage point becomes heaven on earth, opened for tourists to enjoy the sea of mist, fresh air and a beautiful view of the Microwave Peak.



Morning Breakfast at local restaurant to promote local business, there are Khao Yam Budu, tea, coffee, Patongo, and local dessert.



After

Visit the Tae Pu Chu Bridge, a suspension bridge used for local villagers' traffic, stretched with wire ropes, showing the wisdom of the past, laid with laths across the Pattani River, more than 100 meters long.



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On the way to Betong Hot Springs, you can relax with a foot bath in warm water. The hot spring is a large natural hot spring with an area of approximately 3 rai. There will be hot water springing up from the underground contains many minerals. The water temperature is around 80 degrees Celsius which chicken eggs can be cooked within 10 minutes. The landscape around the hotspring has been renovated to bemore beautiful yet still natural, suitable for recreation.

<u>Recommended activities</u> : You can soak your body or your feet in the hotsprin, both large hot springs, new hot spring, and in the hydrotherapy building. It is believed that this mineral water can relieve various diseases, such as aches and pains, skin diseases, and also you can try boiling eggs in this hot spring.



Muen Buppha Garden, a winter flower garden in Betong. It is the only winter flower garden in the south due to Betong's favorable climate. With the terrain that is about 800 meters above sea level, the climate is cool all year round and the water system is sufficient. It is suitable for planting various types of winter flowers. This flower garden is among the mountains in the royal project of HRH Princess Maha Chakri Sirindhorn with a variety of flowers blooming that are planted in rows to attract tourists to visit and experience the climate with lower temperatures than other areas of South. Here, you can take beautiful photos in the Muen Buppha winter



flower garden in the valley Royal projects of Her Royal Highness Princess Maha Chakri Sirindhorn.



On the way to, Piyamit Tunnel. It is an earthen tunnel built by the former Malaya communist bandit as a base for political struggle but later came back to develop the Thai nation. The Piyamit Tunnel was built in 1976 to avoid air raids and collect supplies. Nowadays, it is open as a tourist attraction for tourists who are interested in learning the history of the past. At the entrance, there is a large statue of Guan Yin to pay homage to the thousand-year banyan tree. This is another highlight of the trip to the Piyamit Tunnels, the exotic banyan trees. There are 2 large hollows around the trunk that we can walk into.

On the way to downtown, visit the Betong Museum. Learn about the history of this misty town. Visit a sport stadium in the middle of the valley where local people exercise. Then we would travel to Street Art street.



Go to Street Art street, created by a team of students and teachers from Silpakorn University. They painted it at the 111th anniversary of Betong to impress tourists and Betong people. They create art that tells the story of the way of life and symbols of Betong City, there 11 points on the wall, under the bridge and in many buildings around the city that can attract tourists as well. Then, we would go to Betong Walking Street, you can stroll around, shopping for local products or try some delicious food.
