Day 1 Bangkok– Chaiphum – Phra Chaiphum Siri Maha Chedi – Moh Hin Khao – Pha Hua Nak

05.00 Depart from Bangkok to Chaiphum, it would take around 4 hours and 30 minutes.

07.30 Breakfast at the restaurant.

10.00 Arrive at Chaiphum. Take you to Phra Chaiphum Siri Maha Chedi. Phra Mahathat Chedi Sirichaiyaphum at Wat Arun Thammasathan. It is located on Phu Laen Kha hill, Kaeng Khro District, Chaiphum Province. It is another sacred and important place in Chaiphum Province, which is enshrined Phra Mahathat Ratchamongkol Chedi Sirichaiyaphum or Phra That Chaiphum, and it is also a place of religious practice. Wat Arun Thammasathan Phra That Chaiphum, Kaeng Khro District, Chaiphum Province, is a place of dharma practice in the initiative of Phra Thammasirichai, the abbot of Wat Arun Ratchawararam 13. It was built in 2007 in an area of over 200 rai. It was built from an ancient chedi building plan according to the outline of Lan Chang and Lanna arts. The pagoda is in the shape of a castle. The top of the roof enshrines a standing Buddha image in Lan Xang style. The height is 21 meters. The purpose of building this Phra Mahathat Chedi



Sinichaiyaphum is to make it a unique artwork of Chaiphum Province. Phra That Chaiphum has 2 stairs going up. Stucco work on the stairs is a stucco work of various animals. There is a lot of detail. The sculpture will have a sign that says "Ya-Bai", the word "Ya-Bai" means "don't touch" in the Isan language. Inside, there is a statue of Phra Ya Lae that Chaiphum people worship and the beautiful Lan Xang architecture. At the top, there is a chedi

containing relics and a viewpoint that can see the surrounding area far away. Above, there is a place to receive alms. You can buy offerings to monks from the next to the staff selling merit-making kits.

Noon Lunch at the restaurant.

Afternoon Go to [Moh Hin Khao](#). One of Chaiyaphum's landmarks, "Mo Hin Khao" is located in Phu Laen Kha National Park. 5 large stone pillars occur naturally, located on a wide grass field of a hill within Phu Laen Kha National Park, Ban Wang Kham Khaen, Village No. 9, Tha Hin Ngom Sub-district, Mueang District, Chaiyaphum Province. These white sandstones were formed by the accumulation of silt and clay from waterways, causing fractures, decay and erosion until become the stones on the hills as can see today. It is assumed to be around 175-197 million years old. The charm of Mo Hin Khao is not only beautiful white sandstone pillars, but the surrounding area is also filled with fertile forests. The weather is fresh and cool. The courtyard is filled with beautiful vintage-style wild flowers. Importantly, here is one of the most beautiful sunrise viewpoints in Thailand and a camping ground to see the romantic sea of stars. Moreover, around the courtyard of Mor Hin Khao, there are other interesting groups of stone courtyards. Next to the first group of stone courtyards is a beautiful low-rise stone courtyard with rounded heads about 1-2 meters high. There are about 50-60 blocks, called "Lan Hin Chedi Klong Chang", which the ground is filled with pink grass. It is best to visit this place in the evening before sunset.



15.00 Arrive at [Pha Hua Nak](#). It is another beautiful sunset viewpoint of "Phu Laen Kha National Park". "Pha Hua Nak Viewpoint", drive for another 2 kilometers, then walk the stairs, and go up the hill a little bit to reach Pha Hua Nak. It is located in the Phu Laen Kha National Park, Tha Hin Ngom Subdistrict, Mueang District, Chaiyaphum Province. Pha Hua



Nak is part of Mor Hin Khao. In the rainy season, wildflowers bloom all over the area and you can see the sea of mist in the morning. Pha Hua Nak is about 4 kilometers from Mor Hin Khao, you can see the different mountains and the opposite view of Pha Hua Nak's Pha Hua Nak, which is the Phang Hoei mountain range. Pha Hua Nak is a rocky cliff protruding from the mountain similar to Naga's head. Therefore, the villagers call this cliff "Pha Hua Nak".

17.00 Check in at the Room Resort.

19.00 **Dinner at the restaurant.** Then take you back to the hotel for rest.

Day 2 Phra Phutthabat Phuaet Temple - Chaiyaphum Phithak Temple (Pha Keung)– Sai Thong National Park

Morning **Breakfast at the hotel’s dining room.** Then, take you to **Phra Phutthabat Phuaet Temple**. It is located at Na Siew Subdistrict, Mueang District, Chaiyaphum Province, about 23 kilometers from the city on the same route as Wat Sila At Phu Phra uses Highway No. 201 (Chaiyaphum - Kaeng Khro). It is a low hill with footprints in the rock similar to the Buddha's footprint in Saraburi province. The entrance to the temple on both sides is with trees along the way. Moreover, Chaiyaphum Province also has many other religious sites, such as Phra Phutthabat Khao Yai Hom, located in Wat Phra Phutthabat Khao Yai Hom, Na Yang Klak Subdistrict, Thep Sathit District. The left Buddha's footprint is deep in a red stone courtyard, size 75 centimeters wide, 180 centimeters long, 45 centimeters deep. The end of the Buddha's footprint is facing southeast, about 65 kilometers from Thep Sathit district. Phra



That Nong Sam Muen is located at the temple. Phra That Nong Sam Muen, Ban Kaeo, Ban Kaeo Subdistrict, Phu Khiao District. It is a chedi made of bricks, plastered with two wooden recesses. It is located on a square green base, about 13.30 meters wide. Stairs are leading up on three sides. The staircase is about 4.90 meters wide and has five steps. There is a Thaksin courtyard around the chedi. Next up is the chopping board base around the lotus base of the elemental house with lotus wire between the upper

element. There are arches in all four directions. Inside, the arch on the north side enshrines a Buddha image in the same posture as the west side. The east and south arches are Buddha images in the posture of a dance. Characteristics of Buddhist art influence Lan Xang art mixed in both the face and the clothes. There are small stupas in all four directions. The top of the chedi looks like a square. The middle was slightly bloated. It is assumed that the age is



around the 21st - 22nd Buddhist century. Take you to **Chaiyaphum Phithak Temple (Pha Keung)**. Pha Keung is part of Phu Langka. If traveling along the Chaiyaphum-Nong Bua Daeng route, you will see high cliffs along the way like a crescent moon sticking out. Therefore, the villagers call it Pha Keung, which means moon in the Isan language. On the hill, there is Wat Pha Keung or Chaiyaphum Phithak Temple. It is

enshrined the Chaiyaphum Phithak Buddha image, which is a large standing Buddha image, 14 meters high. In front of the Buddha image is a beautiful viewpoint. Moreover, in the temple area, there are also relics of Pha Keung and a museum of antiques for tourists to see. Pha Keung is about 36 kilometers from the city on Highway No. 2159 (Chaiyaphum-Nong Bua Daeng). Phu Langka National Park It is located in Chaiyaphum province, with an area of approximately 92,500 rai. It is a protected forest area according to the law and forest conservation according to the Cabinet resolutions on 10 and 17 March 1992. Importantly, it is the watershed forest area, fertile forest, natural resource restoration forest, wildlife habitat, and forest area that the National Park Committee, the Subcommittee on Prevention and

Suppression of Forest Resource Destruction, Environmental

Conservation Club, Environmental Organization.

Northeastern region and all relevant sub-district administrative organizations approve and support the establishment of Phu Langka National Park. Phu Langka National Park has many attractions. In the past, it used to be a strategic military point. (History of the battle) and the history of the Grandfather Duang Shrine.



Highlights include Tad Hin Lat Tat Ton Noi, Phu Kham Noi, Phu Klang, Phu Dee, Pha Keung, Pha Phe, Pha Kluay

Mai, Tham Kluea, Tham Phra, Tham Phra, Chi River, Lat Hin Taek, Thep Bucha, Pratu Klong, Thung Dok Krachiao. Phu Langka National Park is suitable to welcome tourists all year round.

Noon **Lunch at the restaurant.**

Afternoon Arrive at [Sai Thong National Park](#). There are 2 highlight points which are Pha Ham Hod and Thung Bua Sawan. Sai Thong National Park is in Nong Bua Rawe district, Thep Sathit district, Phakdi Chumphon district, and Nong Bua Daeng district, Chaiyaphum Province. It has an area of approximately 199,375 rai or 319



square kilometers. It borders Pa Hin Ngam National Park and Phu Laen Kha National Park. At the beginning of the rainy season, the forest is lush and moist with plants in

the Phraya Pho Mountain Range and the Phang Yei

Mountain Range. The topography consists of many high and low mountains. It has an altitude of 300 meters above sea level. It is the upstream forest area of Huai Pong Khun Phet, Lam Huai Chiang Tha, Lam Huai Yae, Lam Huai Yang, Lam Nam Chao, Lam Jiang, which is a tributary of the Chi River. This place is also outstandingly beautiful with daffodils that bloom all over



the field, known as Thung Bua Sawan. There is a beautiful

Sai Thong Waterfall and a cliff for everyone to test their fears. "Thung Bua Sawan" or "Thung Dok Krachiao" has both pink flowers and white flowers on the west ridge of the mountain. There are 5 large fields, about 10 kilometers from the national park office. It will bloom beautifully in the fields around June-August. Sai Thong National Park organizes ecotourism, which is to arrange a guide to take those interested in walking up to camp on the Bua Sawan field.

Evening **Dinner at the restaurant.**

19.00 Back to the Room Resort for rest.

Day 3 Thung Bua Daeng, Bueng Lahan - Pa Hin Ngam National Park – Bangkok

Morning **Breakfast at the hotel’s dining room.** Pack your bags to check out from the hotel. After that, take you to **Thung Bua Daeng, Bueng Lahan**. Bueng Lahan is the 4th largest freshwater lake in the country, with an area of more than 18,000 rai. It is ecologically rich because it is full of red lotuses and is a breeding ground for fish, freshwater animals, and many different kinds of birds. The peak period of viewing the red lotus is from January to June and should come between 06.30 - 07.00 because the red lotus will gradually bloom in the morning sunlight. It is a wide bay of more than 500 rai. If you want to get closer, you can take a boat of the villagers to visit. Moreover, you can also experience the way of life of the villagers who are engaged in fishing in Bueng Lahan. They catch fish with nets, nets, Yilu, Zhu, Tum, Sai Kung.



Then, take you to **Pa Hin Ngam National Park**. It is located in Thep Sathit and Sap Yai district, Chaiyaphum province. There is a forest in perfect condition. It is the watershed source of the Chi River and Pa Sak Rivers. There are many beautiful natural features, especially the Krachiao flower field. In the past, Lan Hin Ngam was known only to residents. Later, in 1985, Thep Sathit District Chief And the forest of Thep Sathit district has inspected the area and found a beautiful natural stone courtyard that should be preserved as a tourist attraction and relaxation of the general public. They submitted the matter to the Forest Service. In the beginning, the Royal Forest Department announced it as Pa Hin Ngam Forest Park on October 10, 1986, covering an area of approximately 10 square kilometers or 6,250 rai. Later in 1993, the Royal Forest Department conducted a thorough survey of nearby areas and found that There are still fertile forests covering an area of about 112 square kilometers

or 70,000 rai. It is also geologically outstanding. There is a stone courtyard that looks strangely beautiful. There is a purple-pink Kachia flower that blooms in the early rainy season. There are beautiful waterfalls that deserve to be preserved in the form of a national park, which was announced in the Government Gazette Volume 124, Part 26 Kor, dated June 6, 2007, as the country's 105th national park.

Noon **Lunch at the restaurant.** After that, back to Bangkok.

Afternoon Depart from Chaiyaphum to Bangkok, it would take around 4 hours and 30 minutes.

17.30 Arrive at Bangkok safely.
