





Day 1 Bangkok – Chanthaburi - Noen Nang Phaya Viewpoint - Kung Krabaen Bay Royal
Development Study Center - Pak Nam Khaem Nu Temple – Khao Laem Sing Temple- Chak Yai
Temple – Mangkon Buppharam Temple- Centric Family Night Market (-/-/-)

06.00 Depart from Bangkok to Chanthaburi would take around 3-4 hours.

09.30 Arrive at Chanthaburi. Take you to Noen Nang Phaya Viewpoint. It is located on

the hill by the seaside near Khung Wiman Beach and the Kung Kraben estuary. It is a famous viewpoint in Chanthaburi because of its beautiful scenery. It is the longest coastal road in Thailand, with a total distance of 111 kilometers. This road is already a landmark for cyclists, so this road has lanes for bicycles most of the way. Along the way, there are many interesting attractions. When looking from a viewpoint, you will see beautiful



scenery. There is a view of the mountains and the sea. You don't need to worry about safety



because there is a fence around the cliff. There is an area to sit to relax and take photos. Another highlight of Noen Nang Phaya Viewpoint is the love key. Many couples have the goal to come here for locking the keys as a promise of love between them.

Then take you to Kung Krabaen Bay Royal Development Study Center. It is located at Khlong Khut Subdistrict, Tha Mai District, Chanthaburi Province. It was established at the initiative of His Majesty the King to consider suitable areas to develop fisheries and agriculture occupational development projects in the





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coastal land area of Chanthaburi. It works on conservation, coastal resource management, and promotion and career development of the people of the Khung Kraben Center. It is promoted as a tourist destination for people who are interested in studying nature to understand the ecosystems in the mangrove forest and know how to use those resources to the

maximum benefit. The surrounding area of the mangrove forest has a nature study path which is the Development Study Center created. It has a distance of 1.6 kilometers and takes about 45 minutes - 1 hour to walk. It was a slatted bridge stretching into the mangrove forest. There are various types of plants such as small-leaved mangroves, large-leaved mangroves, red

burrows, red flower teak forests, white flower teak forests, Lamphu Talay, Samae Talay, etc. Each type of tree has a sign indicating its name, characteristics, and properties. Moreover, you will see little animals such as foot fish, sand crabs running around. The atmosphere in the walk is quite shady and cool with trees that cover both sides of the road.



Noon Lunch at the restaurant.

Afternoon Take you to pay respect to monks and take photos at Pak Nam Khaem Nu Temple, Tha Mai District. It is the photographic landmark of Chanthaburi. It is a blue church floor pattern contrasting with the white background similar to the porcelain vessels made of ceramics in ancient times. It is different from the general chapel that has been seen to be eye-catching to





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those who have seen the picture, causing its images to be shared on social media until tourists



come to see its beauty and take pictures. Wat Pak Nam Khem Nu is located at the Pak Nam Khaem Nu Bridge on the estuary coast. After getting off the bridge, turn left to reach Wat Pak Nam Khaem Nu. The history of this church is that the old church began to deteriorate more because the temple was next to the sea, causing the structure to decay to the roof. Therefore, the old church was

replaced by a new church. They tried to find a way to prevent the new church from rapidly deteriorating. Therefore, there is an idea to use ceramics to coat the plaster layer of the Ubosot to prevent saltwater and to use blue and white patterns in contrast to the colors of porcelain in ancient times that were only used in these 2 colors. When they used it, they found that it is beautiful and outstanding.

Then take you to Khao Laem Sing Temple. It is a temple with a very good atmosphere in Chanthaburi province. It can see the view of Taksin Tharat Bridge and the fishing village. In addition, the church is distinguished by its clean white color decorated with fine motifs. Inside is enshrined Luang Pho Kaew Pratananuek that people often come to pay respect to, including making merit, building a church and gilding Luk Nimit.





After that, take you to Chak Yai Temple at Laem Sing District. It is a shady temple and has an area of up to 50 rai. Inside the temple are many sculptures about Buddhism. Signs are explaining the stories of each sculpture for tourists to understand in detail. This Buddhist park has sculptures that stand out from the story of the Lord Buddha while giving sermons based on the history



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of the Buddha. There is also a reclining Buddha image and a Buddha image in the posture of a Naga for tourists to come to worship and make merit for good fortune as well.

Then take you to Mangkon Buppharam Temple. It is a temple in Mahayana Buddhism of the Chinese sect, built in 1977 as a branch temple of Wat Mangkon Kamalawat (Leng Nei Yi) Bangkok. It is considered the position of the dragon's head, while the Buppharam Dragon Temple (Leng Hua Yi) is the position of the dragon's tail. The outstanding feature of the temple is the valuable blend of Thai-Chinese Buddhist art architecture. In front of the temple is a viharn of Thao



Chatulokban enshrining the four Phra Sri Ariyamattraiya Bodhisattva and Thao Chatulokban.



Inside the temple, there is a three-tiered Chinese-style ordination hall enshrining three principal Buddha images. In addition, there is also a pavilion of the Ubosot decorated with mosaics in various beautiful patterns. The atmosphere inside the temple is quiet, shady, suitable for those who are interested in practicing dharma.



Evening Take you to Centric Family Night Market. It is a night market that sells a wide variety of exotic and modern ready meals. It also sells clothing and accessories such as bags, shoes, jewelry, and other items. This Centric Market is divided into 2 zones: a food zone, and a first-hand and second-hand products zone. There is also a place to sit and eat and enjoy the music.

Dinner of your choice.

19.00 Check in at the New Travel Lodge hotel or a hotel of the same level.



Day 2 Chanthaboon Waterfront Community – Cathedral of the Immaculate Conception - Khao Sukim Temple– Viva Foresta Farm – Bangkok (-/-/-)

Morning Breakfast at the hotel's dining room. Pack your bags to check out from the hotel.



the traces of the past of this old community have not faded over time. Nowadays, it has become a tourist attraction that anyone who visits Chanthaburi should not miss.

Then take you to Chanthaboon Waterfront Community. It is an old Chinese and Vietnamese immigrant since the early Rattanakosin period. Later, it developed into an economic and trade center of Chanthaburi during the reign of King Rama V. Although the era has changed a lot,



Continue to Cathedral of the Immaculate Conception or the Church of Our Lady of the Immaculate Conception Church, Chanthaburi. It is over 100 years old. The Church of Mae Phra Patisonthi Niramon Temple is located at Chanthanimit Subdistrict, Mueang Chanthaburi District, Chanthaburi Province. It is a Roman Catholic church built according to the style of Gothic art that is modeled from the Notre Dame Church in France. It used to have a spire roof, but later it was dismantled during World War II to stand out and prevent the attack. The decoration of the church is decorated with stained glass stencils depicting various Christian saints. There is a statue of the Virgin Mary standing in front of a Gothic cathedral. Inside, there is peace and beauty because decorated with European art. It is a building that, although it has been past for a long time, is still very beautiful.







Noon Lunch at the restaurant.

Afternoon Take you to Khao Sukim Temple. It was built in 1966 with the faith of Buddhists towards Phra Ajarn Somchai Thitwiriyo. It is intended to be used as a place of worship for Buddhists. It used to be a local meditation place known by the villagers as "Khao I Kim" with an area of approximately 3,280 rai. In 1964, the villagers invited Phra Ajarn Somchaithit Wiriyo and monks and novices from Noen Din Daeng Monastery, which is not far away,



came to live on Ikim Mountain. Due to the Buddhist faith in Phra Ajarn Somchai Thitwiriyo, the temple was started building in the same year. It was intended to be used as a place of worship for Buddhists, along with building Mattayom Wat Khao Sukim School and Wat Khao Sukim Hospital, for the public benefit. Therefore, Wat Khao Sukim is one of

the most developed and famous temples in Chanthaburi. The interesting thing within this temple is the main Buddha image which is a large Buddha image, 110 inches tall, 99 inches wide, lap width, with a niche around the Buddha image in a 9-headed Naga pattern. Khao Sukim Temple Museum is on the 3rd floor of the 60th Anniversary Building. It





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houses a collection of antiques such as Buddha images in various postures made of stone and bronze, small and large Chinese porcelain wares, stone axes, gongs, pots, jars, knives, swords, bronze ornaments, coconut grater, etc. There is also an exhibition of wax figures of famous monks in Thailand such as Luang Pu Waen, Luang Pu Wan, Phra Ajarn Mun, etc. Inside the temple, it is a meditation center.

After that, take you to Viva Foresta Farm. It is located at Na Yai Am District, Chanthaburi



Province, with over 31 rai. It is surrounded by long mountain views, beautiful flower gardens, and photo spots throughout the farm. Especially during the rainy season with fog in the morning, you will feel like visiting Switzerland. Viva Foresta Farm has more than 300 different animals such as white furry sheep, llama, camel, sucata tortoise, giant tortoise, dwarf horse, dwarf donkey, dwarf goat,

Angora goat, potbelly pygmy pig, Netherlands dwarf rabbit Holland Lop Rabbit Flemish giant hare, dwarf hedgehog, ferret, Indian star deer, sika deer, rusa deer, American silky fowl, Indian Runners, Mandarin Ducks, Woodtucks, Gooses, White Swans, Black Swans, Koi, Sun Conures and Brutal Emu. We can feed and play with them. There are also many photo spots, especially the giant windmills that we can go up to see a bird's eye view from the top of the

flower bed of various species that change with the seasons. There is a giant moai head sculpture, a large black-faced sheep family statue, and a swan pool that lets swans, ducks of various species swim freely. There are a restaurant, a coffee shop, a snack shop herbal drink shop, and an ice cream shop.

16.00 Depart from Chanthaburi to Bangkok would take around 3-4 hours.



19.00 Arrive at Bangkok safely.
