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Day 1Bangkok – Damnoen Saduak Floating Market – Hua Hin - Venezia - Sheep Farm -Ratchaphakdi Park

**06.30** Depart from Bangkok to Ratchaburi (Damnoen Saduak) would take around 1 hour and 30 minutes.

**08.00** Arrive at Ratchaburi. Then take you to Damnoen Saduak Floating Market. It is a very famous tourist attraction of Ratchaburi. It was first introduced to the world as a tourist attraction in 1967 in the image of a floating market full of boats carrying goods necessary for a living. Vendors wear dark-colored clothes like the farmer and put a hat to sell goods on the



boats. Nowadays, many Thai and foreign tourists come to see the way of life and trading in this floating market. Damnoen Saduak Floating Market is a hundred-year-old market that the Damnoen Saduak Canal was dug under the royal initiative of King Mongkut. He saw that this local transport has no roads that connect to other districts, and most of them use boats as a vehicle. This canal connects the Tha Chin River and the Mae Klong River. It took

about 2 years to dig. The name of the canal was given by King Rama V. In the past, Damnoen Saduak Floating Market was the center of trading in seasonal vegetables and fruits from the farmers in the area. But nowadays, Damnoen Saduak Floating Market has products for sale both on land and in boats. Visiting to this market is not afraid of the heat because there is a

path roofs on both sides of the market. This canal is a canal that people in Ratchaburi, Samut Sakhon and Samut Songkhram provinces use for transportation. It has the same meaning as "Damnoen Saduak" means convenient transportation. Even today the original purpose has changed, but there are still a lot of vendors and tourists. Nowadays, Damnoen Saduak Floating





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Market is like a meeting place for hundreds of boats to sell agricultural products, local handicraft products, and has shops that picked up from factories in Bangkok or other provinces The floating market will start from 6:00 a.m. until about 11:00 a.m. Moreover, you will see the floating market and the way of life on both sides of the canal of the Thai people. Activities when visiting the Damnoen Floating Market: 1. Walk around the floating market to buy food and merchandise. Most products are

fruits such as bananas, grapefruit, rose apple, longan, mango, etc. They are inexpensive because they come directly from farmers. The food is Thai noodles, which are available in many shops. Moreover, there are local handicrafts such as scarves, ready-made garments, silk



images, etc. 2. Take a boat ride to see the atmosphere or dine on the boat. Tourists can also take a boat to see the floating market. You can rent a boat at the entrance to Damnoen Saduak Floating Market. At the pier, there will be a parking lot available.

Noon Lunch at the restaurant.

## Afternoon Arrive at Hua Hin. It is a district of Prachuap Khiri Khan Province. The

old name was "Ban Samor Rieng" or "Ban Laem Hin", where King Prajadhipok (Rama 7) built the Klai Kangwon Palace to stay in the summer, and today Klai Kangwon Palace is the residence of His Majesty King Rama 9. After that, take you to Venezia. It was inspired by the charm of Venice, Italy. Venice is a city that uses water transportation. Canals are one of the most used for transportation in the world. Moreover, there are shops





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and houses with beautiful sculptures located on both sides of the canal. Hua Hin town in Thailand is said that "Hua Hin never loses its charm". St. Mark's Square and the Bell Tower, the symbol of Venice, the world's most famous tourist attraction, are displayed in front of the project to be an activity area and viewpoint. Another symbol that represents Venice is the Grand Canal, which is over 200 m long. The atmosphere is really like being in Venice, Italy. The architecture and design of buildings in each zone have a different color that surrounds the architecture of each island of Venice and its beautiful landscape, such as flower gardens, fountains, and sculptures that truly represent Venice. The number of stores is 361 units or over 20,000 square meters, divided into 4 main zones: 1) Food and beverage zones, pub, and restaurant-style. Trendy restaurants, fast food, famous local restaurants, coffee shops, and bakeries. 2) Fashion products zone for both Thai and international brands. 3) Service zones such as supermarkets, banks, IT, spas, bookstores, etc. 4) Creative design products zones, artworks, and home decorations. Activity area with a size of 4,000 square meters and a viewing tower 23 meters high. Activities within the project include a gondola cruise, mini train, mini zoo, playland, and morning market. Then take you to Sheep Farm. It is an exotic



tourist attraction, "Swiss Sheep Farm", where you can admire the rural atmosphere inspired by the beautiful fields of Switzerland and experience the beauty of European architecture. It is suitable for family trips because there are many activities to enjoy and many points of interest within the farm. There are fun activities such as horse riding, 3D gallery

visits, sightseeing trams, and more. Further, you will see cute animals such as sheep, horses,

alpacas, and more. After that, go to Ratchaphakdi Park. His Majesty the King permitted the Royal Thai Army to build "The Royal Monument of the King of Siam" and establish a historical park named "Rajabhakti Park". It is a park built with loyalty to the King and honors the 7 Kings of Siam: 1. King Ramkhamhaeng (Sukhothai) 2. Somdej Phra Naresuan (Ayutthaya) 3. King Narai (Ayutthaya) 4. Somdej Phrachao Taksin (Krungthonburi) 5. His Majesty King





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Bhumibol Adulyadej (King Rama I of Rattanakosin) 6. His Majesty King Mongkut (King Rama IV) Rattanakosin) 7. King Chulalongkorn (King Rama 5 of Rattanakosin). All of them have made contributions to the nation. The Royal Thai Army has built Ratchaphakdi Park within Royal Thai Army, Hua Hin District, Prachuap Khiri Khan Province.

**Evening** Check in at Isanook hotel.

**18.00** Dinner at the restaurant. After that, take you back to the hotel for a rest.

**Day 2** Hua Hin Beach– Khao Sam Roi Yot National Park – Phraya Nakhon Cave– Huahin Artist Village– Cicada Market

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**Morning** Breakfast at the hotel's dining room. Take you to Hua Hin Beach. It's on the east side of the city. There are hotels and souvenir shops. Hua Hin Beach is approximately 5



kilometers long. The white sand is suitable for swimming in the sea. It is one of the most famous beaches in Prachuap Khiri Khan. In the past, Hua Hin beach was the resort of the elite in Thailand. However, this beach has become a popular tourist destination in the country currently, where every weekend is

crowded with tourists. In the past, Hua Hin beach was the

There are many luxury resorts and restaurants that make this beach delightful. There are also many activities such as beach walks, horse





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riding, and kitesurfing. Then take you to Khao Sam Roi Yot National Park. The topography consists of strange beauty with complex limestone mountains. According to the legend of the



Sam Roi Yot Mountain Range, this area used to be a sea with many large and small islands. One day, a fleet of Chinese junks was wrecked by a storm. 300 people who survived separate to live on various islands, hence it was named "Koh Sam Roi Rod", later distorted as "Khao Sam Roi Yot". The interesting attraction is Thung Sam Roi Yot. There is flooding all year. There are both fresh water and brackish water. It

is a source of biological and physical components that are a variety of plant, animal, and nutrient species. Thung Sam Roi Yot is a habitat for a variety of birds both local birds and seasonal migration birds. It is another important birdwatching destination in the country. At the hill, there is a Thung Sam Roi Yot Nature Study Center to study plant species. Along the way, you will find a variety of plants that grow in the fields: Khaem grass, reed, cattail, water moss, jak, lotus,



tiered algae, Phung Chado algae, and some plants that are hard to find.

Noon Lunch at the restaurant.



**Afternoon** Arrive at Phraya Nakhon Cave. It is located in Sam Roi Yot District, Prachuap Khiri Khan Province. It's a big cave. There is a chimney on the ceiling that allows light to come through. The highlight of Phraya Nakhon Cave is Kuhakaruhat Mansion. It is located



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inside the cave as a pavilion in a tetrahedron style. It is a royal throne built during the reign of King Rama V when he visited on June 20, 1890. Phraya Nakhon Cave is the work of Her Royal

Highness Princess Kajoncharatwong. It was built in Bangkok then sent to be assembled by Phraya Chonlayutyothin. His Majesty King Chulalongkorn came to raise the bouquet by himself. On the right stone wall are the monograms of King Rama V and King Rama 7 in large white letters. Khuha Mansion is also the present seal of Prachuap Khiri Khan Province. The cave was discovered by Chao Phraya Nakhon. According to history, in the reign of King Rama I, Chao



Phraya Nakhon, the ruler of Nakhon Si Thammarat, sailed through Khao Sam Roi Yot and a storm cause unable to continue the journey, so he stopped the boat to avoid the storm at this beach for several days and built a well for drinking, called "Bo Phraya Nakhon" The recommended time to visit is 10.30-11.30. It can travel all year but the good season which should be visited is during the winter-summer around December to March. After that, take you to Huahin Artist Village. It is located at Hin Lek Fai Subdistrict, Hua Hin District, Prachuap Khiri Khan Province. It is an art center with valuable art forms under the supervision of Ajarn Tawee Kesangam. Currently, 19 artists are creating their unique style of art. Each artist's studio is simply built in a total area of 9 rai. It is also a place for rotating exhibitions of the artworks of national artists. Focusing on a friendly, relaxed atmosphere with trees covered enhances happiness for those who visit. Prachuap Khiri Khan Province announced the status of "Hua Hin Artist Village" as a provincial cultural attraction in 2007. Hua Hin Artist Village is divided as follows: "Art galleries displaying works of art"



displays rare master's works. Most are watercolor and oil paintings by various artists. "Artist's studio is creating art", which collects works of art of the artists of Hua Hin. You can watch live painting work, drawing process, but must be in peace because the artist may lose concentration. "Two Clay Houses" exhibiting clay works by Mr. Dee and Mae A-ngun.



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There are beautiful statues of monks and children. "Baan Drawing House" is a creative art workshop zone such as drawing and painting dolls with a simple teaching method that takes no more than 2 hours, then you will have your artwork as a souvenir. "Handmade shop" from artists and artist housewives such as home decorations, accessories, T-shirts, masks, dolls, bags, etc.



**Evening** Dinner at the restaurant. Then back to Isanook hotel before going to the night market.

**19.00** Arrive at Cicada Market or "Cicada Market". It is located in "Suan Sri" (in front of the Hyatt Regency Hua Hin). It is a night market where shows and sells contemporary art pieces, artifacts, handmade items, home furnishings, clothes, second-hand things, and SME products. Moreover, there are performances by skilled artists and B-Boys in the Tropical Garden atmosphere.



**20.00** Back to the hotel for rest.



Day 3 Hua Hin Train Station – Huay Mongkol Temple – Bangkok

**Morning** Breakfast at the hotel's dining room. Pack your bags to check out from the hotel. Then take you to Hua Hin Train Station. The unique thing about this train station is the "Phra



Mongkut Klao Pavilion". It is a pavilion built during the reign of King Rama VI, with the old name "Pavilion Sanam Chan", located in the area of Sanam Chan Palace, Nakhon Pathom Province. It was built in 1926 by Phra Chao Ya Ther Krom Phra Kamphaeng Phet Akarayothin, Commander of the Railway of Siam. This building was influenced by Victorian architecture in 1968. Colonel Saeng Chulacharit, Governor of the Railway, built a

pavilion of

Sanam Chan during the reign of King Rama VI. It used to be located in Sanam Chan Palace in Nakhon Pathom Province to serve as a place for boarding and disembarking the King's trains. This construction was built by Thai craftsmanship. The opening ceremony of "Phra Phra Mongkut Klao" was on April 6, 1974, by Her Royal Highness Princess Maha Chakri



Sirindhorn Sobhavannawadi. Moreover, Hua Hin Railway Station is also a storage facility for an ancient steam locomotive ordered from England. This locomotive used to serve in



Thailand before World War II. There is also a coffee shop along the way that is good for taking pictures. After that, take you to Huay Mongkol Temple. It enshrines the image of Luang Phor Thuad. It is located in Hua Hin District, Prachuap Khiri Khan Province. The old name was "Wat Huai Khot". Later, His Majesty King Bhumibol Adulyadej gave the new name from Huai Khot to be "Huai



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Mongkol". Luang Phor Thuad was built to bow to the royal merit on the auspicious occasion of the 6th Cycle Birthday Anniversary, propagate and inherit Buddhism, and to be respected and worshiped as a refuge for the Buddhists. The atmosphere inside the temple is suitable for bringing the family to pay respects and ask for blessings to enhance the prosperity of life. The Buddha image was cast with alloy, lap width 9.9 meters, height 11.5 meters, on a 3-floor base, ground floor 70 meters wide, 70 meters long. This area is a scenic viewpoint. You can see

Tanaosri Mountains. The lower area of Luang Pu Thuat has a Three-headed Erawan elephant sculpture where people come to pay respects, make blessings, throw coins into Erawan's mouth, and walk under the belly of Erawan according to belief. Erawan elephant was made of 9 types of wood: teak, Rak, bat, jackfruit, Pradu, redwood, Teng Rak, Takhian, and sandalwood, which will protect according to each type of auspicious wood.
