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Day 1 leave from Bangkok - Kalasin Province - Phra That Phanom Model, Huai Mek District - Punboon Park

05.00 A.M. Depart from Bangkok to Kalasin Province It takes approximately 6 hours and 30 minutes.

At noon Arrive at **Kalasin Province**. Take you to **have lunch at a restaurant**. After that, take you to Phra That Phanom Model, Huai Mek District

In the afternoon Arrive at **Phra That Phanom Model, Huai Mek District**. Phra That Phanom Model Huai Mek located at Wat Tham Phithak in the municipality of Huai Mek



District Kalasin Province. Construction started from a meeting of monks at Wat Phra That Phanom Woramahawihan, That Phanom District, Nakhon Phanom Province on February 8, 1977 with Phra Thep Moli. The abbot of Wat Phra That Phanom Woramahawihan at that time was the presiding member of the ceremony. The meeting group discussed which parts and sacred objects of the original Phra That Phanom ong should be placed in which areas. In the end, the Sangha Council took the guesswork method. The result of the fortune-telling

appeared that Wat Thammaphithak Huai Mek District Kalasin Province allowed to Bring parts and sacred objects of the original Phra That Phanom to be enshrined in only one place.

The people of Huai Mek district regard the day of the 6th waxing moon of the 3rd lunar

month every year as the starting day of the celebration until the present.

3.30 P.M. Arrive at **Punboon Park**

Day 2 Muang Fa Daet Song Yang - Phra That Ya Khu - Phraya Chai Sunthon Monument - Rong Si Market

In the morning Have breakfast at the hotel room. After eating, take you on a journey to **Muang Fa Daet Song Yang** is located at Sema Village, Kamalasai District. Sema community organizes cultural tourism that "Wat Pho Chai Semaram" or "Wat Ban Kom" because in addition to being the center of the minds of people here It is also a public place that gathers people in the village as well. City of Fa Daet Song Yang or is mistakenly referred to as the Fa Daet Sung Yang. Some people call the city Sema because the map of the city is shaped like a sema leaf. It is an ancient city with a two-tiered earthen embankment with a length of about 5 kilometers around the embankment. The ditch will be in the middle of the two embankments. From the archaeological evidence discovered that the inhabitants of the city since prehistoric times. and was more prosperous in the Dvaravati period around the 13th-15th Buddhist century, as evidenced by Buddhism that appears generally both inside and outside the city, such as the sandstone bait parapet Memorize many Jataka images and Buddha history. Some are kept at Wat Pho Chai Semaram, which is not far from the city of

Fa Daet Song Yang. Some are in the same location where they were found. and some of them are kept and displayed at the Khon Kaen National Museum. There are also religious sites scattered throughout the city and outside the city, such as Phra That Ya Khu, a group of chedi at the religious sites of Non Wat Sung, Non Fa Yat, and Non Fah Daet. The Fine Arts Department has announced the



registration of Muang Fa Daet Song Yang as an ancient site on September 27, 1936. Phra That Ya Khu or Phra That Yai. It is the largest pagoda in the city of Fa Daet Song Yang. It looks like an octagonal chedi made of bricks. There appeared to be 3 periods of construction, namely, the base was a rectangular recess. There are stairs leading up to 4 directions, decorated with stucco built in the Dvaravati period. Next up is an octagonal base which is built on top of the original base in the form of a chedi in the Ayutthaya period. As for the bell body and the top part, it was built in the Rattanakosin period. Around the Phra. That is found a parapet carved in reliefs about the Buddha's history. Villagers believed that the relics contained the ashes of a senior monk who was revered by the townspeople. It can be seen from when Chiang Som won the war destroyed everything in Fa Daet Song Yang. But did not destroy the relics of Yakoo. It is an archaeological site that is still in perfect condition. The villagers hold a water ceremony for Phra That Ya Khu annually in May. To ask for rain and peace for the village. Another activity that tourists can do that is. Make a Krathong to worship Phra That Yakhu for good luck. Then bring him to pay respect to **Phra That Yakhu**, formerly known as "That Yai". For this reason, the villagers arrange an annual festival to worship the relics. Between April and May to ask for rain and peace for the village. If there is a chance to visit Kamalasai District Kalasin Province, then invite you to visit and pay respect to Phra That Yakhu for peace and prosperity.

At noon **Have lunch at the restaurant**



In the afternoon Arrive at **Phraya Chai Sunthon Monument** located in front of the post and telegraph office Kalasin Province. Phraya Chaisoonthorn Monument (Thao Somphamit) is a monument of Phraya Chaisoonthorn or "Thao Somphamit", the first governor of Kalasin-by-Kalasin people All groups have sacrificed their wealth to build a monument. To show gratitude to the creator of Kalasin, located in front of the post

office Kalasin Province is a place of worship for the people of Kalasin. including people from other provinces who came to live in Kalasin who often come to worship and pray for auspiciousness It is a valuable monument and a sacred object of Kalasin. The statue of Phraya Chai Sunthon is cast in life-size bronze standing on a pedestal. Right hand holding a kettle the left hand holds a criminal right sword. The people of Kalasin joined together to build a monument. to show gratitude to the founder of Kalasin

In the evening Take you to the **rice mill market**. It is a shopping center and a collection of unique local food stores such as dinosaur rice, Pa Tong Go Dinosaur, and dinosaur roti. It is also a space for performing music, art, and performances on various occasions. **After that, have dinning at restaurant.**



7 P.M. Take you back to the hotel. Free time, you to relax.

Day 3: Wat Phuttha Nimit (Phu Kao) - Sirindhorn Museum - Bangkok

In the morning Have breakfast at the hotel room. After eating, keep your luggage and check-out from the hotel. Wat Phuttha Nimit (Phu Kao).



9 A.M. Arrive at Wat Phuttha Nimit (Phu Kao) located on the top of Phu Kao the west side of the mountain has "The Reclining Buddha" is carved on a cliff that is thousands of years old. It has a left-sided appearance. His head supports his forearm. Where the forearm that supports the head is not erected, and the hand does not support the head without Ketumala the length of the Buddha image is 2

meters, height 0.5 meters, covered with gold leaf. Presumed to be Moggallana the left apostle of the Buddha. The temple organizes a ceremony to bathe the reclining Buddha image on April 19 of every year. Its local legend tells that Reclining Buddha was carved on this cliff. It was built after a little celebration of Phra That Phanom, around the



year 8 B.E. by a group of people who would go to build Phra That Phanom but couldn't make it in time. Phra That Phanom was completed first jointly built this reclining Buddha image in



1941. His Holiness Somdej Phra Maha Wirawong went up to inspect the Diocese of Northeast Thailand, and visit temples in the city of Sahatsakhan Which is about 8 kilometers west of Phu Kao. At that time, he also went to worship the Reclining Buddha at this cliff.

After completing the sermon, he returned to

Bangkok. Therefore, ordered the Director-General of the Fine Arts Department to register it as the first ancient artifact in Kalasin Province. Inside the temple, there is also a "Wooden chapel" which is an open chapel made from wood under the Lampo Dam. It is a wooden building in Thai style. Set on a stucco lotus wire base Three-tiered gable roof There are cantilever eaves on all four sides. Surrounding the Ubosot is beautifully carved in three-dimensional patterns and reliefs depicting the history of the Buddha, the Jataka Jataka, and the Vessantara Jataka. Inside the wooden chapel enshrined "Phra Mongkhon Chaisit Rojanaritthi Prasitphon" is the main Buddha image in the enlightenment posture or the golden meditation posture. The ceiling dome above the Buddha image is decorated with low-relief wood carvings about the Buddha's history, painted in gold. There is also "Vihara Sangkha Nimit", which houses various rare Buddha images and amulets. Another important place of this temple is "Phra Mahathat Chedi Phutthanimit". Which is a golden chedi with a weight of 30 kilograms inside enshrines relics from 5 countries, namely Thailand, India, Sri Lanka, Nepal, and Burma, including the Arahants. Phra Phuttha Nimit Lek Lai and a large number of sandstone Buddha images. Then take you on a journey to [Sirindhorn Museum](#). Formerly, this was the Phu Kum Khao Dinosaur Research Center. In 1994, the skeleton of an herbivorous dinosaur was discovered. Phu Wiang Gosaurus Sirindhorn in the area, that is the current excavation pit by Phrakhru Wichit Sahatsakhun Abbot of Sakkawan Temple. Since the end of 1994, a team of dinosaur surveyors from the Department of Mineral Resources. It has started a systematic excavation and found that Phu Kum Khao is the source where the most complete plant-eating dinosaur skeletons of Thailand were found. It has found dinosaur skeletons of various sizes. It is a type of carnivorous plant with more than 7 bones, the number of bones is more than 700 pieces, and the important thing is Parts of the skull, teeth, and jaws, and skeletons were found lined up. It's almost complete. All of the skeletons were in a layer of rock that rested on the mountainside of Phu Kum Khao. which is shaped like a straw It has a height of about 240 meters. In 1995, Her Royal Highness Princess Maha Chakri Sirindhorn Her Royal Highness Princess Maha Chakri Sirindhorn came to see the remains of dinosaur bones His Highness established a project to develop the Phu Kum Khao Dinosaur Museum. A temporary excavation pit building was to be built to protect the skeletal remains. In 1996, the Department of Mineral Resources built a research building. It has a usable area of 375 square meters to be used as a place for conservation, study, research, and collecting fossils discovered in Thailand. In 2007, it was fully open for service. Phu Kum Khao Dinosaur Research Center and Museum or Sirindhorn Museum. It is considered the first dinosaur research center and dinosaur museum in Thailand. It received the royal name from



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Her Royal Highness Princess Maha Chakri Sirindhorn Her Royal Highness Princess Maha Chakri Sirindhorn "Sirithorn Museum". Sirindhorn Museum has 2 exhibition buildings, the first building exhibits 2 parts, which are permanent exhibitions and temporary exhibitions. Starting from the 2nd floor, use the museum hall as a public relations area. In the hall, there are exhibits of dinosaur models of Siam Motyranus, Isan ensis, and information about the geology of Thailand.

At noon **Have lunch at the restaurant**

In the afternoon Depart from Kalasin Province to go back to Bangkok the travel time is approximately 6 hours 30 minutes.
