Day 1 Travel from Bangkok – Kanchanaburi – Mallika City – Krasae Cave – Death Railway –

JJ Market Kanchanaburi

6 a.m. Depart from Bangkok to Kanchanaburi travel time approx.
2 hours 30 minutes.

8:30 a.m. Arrive at Kanchanaburi Province then take you to walk to see **Mallika City or Mallika** R.E. 124 A.D. is a tourist attraction in a replica of an ancient city. Located at the entrance of Prasat Muang Sing, Sing Subdistrict, Sai Yok District, Kanchanaburi Province, 32 kilometers from Kanchanaburi City. Within the area of 60 rai, it will bring the way of life of the Siamese people. Around the Chao Phraya River basin during the reign of King Rama V to simulate the atmosphere for you to see Areas within Mallika City will have both Thai-style houses, shopping districts, bridges over the water, city towers, and also there are vendors dressed in traditional Thai costumes, giving you a feeling of really going back in time to those days. Here, there is also a service in Thai costumes for us to dress to match the atmosphere.

Have lunch at a restaurant.

In the afternoon

Take you and then take you to **Tham Krasae**. This cave used to be a residence for prisoners of war when building the Death Railway from Thailand to Burma. The cave is adjacent to the Kanchanaburi-Namtok Railway Line. It is a historical railway line during World War 2 that currently ends at Namtok Railway Station inside the cave is airy and enshrined a sacred Buddha image. Looking from the mouth of the cave to the railway area, you will see a beautiful view and overlook the Kwai Noi River below. This area was the hardest point to build a railway due to the curving paths along the hills. After walking to see Krasae cave, we went to take beautiful photos at **the train tracks death railway**. It is



considered the most beautiful point and the most dangerous of the railway lines with a great height and stuck along the cliff, looking down below is a river tributary that flows peacefully.

In the evening

Take you to **the JJ Market Kanchanaburi**. There are good quality products at very cheap prices, whether it's necklaces, rings, watches, clothes, jeans, modern, whether long legs. Dave legs or short legs or food Assorted grilled meatballs, mala is also available, ice and thirst-quenching beverages are also available. Kan people don't know anyone and have never been there. **Have an independent dinner at your own leisure.**



7 p.m. Take you to check-in at Felix River Kwai Resort or equivalent. Invite you to pack your luggage into your room and relax at your leisure.

Day 2 Bridge over the River Kwai - Souvenir shop with young coconut jelly - Wat Tham Suea - Mina Cafe - Bangkok

In the morning **Have breakfast at the hotel restaurant.** After finishing the meal, you can store your luggage for check out from the hotel. Then take you to the Bridge over **the River Kwai**. At present has been improved and repaired by the State Railway of Thailand Replaced the original item that was attacked by Allied soldiers 10 times during the war and became a major tourist attraction of Kanchanaburi. The highlight of visiting here is Walking on the railroad tracks on the bridge over the River Kwai is a distance of 300 meters is a photo point and a viewpoint on the River Kwai. Then take you to buy souvenirs at the souvenir shop **Wimon Young Coconut Jelly**.

At noon **Have lunch at a restaurant.**



In the afternoon Take you to the **Tiger Cave Temple**, a very famous temple in Kanchanaburi including a Buddha image in the posture of giving



blessings The Buddha image is decorated with gold mosaics and is the largest Buddha image in Kanchanaburi. There is also a pagoda that is outstandingly beautiful and can be seen from a distance because it is located on a hill Tourists can come to admire the beauty of Chedi Ket Kaew Prasat in which each floor will be enshrined Many Buddha images and the top floor is the enshrinement of the Buddha's relics brought from India and worshipping Luang Por Chinprathan. Then take you to take photos

and sit and chill at **Meena Cafe** located in Tha Muang District. Kanchanaburi, a chic cafe with a chill atmosphere on the rice field behind Tiger Cave Temple Making it possible to see the view of Wat Tham Suea from the front of

the shop, plus there is a long bridge in the middle of the field for walking and taking in the views. Take photos of cool check-in from various angles. It is another new landmark in Kanchanaburi that should not be missed.



In the evening Then take you from Kanchanaburi back to Bangkok, taking about 2 hours and 30 minutes.
