In the afternoon Take you to **Wat Phra That Nong Waeng**, inside Wat Nong Wang, the old city, which is a royal monastery, has Phra Mahathat Kaen Nakhon or Phra That Nine Floors, with a square base, 50 meters wide on each side. The chedi-shaped top house is a replica of Phra That Kham Kaen, built on the occasion of His Majesty the King. King Paramintharamaha Phum Pol Adulyadej completed 50 years of his reign and 200 years of the Maha Mangkhalanusorn. It is an art in the Dvaravati period that combines Indo-Chinese art, which is the style of the Isan people of Tak Hae.





Take you to **Bueng Kaen Nakhon** is a popular place to relax and do recreational activities because of its comfortable atmosphere. The surrounding area has been renovated to be a health garden, decorated with various sculptures. You can enjoy it. Day 2 Thung Setthi Temple – National Museum - Phra That Kham Kaen - Ton Tan Art Gallery - Ton Tan Market

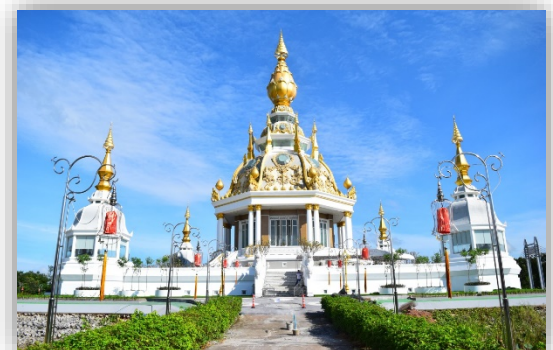
In the afternoon

The top of the rectangular plan, the top end is a golden tiered tier, is a beautiful Lan Xang architecture that is a spiritual anchor and is sacred to the northeastern region.

Day 3: Hong Moon Mang, Mueang Khon Kaen - Wat Pa Thamma Suan - Jay Ratchakhon Shop - Bangkok

In the morning

It conveys the background and the story of Khon Kaen which will reflect people to experience the conditions of life. The lifestyle of Khon Kaen people from the past to the present, Hong Moon Mang. Khon Kaen City is divided into 5 zones, divided according to content in the administrative system, way of life, wisdom, and cultural identity since

prehistoric times. The era of building

houses and transforming the city, and

passing through the prosperous days until now is the city of

Khon Kaen. Bring you to **Wat Pa Thamma Suan**. The temple

emphasizes the practice of dharma and the development of

mindfulness. With Phra Ajarn Samran Thammathuro or Luang

Por Kluay as the founder and a vipassana teacher at Wat Pa

Thammapark, it is a place of meditation with an area of over 70 rai surrounded by large trees

The atmosphere in the temple is shady, calm, and serene. There are many large clumps of trees

making it shady. Sappaya is suitable for practicing dharma, how is it good for meditation? It is

convenient to stay and practice dharma. fasting scattered throughout Inside the temple, besides





having shady nature, there are also Buddha images and other auspicious things to pay respect to.



Travel to **Jay Rat Khon Kaen shop**. A famous souvenir shop in Khon Kaen collects sweets, silk, local products. Items at Jay Rat's shop must be Moo Yo, Isaan sausages, bought as branded products from the shop itself. Everyone can buy souvenirs to bring back to their friends and relatives.

At noon Have lunch at a restaurant. Then take you from Khon Kaen back to Bangkok which takes about 6 hours and 25 minutes.
