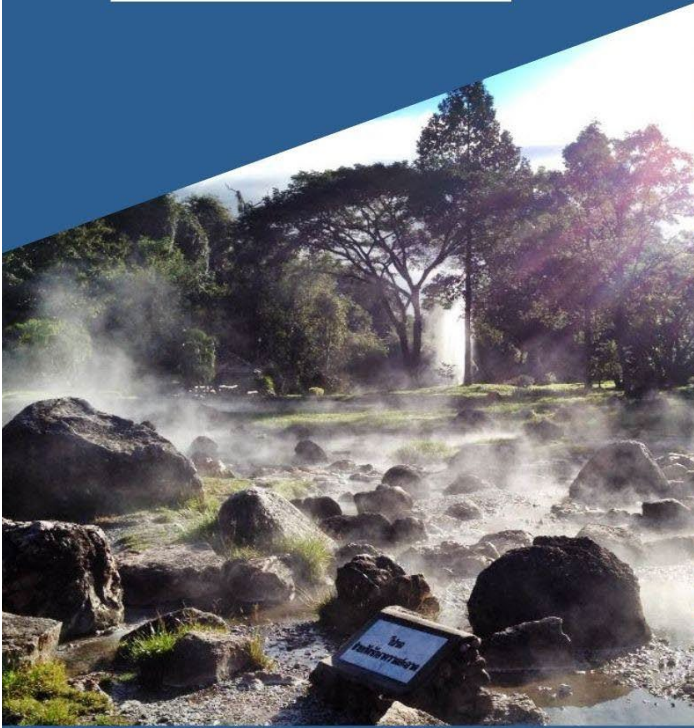

DAY1 Lampang Airport – Phrathat Lampang Luang - Chaloeprakiat

06.00 Assemble at **Don Mueng Airport**

07.20 On the way to **Lampang Airport** by **Nok Air**, flight **PG203**.

08.50 Arrive at Lampang airport, continue to **Phrathat Lampang Luang**, it is a temple located in Lampang Luang Subdistrict, Ko Kha District, Lampang Province. It is a relic of the year of the Ox, which will allow you to pay homage to the blessing and see the wonderful shadow of the relics and the Viharn in the reverse side, making it an important temple that is It enshrines Phra Kaeo Don Tao,



which is highly revered by Lampang people and Buddhists in general. Then continue to travel to **Chaloe Phrakiat Park** to relax and enjoy the atmosphere. Here is a park decorated with beautiful plants to admire the beauty of nature.

12.00 Lunch at Krua Chat Sombun

13.00 Visit the **Dhanabodi Factory and Museum** founded by Mr. Panasin Thanabodeesakul, the second generation descendant of Mr. Yi (Simyu) Qin, the founder of the Thanabodee Sakul family who discovered kaolin and founded Lampang's first ceramic factory, which embodies the legendary chicken bowl of Dhanabadee, the city of ceramics in Thailand Inside shows the history of the origin of ceramic chicken bowls in Lampang and a demonstration of the production of

traditional chicken bowls. Next, take you to the Museum of the Lignite Coal Center, which has a geology exhibition room. The 3D animated cinema offers both an insight into the evolution of the world and a display of fossils of flora and fauna unearthed



at the Mae Moh Mine. There are 4 tusks of elephants and a simulation of the atmosphere in the mine pit with stories about mining and coal production. Mine and Power Plant Exhibition.

Evening Dinner at San Kam Paeng Restaurant

DAY2 Akko Chai Khiri Temple - Chalodem Phrakiat Phra Chom Klao Rachanuson Temple - Chae Son National Park

Morning Breakfast at hotel's dining room

08.30 Go to Chae Hom District, one of 13 districts of Lampang Province. It is in the north of the province and is the third largest district. after Ngao and Thoen districts The distance from Amphoe Mueang is about 52 kilometers by stopping to make merit at **Wat Akko Chai Khiri**. This is an old temple in the city of Chae Hom for hundreds of years, but the history of construction has not been shown. It is clear that the temple is a small temple on the top of a hill in the area of Wichet Nakhon.

Wat Chalodem Phrakiat Phra Chom Klao Rachanuson was formerly known as Wat Phra Phutthabat Pu Pha Daeng. It is a temple famous for its beautiful image of a small white pagoda built on a sky-high mountain surrounded by high mountains created by human faith. It is a picture that attracts many people who want to travel to see the beauty.



12.00 Lunch at Aw Im, Chaehom, Lampang

13.30 Go to see the Chae Son National Park in the area of the park. There is a mineral spring filled with beautiful natural rocks in the midst of hot springs. Mineral water has a high temperature of 70 – 80 degrees Celsius before returning to Mueng Lampang.

DAY3 Lampang Elephant Reservation Center – Thung Kwian Market – Lampang Airport

Morning Breakfast at hotel's dining room

08.30 Watch an elephant show at the **Thai Elephant Conservation Center** at Ban Thung Kwian, Wiang Tan Sub-district is the first and only elephant training center in the world to raise and train young elephants to



obey orders and have Due to the lockdown policy that left the elephants unemployed, the Elephant Training Center has been adapted to care for old and sick elephants, and also houses an elephant hospital and organizes tourism activities. Then, we would go to **Thung Kwian Market** or gad Thung Kwian. In Northern language, Kad means market, located in Hang Chat District. It is a collection of shops selling forest products, wildlife, wild animals, Yae, Lan, etc., and there are also local products such as OTOP products, Lampang ceramics, souvenirs, clothes leisurely.

Noon Lunch at Chat Kaew Resaturant.

13.30 Visit **Wat Phra Kaew Don Tao Suchadaram**, located along the Wang River. In Tambon Wiang Nuea, Amphoe Mueang, Lampang Province, the temple's location is a large high mound. It is an ancient temple and Beautiful, thousands of years old, used to be the place where Phra Phuttha Maha Mani Rattana Patimakorn was enshrined. Then, we would go To Trairak Cemetery, pay homage to Luang Pho Kasem, a famous guru of Lampang.

18.00 Check-in at Lampang airport, Thai Airways Airline.

19.00 On the way to Bangkok, flight number PG208

20.45 Arrive at Don Mueng Airport peacefully.
