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Day 1 Travel from Don Mueang Airport (Bangkok) – Loei Airport – Phu Pha Ngam Park – Phu Pa Po (-/-/-)

07.00 am. All together at the meeting point with staff to welcome and facilitate you with luggage.

10.20 a.m. Depart from Don Mueang Airport (Bangkok) to Loei Province by Thai AirAsia, flight FD 3542 takes approximately 1 hour and 10 minutes.

11.30 a.m. Arrival at the Loei airport and pick up luggage.

At noon Have lunch at a restaurant.

In the afternoon We will take you to Nong Hin District, Loei Province. Take you to the **Stone Garden**, Pha Ngam is a large and majestic limestone cliff. It stretches in a strikingly long line amid the lush green fields. This area is the location of Suan Hin Pha Ngam Mueang Loei, within about 15 km



of an intricate walking path leading to the west along a paved road through villages for about 15 km. There will be signs along the way until the grassland area is wide enough. There are



naturally occurring limestone mountains scattered into small, large, and small children alternately. Some mountains that can be passed through it have a name. Called differently according to their appearance, such as dinosaur rocks, discouraged cliffs, worship arches, Orathai caves, labyrinths, stone pagodas, natural picture

frames, the Great Wall of China, Khong gates, Hin Mongkut, rock gardens, Hell arches, Rurantu (Rutan) with various trees growing together. Find rare and giant plants like cycads that are hundreds of years old, therefore has another name Kunming city Loei. It is assumed

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that in the past. It was the area of the sea before and is over 225 million years old. Then take you to **Phu Pa Po**, located at Ban Pha Wai, Puan Phu Subdistrict, Nong Hin District, Loei Province. The atmosphere on the viewpoint, which is about 900 meters above sea level, can



see Phu Hor looks like a high mountain. A mountain peak or mountain peaks, especially when the sea is covered with mist. Tourists called Similar to Mount Fujiyama in Japan, originally Phu Pa Po was an area in the Phu Kho-Phu Kratae National Forest Reserve. And Phu Kho-Phu Kratae wildlife sanctuary has been encroached and cleared for

agriculture until the forest condition in that area is in the deteriorating stage but after the village headman was selected, the forest was restored to become fertile until it has become a tourist attraction that has become more well known, especially the mountain that is similar to Mount Fuji. There are 3 viewpoints of Phu Pa Poe, each of which is about 200 meters apart, descending according to height. The first point is the most beautiful viewpoint. Nothing is blocking the eyes; one can see the view of Mount Fuji as close as possible at the angle that is most similar to Mount Fuji. At this point, there is a balcony extending for allowing tourists to

stand and admire the view of Phu Hor up close. As for the second point, you will see a panoramic view of Phu Ho that is different from the first point. At this point, there is a balcony to view as well. As for the last point, we have to walk up the hill for about 200 meters. It is the highest point we can see a 360-degree view, but there may be some trees and grass that



cover our eyes. The highest point can watch the sunrise and sunset at the same point. You can also see Phu Pha Man National Park Phu Pha Man District, Khon Kaen Province Nam Nao National Park, Lom Sak District, Phetchabun Province Na Yung Nam Som National Park, Nam Som District, Udon Thani Province, and Erawan Cave, Na Wang District, Nong Bua Lamphu Province Go up one mountain and see 4 provinces.

In the evening Have dinner at the restaurant.

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7 p.m. Take you to check in at **The White House Chiangkhan Villa or equivalent**, invite you to store your luggage and relax.

Day 2 Phu Thok - Skywalk - Wat Phra Phutthabat Phu Kwai Ngein - Kaeng Khut Khu - Wat Si Khun Mueang - Chiang Khan Walking Street (-/-/-)

In the morning Have breakfast at the hotel restaurant.

After having breakfast, you will be taken to **Phu Thok**, the famous sea mist viewpoint and popular with tourists who come to Chiang Khan. It looks like a high mountain located on the Mekong River. On the top of the mountain is the location of the Chiang Khan telecommunication station and is a viewpoint of the beautiful scenery of Chiang Khan





District and the Mekong River around. It is located on the same road as Kaeng Khut Khu is far from Chiang Khan District, about 3 kilometers. If anyone who has visited Chiang Khan should not miss seeing the sea of mist

in the morning here. In addition, Phu Thok has a viewpoint. See the beauty of the Mekong River, Sanakham City, and Kaeng Khut Khu. As for the sea of fog, it may or may not be seen at all depending on the weather conditions of the day. Then take you to Skywalk Chiang Khan or





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Skywalk Phuket is over 80 meters above the Mekong River level, or equivalent to a 30-story building. There is a walkway made of clear glass that is over 100 meters long and 2 meters wide, which is the most thrilling and exciting spot. It is also a place where tourists can walk and enjoy the view. On the skywalk will be able to see the Hue River. The river

that borders the Thai border beautifully by the image that we see. It will be a picture of the two rivers with clear contrasting colors. Located in the middle between the high mountains on both sides of Chiang Khan and the Lao PDR side, the upper part of the Skywalk Chiang Khan is still enshrined. Big Buddha Phu Khong Ngeo as well, which is a Buddha image in the posture of giving blessings. Cast with fiber mixed with gold resin, height over 19 meters. It is another symbol of this new landmark as well. The walkway of Skywalk Chiang Khan is a special type of transparent glass with steel grating support specially designed to have stability, safety, and tightness up here. The reason why this place was built was to become a beautiful viewpoint. That one must want to come check-in.

At noon Have lunch at a restaurant.

Phu Kwai Ngein is enshrined the long footprint of the Buddha on the sharpening stone that both locals and tourists pay their respects and there is also a belief that. Only those who have merit will be able to come up and pay homage to this Buddha's footprint because, in the past, the path to come up to the temple was very difficult but nowadays the journey to the temple. It's much more comfortable. The history of Wat Phra Phutthabat Phu Kwai Ngern has stated that Wat Phra Phutthabat Phu Kwai Ngern was built in 2300 B.E. It is one of the oldest



temples in Chiang Khan ever. This is a temple located on a hill that is 400 meters above sea level. There is also a story about the history of the temple. In the past, this was an abandoned temple but are always monks who travel a lot. And in the temple area, there is still a footprint of the Buddha under a large brick arch. The size is enough for 2 people to sit in, which in the



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
local language will call buildings like this "Um Mung". Later it became the name of the village to the east of the temple, Ban Umang. There is a farmer who often brings buffalo up to eat grass in the mountains near the temple. And when the monks pass by, farmers will regularly bring food to offer to

the monks. This is believed to be the merit of this offering This allows farmers to farm and sell rice for a lot of money every year. Until rich to a millionaire and with the gratitude of the buffalo who tirelessly plows the fields. The farmer called this buffalo "silver buffalo". Therefore, this temple was named "Wat Phra Phutthabat Phu Kwai Ngein" according to this story for this mountain The villagers call it "Phu Kwai Ngein" in honor of the buffalo, which

is the power of the farmers to succeed in rice planting each year. Then take you to see the view at Kaeng Khut Khu, another famous tourist attraction of Chiang Khan. Kaeng Khut Khu is a large rapid in the middle of the Mekong River. When the Mekong River dries up with the creation of a balcony and a gazebo can stand and admire the view of the rapids. And the Mekong



River flowing through the area of Kaeng Khut Khu a wide sandy beach saw hundreds of thousands of shiny round stones lined up. The atmosphere is very good, the wind is cool. You can walk down to feel the atmosphere of the Mekong River closely. The area around Kaeng Khut Khu has been converted into a small park that is quite wide with buildings that add color to Kaeng Khut Khu, including old wooden screens. A large archer statue next to the Kaeng Khut Khu sign. A balcony overlooking the Mekong River if visiting Kaeng Khut Khu



weather, you can also see some mist mingling with the sunlight that covers the Mekong River. The backdrop is a view of the mountains that are as beautiful as a painting. During the flood season, rapids in the Mekong River cannot be seen because the water is completely flooded. Around June-November, during the dry season, the water level in

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the Mekong River will drop to the extent that small and large rocks and sandy beaches have previously sunk. Under the Mekong River emerges to show off its beauty for tourists to admire around December – May. This time is considered the most suitable time to visit. This time is





considered the most suitable time to visit. and the belly part towards the head of the serpent has a hole for water to flow down This hung hod is only used for bathing ceremonies for the elders or city lords, which is rare nowadays.

Then take you Chiang Khan Walking Street. The

colors of visiting Chiang Khan start from the evening until dusk. It is a long walkway that runs through old wooden houses. On both sides of the road, there are shops selling food and local products. and various souvenirs along the way Chiang Khan Walking Street Located on

the lower Si Chiang Khan Road near the Mekong River. Starting from Wat Tha Krok to Wat Si Khun Mueang They are open daily from 17:00 – 22:00. In addition to walking around to find food to fill the stomach. In the evening, you can still walk along the Mekong Road. To see the atmosphere of the sunset in the evening beautifully. Come to Chiang Khan Walking Street. Don't forget to stop and take photos of the old brick walls of this house. Located on the corner of Si Chiang Khan 14 Road, called the wooden house at Chai Khong. An old house with a unique beauty that is different from other old







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houses in Chiang Khan. But this house is a two-story building. The top layer is the polished bamboo cover that is plastered with clay or lime on both sides. The bottom part is a brick wall holding mortar. In front of the house is a wooden framed door. It is an old house in Chiang Khan that remains the same. It hasn't been renovated to spoil the structure much. clothing store cotton native products Various souvenirs on Walking Street are available in many shops. There are many different types of food. Most of which is local food. There are many shops that you can see, such as shredded shrimp, white shrimp, squid, crab, cherry clams, skewers, appetizers that have become memories of Chiang Khan. Dip with seafood sauce most of which are made with a little sweetness.

Have an independent dinner at Chiang Khan Walking Street.

Day Three: Wat Mahathat - Cafe de River - Mueang Loei OTOP - Don Mueang Airport (Bangkok)

In the morning Have breakfast at the hotel restaurant. After finishing breakfast

Allow you to store your luggage to check out from the hotel. Then take you to Wat

Mahathat, which is regarded as another interesting and important tourist spot of Chiang Khan. It is beautiful and is a tourist destination that has been very popular ever among tourists who visit Chiang Khan. Because this tourist attraction is like a symbol of Chiang Khan, the old temple of Wat Mahathat has a long history.



In the past, it was not a temple at all, but it was Chiang Khan City Hall. It was built in the year 1654. It was used as a command base for the administration and military of the Siamese government in the past. And it is considered an important stronghold in many disputes with France ever. Makes an aura of blending of both Thai, Laotian and French art before being



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converted to a temple that is very beautiful in terms of fine arts inside of Wat Mahathat. That is very beautiful, both from the beautiful temple and there. Wooden Buddha statue in Lan Xang art and the Buddha image in the attitude of subduing Mara That is old and very beautiful as ever. Until it has been registered as a national treasure. In addition, the wall paintings are very beautiful and are the target of photographers who visit Chiang Khan. As for the old chedi within this temple, it is no less interesting. And is very old as well but more interesting is probably the bathroom. Inside the

temple that has been influenced by the French in creating it until it's very beautiful. It's quite strange. Take you to **Cafe de River**. The cafe is located close to the Mekong River. There are both indoor and outdoor seating areas. You can choose to sit as you like. There are many photo spots. Either a flower arch chair, a bird's nest chair, or a skywalk that stretches across the





garden. It's beautiful and cute in another way.

There are many menus to choose from both Thai food menu Local cuisine, a la carte, pizza, as well as a wide selection of delicious desserts and beverages. The bottom of the cafe. There is also a sky walkway, a chilling seat hanging legs overlooking the Mekong River. And beautiful flower fields as well. Whoever comes during the

winter, in the morning can also see the mist on the water surface. Looking at the opposite side is Chanakham City, Laos, with good views, a good atmosphere, and a beautiful mood.

At noon Have lunch at a restaurant.

In the afternoon Take you on a trip to buy souvenirs at Mueang Loei OTOP is the center of the community and local products of Loei Province. And nearby regions There are many types of OTOP products in the shop, such as clothing type, user type, beverage type, food type, etc., and take you to the airport.







4:25 p.m. Take you out of the airport Return to Don Mueang Airport (Bangkok) by Nok Air, flight DD 377, traveling time is approximately 55 minutes.
