On the way to Lopburi by air-conditioned VIP van.

Upon arriving in Lop Buri, the first place we will go to is the Phra Kan Shrine for everyone to pay

respects to the sacred things of Lop Buri, which is another interesting tourist spot in Lop Buri. Inside is enshrined Chao Pho Phra Kan. It is assumed that it is a standing image of Lord Narai built with 2 laterite bodies. The smaller one is an old idol in Thailand. The big Buddha statue is a Lopburi



style sculpture, but the original head is missing. Later, the head of the Ayutthaya-era sandstone Buddha image was put on. The area around the Phra Kan Shrine is covered with large shady trees that are home to many monkeys and become symbols of the province and when people bring food and fruit to vow. Those monkeys will come to eat. Later, it has become a habit of monkeys and familiarity with villagers and tourists by default that when they come to the shrine, they have to feed the monkeys.

O9.00 Phra Prang Sam Yod, an important landmark of
Lopburi, is an archaeological site. and one of the
important historical and archaeological sites of
Lopburi It is a Khmer castle in the Bayon style. It is a
laterite castle in Khmer style, connected by 3 pieces

connected by a porch. Within the area, besides



these three castles, on the east side of the main castle, there is an addition of a brick and mortar sanctuary connected to the main castle to enshrine a Buddha image during the reign of King Narai the Great. We can also feed a herd of macaques that are roaming around the pagoda, which these monkeys are not unruly because they are familiar with tourists as well.

Visit Phra Narai Ratchaniwet or the National Museum of King Narai is a palace that King Narai the Great had built in 1666 on an area of 41 rai in Lop Buri to be used as a hunting ground for government officials and welcoming visitors to the city. Inside, there is the King Narai National

Museum, which currently exhibits more than 1,864 artefacts in various buildings and palaces within the museum.







Lunch at Kaprao & Coffee, located at the entrance of Khao Chin Lae. which is the famous sunflower field of Lopburi. It is a popular restaurant that stands out because the atmosphere behind the shop has a very good view. The restaurant is brick orange with wooden bridges stretching among the

fields of yellow starbursts and cosmos flowers against the bright blue sky which is the most beautiful in winter. In other seasons, there may be flowers, but not a lot, with beautiful shaped limestone mountains in the background. The shop has 2 seating zones, an air-conditioned room



and a view behind the shop overlooking the flower fields and Khao Chin Lae.

Continue your journey to Khao Phraya Dern Thong, not far from Pa Sak Cholasit Dam, is a quiet monastery at Wat Nong Na and is home to many Buddha images for tourists to pay their respects and watch the sea mist in the morning unseen in Lop Buri. From the viewpoint, you can clearly see the Pa Sak Chonlasith Dam and the floating railway.

Take a tram, ride a bike, and enjoy the view around the dam. Relax and experience the natural atmosphere and fresh air at Pa Sak Chonlasith Dam. It is the longest clay dam in the country. It covers the area of 2 provinces, which is Lop Buri and Saraburi. Around the dam, there will be a garden in honor of King Rama IX at the edge of the reservoir. This point will be a popular spot for tourists to relax and admire the nature, watch the sunset, fish, and sit and watch the reservoir. There is a museum of Pa Sak Dam and a tram ride around the dam area.
