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**Day 1 Don Mueang International Airport - Chiangmai International Airport - Pai - Tha Pai Memorial Bridge – Phra That Mae Yen – Pai Walking Street**

**07.00** Depart from **Don Mueang International Airport** to Chiangmai International Airport by AirAsia, flight FD 3437. The flight would take around 1 hour 15 minutes.

**08.15** Arrive at **Chiangmai International Airport**. Then take you to **Pai District**, Mae Hong Son would take about 3 hours.

**Noon** **Lunch at the restaurant.**

**Afternoon** Arrive at **Mae Hong Son**. Take you to **Tha Pai Memorial Bridge**. It is a landmark that should not be missed when visiting Pai. It's a nice walking spot. It is also a tourist attraction that has a history during World War II. This point used to be where the Japanese army transported food and equipment to Burma. Today, it is a place for walking, chilling, taking photos. Enjoy the view of the Pai River. It is another charm of Pai that must be experienced.



After that, take you to **Phra That Mae Yen**. Arrive at Pai, you must not miss paying respects to the city's sacred pagoda at Wat Phra That Mae Yen. This is a beautiful temple located on a hill, not far from Pai town. The highlight of this place is walking up to pay homage to the white Buddha Lokutta Maha Muni. If you count the number of steps, it can

make you feel discouraged. But if you go up and see the view from the top, you will recover from exhaustion! Moreover, this place is also a beautiful 360-degree viewpoint.



**Evening** **Dinner at the restaurant.** After that, check In at Ai Pai Hotel.

**19.00** Take you to take a walk at **Pai Walking Street**. It is another tourist attraction of Pai that should not be missed. The inside will be closed to traffic, making both sides of the road full of various shops: restaurants, coffee shops, and local food in the form of street food. We will be able to shop in many shops along the way. It can be called a hip and chill place for many tourists.



**20.00** Go back to the hotel.

**Day 2** Yun Lai Viewpoint - Nam Hoo Temple - Doi Kiew Lom View Point, Pai - Pang Mapha – Dekdoi Coffee at Jabo – Long Neck Village - Ban Huai Suea Tao – Kam Ko Temple - Phra that doi kong mu Temple – Before Sunset Coffee Shop- Chong Klang-Chong Kham Temple

**Morning**                      **Breakfast at hotel’s dining room.**

Take you to [Yun Lai Viewpoint](#). It is a viewpoint that should not miss when visiting Pai. Anyone who wants to see the sea of mist must come here. The peak of here is the picture of the sea of mist and beautiful yellow lotus flowers in winter. It's impressive.



On the way to [Nam Hoo Temple](#). It is one of the oldest temples in Pai. There is Luang Por Un Muang, a sacred Buddha image that is worshiped by the people. Luang Pho Unmuang has a special feature that water seeps from the head of

the Buddha statue all the time. The villagers call it Nam Ok Ru or Nam Hu. In addition, within the temple, there is a golden chedi called Suphankanlaya Chedi, which contains the ashes of Phra Suphankanlaya. Take you up to see the beauty of the mountains and get a cool breeze at [Doi Kiew Lom Viewpoint, Pai Pang Mapha](#). The recommended point is the Doi Kiew Lom repeater station, which is higher than the viewpoint. From above, we can see the scenery of the intricate mountains and experience cool weather. There are also points to taking beautiful photos.



**Noon**                      **Lunch at the restaurant.**

**Afternoon**            Take you to [Dekdoi Coffee at Jabo](#), a small coffee shop with baristas that were born and grew up at Ban Jabo. The atmosphere can't be found anywhere. Sip coffee and watch the sea of mist. It is a shop for people who want to find a good atmosphere, good coffee, and drinks at reasonable prices. After that, take you to [Long Neck Village - Ban Huai Suea Tao](#). It is a long neck village closest to the city and is an ethnic minority who lives in Burma. In the old days, there was a great conflict



between the Karen Army and the Burmese military government so that long neck people migrated to live along the border, and some came to live in Mae Hong Son. Long neck villages are in many areas. The long neck village is transformed by society into a business style. It was not the nature of the community and the traditional way of life as before. However, long neck

village is still the highlight of Mae Hong Son tourism with Thai and foreign tourists. Then go to [Kam Ko Temple](#). It is an old temple in the city of Mae Hong Son. There is a beautiful architecture that is not less than other temples. Especially the feature that there is a roof covering the walkway from the entrance arch to

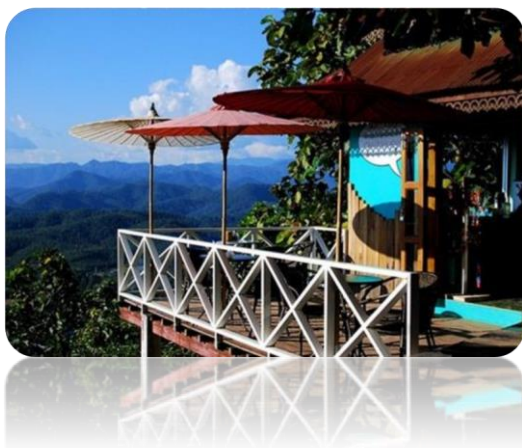


the pavilion "Wat Kam Kao" (Thai meaning "Bunnak flower"). It was built on January 22, 1890, by the first abbot of the temple called "Kruba Tao", a Shan people who immigrated from Chiang Thong. The general villagers called him "Tu Chao Jiang Tong" (pronounced in the local language) refers to the monks who came from Chiang Khong.

**Evening** Arrive at [Phra that doi kong mu Temple](#). It is an invaluable temple of Mae Hong Son Province. Even though it's not in Pai, but it's not far away, so tourists who visit Pai will have to visit Wat Phra That Doi Kong Mu as well. An important archaeological site is Phra That Doi Kong Mu, which was built with Burmese art. There are 2 Phra That Chedi: the large Phra That Chedi and a small Phra That Chedi.



After that, take you to [Before Sunset Coffee Shop](#). It is located behind Wat Phra That Doi Kong Mu beyond the souvenir zone at the parking area. There is street art for you to check-in. This restaurant is popular with tourists in the evening because you can watch the sunset and the beautiful evening light. You will see the view of the mountains and some fog in the back.



Then take you to [Chong Klang-Chong Kham Temple](#). It is like a twin temple because it is located on the same wall. Wat Chong Kham is on the left-hand side, and Wat Chong Klang is on the right. Wat Chong Kham and Wat Chong Klang are located in the center of Mae Hong Son. They are cultural symbols of this Shan city because, besides their artistic beauty, they are also the centers of cultural activities and the traditions of the people of Mae Hong Son. The area in front of the temple is Nong Chong Kham Public Park, which is also allowed to use as a venue for various traditional ceremonies throughout the year.



**19.00** Dinner at the restaurant.

**20.00** Go back to the Ai Pai Hotel.

**Day 3** Pang Oung - Lee Wine Ban Ruk Thai - Su Tong Pae Bridge - Coffee in Love - Pai Canyon - Chiang Mai - Mae Taeng Pine Garden – Mueang Chiang Mai

**Morning** Breakfast at hotel's dining room. Pack your bags to check out from the hotel. Then take you to Pang Oung, it would take around 3 hours.

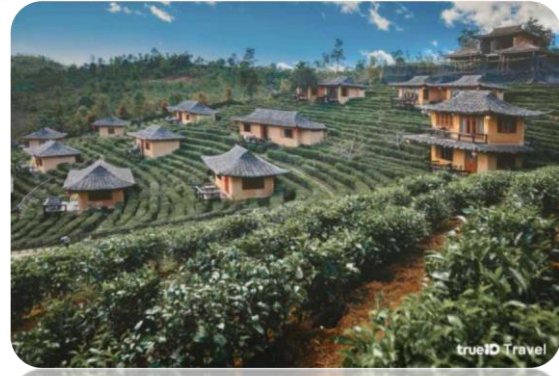
**11.00** Arrive at [Pang Oung](#) or the full name of the "Pangtong Royal Initiative Project 2". It is a large reservoir on a high mountain peak. Along the reservoir are pine trees that are planted lined up. In the winter morning, you might find a beautiful sight of the mist floating over the lake and the cold weather that makes Pang Ung a romantic attraction of Mae Hong Son. The sunrise reflects the water through the pine trees and the thin mist is an unforgettable sight



**Noon** Lunch at the restaurant.

**Afternoon** Take you to see [Lee Wine Ban Ruk Thai](#) or Ban Rak Thai. It is another tourist attraction that is not in Pai District, but it's not long about 1.30 hours. It is another highlight of visiting Mae Hong Son. If you traveled to Pai, this is another point that you must not miss. Ban Rak Thai is a Yunnan Chinese village with beautiful views like being in a foreign country. There is also a clay house located in a tea plantation and a small lake to chill, walk and take beautiful photos.





Then take you to [Coffee in Love](#). It is located on the hillside of Pai District. It is a very cute coffee shop that anyone who comes to Pai should visit. The shop has a wide area that cars can be parked comfortably. There are points to taking photos.



After that, take you to [Pai Canyon](#). This is caused by the miracle of nature from the collapse of soil and erosion by wind and rain to form deep basins and cliffs. It is similar to the Grand Canyon, which is why it is called Pai Canyon or what the villagers call Kong Lan. Anyone who likes a landscape like this is guaranteed to have fun taking pictures. It is also a beautiful sunset viewing point.



**Evening** Arrive at [Chiang Mai](#). Take you to [Mae Taeng Pine Garden](#). It is suitable for anyone looking for a place to shoot a pre-wedding photo or take photos for fun. The winter is more beautiful. The Mae Taeng pine garden is usually just a passage between Mae Taeng – Mae Rim. Although it is next to the main road, few people know and come to take photos. Mae Taeng Pine Garden is a research for the development and restoration of an experimental planting of Caribbean pine. It also produces the seeds of the Caribbean pine. This place started in 1977 with an area of 27 rai. It is the work of the Forest Research and Development Office, the Royal Forest Department. The research has continued to improve. Every year, it is possible to maintain and restore the Caribbean pine as quickly as the goal.



**19.00** **Dinner at the restaurant.**

**20.00** Check in at the Darley hotel.

**Day 4** Mon Jam, Chiang Mai– Pang Hwa Flower Garden - Pongyang Jungle Coaster & Zipline-  
Souvenir shop - Chiangmai International Airport - Don Mueang International Airport

**Morning** Breakfast at hotel's dining room. Pack your bags to check out from the hotel. Then take you to [Doi Mon Jam](#). It is located in Nong Hoi Royal Project Development Center, Mae Ram Subdistrict, Mae Rim District, Chiang Mai Province. Anyone who has a car can bring it to the park and walk to breathe the air. The area on Doi Mon Chaem is not very large. You can walk and feel the surrounding scenery, then sip coffee, share the experience with cool weather.



After that, take you to see [Pang Hwa Flower Garden](#). In the winter, purple Margaret flowers will bloom. There is a great view of the surrounding mountains. Besides the flower garden, there is also an orange orchard with bamboo walkways around the garden. Traveling here has taken pictures of the flower garden and orange orchard. Pang Hua Flower Garden is close to Orange Yod Doi Garden and my garden. The area around the garden is a view of the mountains, so taking pictures of flowers will also get a view of the mountains in the background.



Take you to [Pongyang Jungle Coaster & Zipline](#). It is located in Mae Rim District, Chiang Mai Province, in the Mon Chaem zone. No matter which resort you stay at, you will pass the road here. The surrounding area is forest and hills. In winter, the atmosphere is very good. There are 5 rides, which can be purchased as a combination of tickets or can be played separately according to your preferences. There is also a cafe and beautiful resorts to serve.



Then take you to [Souvenir shop](#). There is a wide selection of souvenirs from Chiang Mai, both food and things, which all show the uniqueness of the North. Many people like to buy souvenirs back to give to their family or close friends. The famous souvenirs of the northern include Sai Oua, Nam Prik, Kham Moo, Moo Yo, Naem, snacks that can only sell in the north, and souvenirs are also available for purchase.



**Noon** Lunch at the restaurant.

**Afternoon** Take you to Chiangmai International Airport to check-in at the counter of AirAsia to return to Bangkok

**15.40** Depart from **Chiangmai International Airport** to **Don Mueang International Airport** by AirAsia, flight FD 3434. The flight would take around 1 hour 15 minutes.

**16.45** Arrive at Bangkok safely.
