

# Maha Sarakham

**Day 1: Bangkok - Maha Sarakham - Phra Borommathat Na Dun - Ku Santarat - Kae Dam Mai Bridge - Nong Hu Ling Temple - Kaeng Loeng Chan (-/-/-)**

**05.00** Depart from Bangkok to Maha Sarakham It takes around 5-6 hours of travel time.

**11.00** Arrive at [Maha Sarakham](#), take you on a journey to pay respect to the Buddha image. [Phra That Na Dun](#) is located in Ban Na Dun, Phra That Subdistrict, Na Dun District, Maha Sarakham Province. It has an important place in Buddhism. It is worthy of Maha Sarakham because it is considered a sanctuary built for



the prosperity of the Isan region, known as the Isan Phutthamonthon. around the relics will be decorated with an arboretum and planted with trees from various Buddhist histories, including Phra That Na Dun There has also been excavated historical evidence of various archeology in the past as well. This area used to be the location of Champasri before. Various antiquities found were displayed at Khon Kaen National Museum, including The stupa containing the



Buddha's relics is contained in gold, silver, and bronze caskets, presumably in the Dvaravati period. In the 13th–15th Buddhist century, the relics of Na Dun were replicated from a bronze stupa containing the Buddha's relics. The base is in Dvaravati art style. It has a height of 50 meters from the base to the top, decorated with lotus wire patterns, various lotus pillars, and replicas of various printers. From the excavation, 32 relics are

enshrined together, and there are more than 40 bas-reliefs decorated at the base. The relics are divided into 16 floors beautifully.

Noon **Lunch at the restaurant**

**Afternoon** Take you to **Ku Santarat**, located in Ku Santarat Subdistrict, Na Dun District, Maha Sarakham Province. built with laterite It is a traditional Khmer art. It is believed that it was built



during the reign of Jayavarman VII (1700-1750 AD). Prasat Prangprathan has a square shape. Facing east is a characteristic of the disease drug court. (It is an ancient hospital used for resting the sick and performing religious ceremonies). lintels and castle pillars made of sandstone but not carved,

surrounded by laterite walls. On the northeast side of the castle, there is a large pond called "Balai", 10 meters wide and 12 meters long, which has been rather intact and beautiful until now. Then take you to a photo stop at **Kae Dam wooden bridge**, one of the beautiful old bridges of the Northeast. This is an old wooden bridge in the middle of the rice field atmosphere. It is a path across the Nong Kae Dam Reservoir and has a length of almost 1 kilometer. Connecting Ban Hua Kua and the surrounding villages The wooden bridge has lotus ponds and various green aquatic plants. It is



another beautiful place to take photos. You must not miss check-in at



all. Then take you to [Wat Nong Hu Ling](#), an old temple built in the year 1933. It is a beautiful temple, and outstanding is Ubosot in the shape of an Ananta Nakarat boat Designed by the abbot Phra Kru Bowonthammaprakun, which has a different shape from the chapel of other temples in Maha Sarakham, which is a boat-shaped chapel, meaning a merit



boat. Within the temple, there are riddles hidden in various corners of the church, for example, the way up and down the chapel has 4 directions, meaning the 4 Noble Truths. The main Buddha image is enshrined in the Ubosot as the first sermon so that

those who enter the chapel It's like having come to listen to the Dharma teachings from the Buddha itself. Then take you to relax and watch the sunset at [Kaeng Loeng Chan](#) located west of Maha Sarakham City. You can travel to Kaeng



Loeng Chan Subdistrict,

Mueang District, Maha Sarakham, where you can visit the evening atmosphere all year round. Kaeng Loeng Chan is the largest reservoir adjacent to Maha Sarakham Municipality.

Adjacent to the bypass road at the intersection of Kosum Phisai District and Borabue District Intersection, around the

reservoir ridge, is made into a beautiful public park. There is a flower garden, an artificial waterfall, and a vacation pavilion. In winter, there is a large flower bed. Tourists can explore the garden while watching the sunset at Kaeng Loeng Chan at the same time.



**Evening**      **Dinner at the restaurant**

**19.00** Take you to Check-In and stay at S-Tawan Hotel & Convention or similar. Invite you to store your luggage and check in to your room and relax at your leisure.

**Day 2 : Wat Pa Wang Nam Yen – Kosampe Forest Park – Suwannawat Temple – Yuen Mongkol Buddha Statue – Arte'cafe**

**Morning** Have breakfast at the hotel restaurant. After the meal, take you to [Wat Pa Wang](#)

[Nam Yen](#) or Wat Phuttawanaram, Wat Dang Maha Sarakham, located in Mueang Maha Sarakham District, was built by Phra Ajahn Suriyan Kosapanyo, a famous monk, a student of Luang Pu Khamphan Kosapanyo to be the center of the mind. among Buddhists The outstanding attraction of Wat Pa Wang Nam Yen is Chedi Sri Maha Sarakham. The magnificent golden pagoda Moreover, within the temple, it is also enshrined. Buddha statue



made of pure gold, 3 bodies, including a wooden salutation pavilion, The largest in Thailand as well. Then take you to [Kosamphi National Park](#), another natural attraction in Maha Sarakham It is a small forest that is home to more than 800 macaques, which

tourists like to feed the monkeys. There is also a nature study path. where we can walk or cycle around. It is a recreation place for villagers and also has Kaeng Tad, the most important Songkran watering point in the Northeast as well.



**Noon** Lunch at the restaurant

**Afternoon** take you on a journey to [Wat Suwannawat](#), an important measure of Kantharawichai District, Maha Sarakham this is where the Ming Muang Buddha image is



enshrined. The ancient standing Buddha image was made of red sandstone and is assumed to have been built since the Dvaravati period. In addition, within the temple, there is a Sim or an old ubosot that is full of beauty and interest. It was regarded as one of the best shows of the craftsmanship of the former Isan artisans.

Then they will take you to the [Yuen Mongkhon Buddha Image](#). It is a Buddha image from the Dvaravati period, built with red sandstone and enshrined in Wat Phuttha Mongkhon. The two Buddha images are Phra Phuttha Ming Muang. Wat Suwannawat and the Yuen Mongkhon Buddha Image, Wat Phutthamongkol, were built at the same time. When the Kantharawichai district rains and droughts and located approximately 1 kilometer apart according to legend Man builds Ming Muang Buddha image A woman builds an auspicious standing Buddha image. They finished together and made a grand celebration. It appears that since the two Buddha images were built, it has rained according to the seasons.

**Evening** Take you to [the Night Bazaar Market, Maha Sarakham](#), a walking market, fashion, clothing, food.

**Have dinner at your own leisure.**



**19.00** It's time to take you back to your hotel. Free to invite you to relax at your leisure.

**Day3 : Jet Noi Souvenir Shop Bus Station Maha Sarakham – Ku Mahathat Prang Ku Ban Khwao – Bangkok (-/-/-)**

**Morning** **Have breakfast at the hotel restaurant** .After food, you can store your luggage for check out from the hotel, then take you to buy souvenirs at [Jet Noi Souvenir Shop Maha Sarakham Bus Terminal](#)



**Noon** **Lunch at the restaurant**

**Afternoon** Take you to [Ku Mahathat Prang Ku Ban Khwao](#) is located in Ban Khwao,



Muang District, Maha Sarakham Province. It is an archaeological site that dates around the 18th century, built as a medicinal court. In the reign of Jayavarman VII, it was a Bayon-style Khmer art, made of laterite, in the shape of a square tent, which is 4 wa from the ground to the top, 2 wa in width, 2 cubits in height.

**14.30** Take you from Maha Sarakham to Bangkok which takes around 5-6 hours.

**19.30** Arrival in Bangkok by safety...
