Day 1 Suvarnabhumi Airport - Nakhon Si Thammarat Province - Wat Yang Yai

- Wat Chedi (Ai Khai) - Nang Talung Folk Museum - Na Phra That Market (/_/_)

8:30 a.m. Traveling from Suvarnabhumi Airport to Nakhon Si Thammarat Province by Thai VietJet Air, flight VZ 370, traveling time is 1 hour 30 minutes.

10 a.m. Arrive at **Nakhon Si Thammarat province**, take you to **Wat Yang Yai** or Wat Chompoo, located in Tambon. Tha Sala, Nakhon Si Thammarat Province is an old abandoned temple in ancient times. The villagers in rubber plantations dug up and found a piece of Buddha image, Luang Por Phra Prathan, so Luang Por Wat Yang Yai was restored, and with the fame of the hunter Boon, it was restored. Another temple until it is a beautiful temple as in the present. The highlight of this temple is "Ta Pran Bun", a sacred thing that



the people of the southern people believe to be the culmination of all hunters who worship and have good fortune and money for most of the people. The popular request is safety, fortune, to have food to eat, to use the history of the hunter's merit of Wat Yang Yai, "Pan Boon Mask" or "Manorah Mask". Naphran is considered a clown in the band Manora, who creates laughter in the audience. Because the humorous performances and dances communicate closely with the audience, making it a favorite character of audiences of all ages. Unsurprisingly, the mask is carved out of wood, with a long protruding nose and black eyes that will be pierced. The face is red or gold

and other colors. There are white teeth decorated with gold on top and decorated with duck feathers. I believe that the hunter is a very strong magician who can survive in the forest with but the danger from various beasts and mystical, which Huntsman is considered



the greatest and unparalleled. According to legend, that hunter Boon is a hunter with good skills who can travel in the Himmaman forest. Once, Hunter has helped. The life of the serpent named Thao Chompoochit was saved from death with the ability to have Thao Chomphuchit. Therefore, returned by taking the hunter Boon to the Naga Phipop for 7 days and then gave the magic glass to be ready to make a promise. The hunter Boon that if in the future, if you want anything, you can come and ask for anything. Over time, the hunter has shown his ability to become evident again by capturing the seven daughters of Thao Tumrat and Mrs. Manora, the youngest daughter, to offer to the Sunthorn with Nagas borrowed from Thao Chompoochit. Which is a magical amulet of the serpent that uses to catch Nang Kinon makes people respect the great abilities of the hunter Boon. And also stand out in fortune and wealth. Then take you on the way to **Wat Chedi (Ai Khai)**, located at Chalong Subdistrict, Sichon District, Nakhon Si Thammarat Province. In the past, it used to be an abandoned temple. Legend has it that it has been built for more than a thousand years, leaving only an ancient chedi in the area of the present church until about a year ago. In 1957, Wat Chedi was renovated, causing more monks to stay at the temple and enshrine the old Buddha image that had been there since it was an abandoned temple. But what makes this temple so well known is that Ai Khai Wat Chedi or Ta Khai Wat Chedi is a wooden carved figure of a 10-year-old boy that sits in the Chedi Temple pavilion. Became worshiped by villagers from the area near

the temple to the provinces in the southern region, no matter how many people come to pray, especially in terms of fortune and trading, there are many stories



about the egg legend. Even though Ai Khai is the spirit of a child who followed Luang Pho Thuat. When Luang Por Thuat came to this abandoned temple and let this spirit guard and protect. The property of the land within the temple while some legends said that Ai Khai was a child who used to run and play in the

temple a long time ago. Later that child had an accident and died in the water.

The child's spirit was attached to the temple, so he stayed at this temple since

then. But what makes Ai Khai famous is the incident of a ranger company that

came to set up a temporary base of operations at Wat Chedi. The first night that

the whole squad didn't sleep at all. Because of the children playing and pulling

their arms. Pulling my legs all night. In the morning, so I brought this story to

the villagers. So, the villagers told the story of Ai Khai to them and told this

group of soldiers to pay homage to the stars and bring food to offer to Ai Khai

as well. After that, everything was calm,

nothing disturbed the rangers, so he told the

story to the outsiders, so the egg's

reputation became known even more.



At noon

Have lunch at restaurant.

In the afternoon Take you to check-in and stay at the Hop Inn Hotel. Invite you to store your luggage and enter your room after luggage storage. Then take



you to **the shadow puppet museum** at 10/18

culture, including the shadow puppet making

that is accepted at both national and international levels, as well as maintaining a Thai identity. It is to preserve Thai culture by being selected as a local artist who has received an award for being the best in the tourism industry. (Thailand Tourism Award) of the year 1996, an outstanding award in the category of culture and ancient monuments. Baan Nang Talung Suchat is a source of production and distribution of shadow puppets and puppets. There is also a demonstration in the shadow puppet house area. This area has also been divided

into a museum displaying local tools and the

International Shadow Play Museum. Mr.

Suchart Sapsin graduated from Wat Sakaeo

School and learned how to carve shadow

puppets from Mr. Thongnoo Khao, a skilled

shadow puppet craftsman of Thailand. Nakhon

Si Thammarat Province until could carve

shadow puppets and puppets very well and play shadow puppets with Suchart

Subsap having the ability to write and carve shadow puppets and be able to

design shadow puppets and puppets according to ancient and applied styles, in

addition, Suchat Sapsin can write poetry and shadow puppet scripts. At Nai

Nangchat Sapsin's house, there will be a shadow puppet-making demonstration.





And a shadow puppet shows for those who are interested as well. It is an important tourist attraction of Nakhon Si Thammarat province with both Thai and foreign tourists. Popular to come to see the art of shadow puppet carving and shadow puppet shows, and products of

shadow puppet carving. And puppets can be exported to foreign countries because the shadow puppets are of high quality. The famous shadow puppet carving of the city, the sound of leather carving tools from the daily work of Suchat leather. The charms that bring this museum to life, inspired by His Majesty the King who thanked the preservation of which means the art of carving shadow puppets for the performance of shadow puppets during the year 1984.

In the evening Have dinner at restaurant.

6 p.m. Take you for a in front of **Phra That**

Woramahawihan or the street in front of Wat Phra Mahathat, in Muang District, Nakhon Si Thammarat Province. There is also an English name, “Phrathat Night Market”, the word “Market”, the southern people call it “Lard”, hence the origin of the name “Lard Na Phrathat”. This market has since opened. The



market on July 15, 2017, is also a tourist attraction that has just been opened for almost a year under the slogan “Must-See Market on Sai Tham Road”. Wat Phra Mahathat, all 4 lanes, converted into a market for people to visit, taste, and shop for fun. The atmosphere in front of the Phra is lively, with local desserts,

local food of the southern people, which is known as full of both savory and sweet dishes. Which snacks and some foods are only available in Nakhon Si Thammarat Province. It can be called a local specialty sweet, so it's possible to



get strange snacks, rare snacks that can be found here. In addition, there are various types of OTOP products and products to be displayed and distributed to tourists and the general public to buy as things. Souvenirs here has a garbage

disposal policy at all shops and does not use a pass bag. Vendors tend to use banana leaves, paper bags to pack food, and other products that customers buy instead. Demonstrations of local cultural performances such as Nora dancing, shadow puppet shows, singing, and so on, are rare to see. In modern times, it is the dissemination and conservation of the culture of the city. For future generations to learn about the performance. There is an open space for everyone who has talent, both cultural and cultural performances, as well as music, or they can show their talents as well.

Day 2 Wat Phra Mahathat Woramahawihan - Khao Khun Phanom Temple - Khiriwong Village
- Khanom Beach – Protpran Cafe (_ / _ / _)

In the morning Have breakfast at the hotel restaurant. After the meal, take you to **Wat Phra Mahathat Woramahawihan** or what the people call "Wat Phra That". An ancient site, sacred place, and the mascot of Nakhon Si Thammarat people as well as all Buddhists, a symbol of Nakhon Si Thammarat



province that is widely known. It is Phra Borommathat Chedi which is located within Wat Phra Mahathat Woramahawihan because it is the place where the Buddha's relics are present. The inverted bell-shaped architectural chedi is featured at the top of the chedi, which is covered with

real gold. According to tradition, the relic is composed of many precious gold ornaments and valuables. People bring it to the Lord Buddha to make them meet Nirvana from the provincial slogan, Historical City, Phra That Golden, Juicy, Natural, Minerals, Rich in Relics of the Three Kings, Wat Mak Silp, complete the message that Phra That Thong, therefore, refers to the top of the golden chedi of Phra Borommathat, and if anyone wants to see the golden relics of the golden relics closely Binoculars are available for a price, depending on how long you will be able to appreciate the beauty. The famous and sacred relic of the Chedi attracts people from all over to pay respects. Another ritual is to bring the cloth up. The legendary element believes that. If anyone has brought a cloth to the element and on top of the blessing in any matter. They wish to be healed. Ask for a child, ask for work and study that will be true as hoped there is a story. A man had a walking accident. He couldn't heal. In the end, his parents

didn't know what to do. So, he came on and brought the relics to his son. The young man soon recovered until he was able to walk normally. Every year during Makha Day and Visakha Bucha Day, a parade of cloth is held, which is an annual merit-making event with people from all over the world. Sarathi joins to make great merit. One of the wonders of Phra That has no shadow on the ground, no matter which way the sun shines, which no one can find an answer



as to why. From this miracle, the TAT has given this pagoda as one of the unseens of Thailand. Apart from the Buddha's relics, the small chedi that surrounds many relics is a strange thing for tourists. I saw this chedi called the Acropolis of Pagoda, which has a total of 149. The

Comprehensive Pagoda is a chedi that ancestors' descendants have built over and over again to contain the remains of their deceased relatives by praying that their relatives can get it. Born in the religion of the Buddha again in the next life, besides the magic of the shadow relics, the surrounding chedi that surrounds the Buddha's relics are wonderful things that we rarely see anywhere else as well. Then take you to **Wat Khao Khun**

Phanom, a temple that has a cave with a wall of historical and archaeological importance, brick and mortar with parapet, as well as the city wall. The front wall has stucco designs adorning Chinese porcelain. There are



Buddha images in the cave. About 30 bronze and bronze Buddha's feet is an old temple that

is important in history and archeology. It is the residence of King Taksin who came to live and worship in this cave. In front of the temple is an ancient nectar site, believed to be a holy well. Dedicated to King Taksin for his personal use. Inside, there are interesting things such as the monument of King Taksin the



Great. The temple features brick walls holding mortar and parapets as well as the city wall. The front wall has stucco designs decorated with Chinese porcelain. The cave is on the top and having to walk up the stairs about 250 steps, about 30 bronze Buddha images, and bronze

Buddha's feet said for the history of this temple is assumed to be the residence of King Thon Buri. (King Taksin fled to pray until death but some say that it was a resting place for Princess Kenee, daughter of Prince Nara Suriyawong, Nakhon Si Thammarat during 1769-1776. Then take you to the **village of Khiri Wong**, an old community that migrated to live in the foothills of Khao Luang, Kamlon Sub-district, which is a path leading up to the peak of Khao Luang.

The mixed orchard is called Ban Khiri Wong community garden. It is surrounded by mountains that are part of the Luang Mountain Range, which is the highest mountain in the south. The highest point of the mountain range is about 1835 meters above sea level. Nature is also a forest upstream of many streams, one is "Khlung Tha Dee" which is the main canal that flows through Khiri Wong Community



Village as a model for managing ecotourism business amid the nature of the mountains and the Karan River. The quality from the Best Tourism Industry Award 1998, Kiriwong Village is full of interesting activities that open up a new world of learning for you and there are many waterfalls nearby of fun activities such as visiting the Somsom Garden, which is mixed gardening where various types of plants are planted in the same orchard such as mangosteen, durian, betel nut, etc., learn about different production groups of different



villagers. According to the interest in producing tourism products such as natural tie-dye fabric group, mangosteen peel herbal soap making group. In addition, the Ban Khiriwong community has homestay accommodation available amid a waterfall, especially during the fruit season. wood

Available from July to September to taste fresh fruit as well. Trekking to study nature to the peak of Khao Luang for forest lovers and swimming in the stream that flows through the village. There are many spots suitable for swimming.

Shopping at Khiriwong Village has a souvenir shop. Big is a product that the villagers produce themselves and there is also a market selling fruit that the villagers picked from the garden to sell, something they may not have seen before, such as Khom Khom Kluek Lok Niang during the fruit season. At the market, there are both fresh and processed fruits such as mangosteen, mangosteen, durian, fried durian, and grilled durian as souvenirs.



At noon Have lunch at restaurant.

In the afternoon Take you to **Khanom Beach** or “Hat Khanom National Park - Mu Ko Thale Tai”. It is a famous beach of Nakhon Si Thammarat, characterized by a long sandy beach that extends out into the sea with pine



trees, Koh Mankong and Koh Matsum with sandy beaches and long with coconut trees. There are abundant beautiful corals, both disc corals, brain corals, and staghorn corals around the island, with beaches and clear water suitable for snorkeling and swimming activities in various bays such as Ao Thong

Yee, Ao Thong Yang, Ao Kho Khao. Ao Na Dan, Ao Laung Phao, Ao Thong Ching, and Ao Nai Phlao which have white sand beaches and clear waters suitable for swimming. Koh Yao Nok is the legendary island of Luang Pu Thuat. Stepped on freshwater where Khanom Beach is a beautiful beach.

Collectively referred to as “Haad Na Dan”, is a long sandy beach. Alternating rocks located between the hills that extend into the sea, both north and south along the banks of Khanom. There are many large and small beaches lined with crystal clear water, suitable for swimming, if using the position at the mouth of the canal.



Khanom flows into the sea mainly in the northern area of the canal up to the contiguous sandy beach, including Thong Ching Haad Beach. Lat Phao, Thong Nod Beach, Thong Nian Beach, and Nang Nang Beach. The southern part of the canal has one of the most beautiful beaches in the city, Nai Phlao Beach, an 18-kilometer-long white sandy beach curved in a rubber moon circle. Then take you to a **Protpran Cafe**, a small cafe by the sea that says that the atmosphere is very good. The shop is located not far from the Chedi Temple. You can leave your stomach before or after you go to pray for Khai without having to go far to Bali.

You can see a good atmosphere by the sea because there are both lovers and family's corner and playground corner for all children. The highlight here is the colorful moon sticky rice with sweet mango topped with coconut milk, which is only available for holidays. Only for women or wanting to find desserts to cool off the heat, you must try a pair of shaved ice with a variety of fruits besides quenching the heat.



In the evening Have dinner at the restaurant. After eating, return to rest at the hotel.

Day 3 City Pillar Shrine - Buddhism Park - Souvenir Shop - Bangkok (_ / _ / _)

In the morning Have breakfast at the hotel restaurant. After meals, collect your luggage for Check Out from the hotel. Then take you to **the City Pillar Shrine**. It is enshrined as the city pillar of Nakhon Si Thammarat province, located



in Mueang District, north of Na Mueang, an area of approximately 2 rai. There are a total of 4 buildings in the middle that house the City Pillar Shrine, designed to resemble the Srivijaya art called Hemaraj Leela, while the four



smaller buildings are the satellites of the four directions called the Jatulokthep Shrine, consisting of Phra Suea Mueang San Phra.

Phra Brahma Muang Shrine and Nakhon Si

Thammarat City Pillar Shrine are like sacred

things that protect the country from various dangers. Many people may have known about the sanctity of the City Pillar Shrine from several rumors through the Quadrant. Kamramathep, the guardian angel of the city, is on the highest pillar of the city pillar. Many stories are told from the experiences of those involved in the construction of the City Pillar Shrine, starting from the city pillar made of golden Takhian wood obtained from the top of the mountain. One of the yellow mountains in the Nakhon Si Thammarat Mountain range, the group cut the teeth and cut the Takhian tree to a length of 4 meters, requiring an elephant. Dragged down from the top of the mountain when the elephant dragged at first the Takhianthong wood refused to move but when the group cuts their teeth, they light the incense beside them, they can drag it as usual. On the first day, they parade the carved and decorated city pillars and board the replica of the ancient Srivijaya boat from the director's residence. To the front of Viharn Luang, while summoning the city pillar from a model ship to the ground in front of the royal viharn. There was an astonishing phenomenon of the setting sun at that instant, heavy rain in the upstream mountain area in the west of the city. Causing wild water to almost overflow the banks of Khlong Tha Di and Khlong Phrom Lok Wua 1. Many of the buffaloes that villagers were tethered to in the canals died during that time. Drought or even performing rituals related to the Nakhon Si Thammarat City Pillar, especially outdoor ceremonies, often with pouring rain almost every time in various rituals and many other wonderful



stories. Then take you to **the Buddhist Park** located in Thung Yai District, Nakhon Si Thammarat Province, on the Asian route along the Tapi River, or some people often call it “Wat Anonymous”. It is a construction site that has not yet been completed, which makes this place. It is interesting and has tourists and photographers always frequented in the park. There is a Buddha image enshrined in the middle of the courtyard, both white, gold, and plaster models that are not complete, arranged in rows becoming the picture. It looks particularly quaint during the evening hours when the sun sets, when multicolored twilights appear in the backdrop of the Buddha image, making the area even more magical, although this is not a golden temple in the way it looks. Together since I can remember. But this strange beauty is still a temple in a new way for us to see even though this place is called an anonymous temple. But in reality, it turns out to be another place that people come to wonder. Just looking at the image of the Buddha statue and the light shining across the evening sky makes everyone who visits the Buddhist Park. Lost along the way, this place is regarded as the unseen of Nakhon Si Thammarat.



Then take you to buy souvenirs at **the souvenir shop**, walk to buy snacks and processed seafood, clean and delicious, such as grass shrimp, squid, squid. etc., invite you to buy at your convenience.



At noon Have lunch at restaurant.

In the afternoon Then travel to take you out of Nakhon Si Thammarat back to Suvarnabhumi Airport by Thai VietJet Air, flight VZ 339. Traveling time is approximately 1 hour 30 minutes.
