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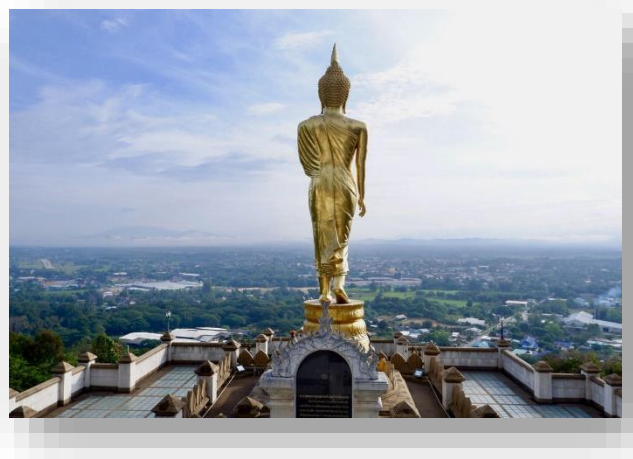
Day 1 Bangkok – Nan- Phra That Khao Noi Temple- National Museum

(-/-/-)

05.00 Depart from Bangkok to Nan would take around 8 hours 55 minutes.

13.30 Arrive at [Nan](#) and **lunch at the restaurant.**

14.30 Arrive at [Nan](#). Take you to [Phra That Khao Noi Temple](#). It is located in Mueang Nan District. It is the Phra That chedi made of bricks and cement in Burmese style mixed with Lanna style. Inside contains the Buddha's hair relics. It is another important and ancient precursor. It is assumed that it is the same age as Phra That Chae Haeng. The temple is located on a high hill. Therefore, it is a beautiful viewpoint overlooking the surrounding city of Nan. At present, the viewpoint area enshrines Phra Phuttha Maha Udom Mongkhon Nanthaburi Si Nan, which is a Buddha image in the posture of giving blessings on a lotus base 9 meters high, the top of the hair is made



of gold weighing 27 baht. According to history, Phra That Khao Noi was built by the second consort of Phaya Phu Kheng, the ruler of Nan around the 20th Buddhist era. Many Nan rulers later restored the relics until there was a major renovation during the reign of King Suriyaphong Pharitdet in the year 1906-1911 by a Burmese technician named Mong Ying Krom. Silpakorn surveyed and registered it as a historical site in 1980.

Then take you to [Nan national Museum](#). It is the National Museum of Nan Province, located in the protected area of the former ruler of Nan, Pha Kong Road, Nai Wiang Subdistrict, Mueang District, Nan Province, with a total area of 14 rai, 2 ngan, 32 square wa, surrounded by important roads such as Phakong Road on the east side, Suriyaphong Road in the south, and Mahaprom Road in the north. The original museum building was a tower that King Suriyaphong Pharitdet built as a residence in 1903 B.E. It is a two-storey brick building in a tri-muk or T-shape style. The style is a blend of western art and Thai art. The internal structure is wooden facing east with a porch out the



front. Thatched roof When Chao Maha Brahma Suratada, the last ruler of Nan, reached the Piralai, the prince, the son of the ruler of Nan, gave this tower with all the land to the government to use as the Nan City Hall. Later, when the Ministry of Interior had built a new city hall, the Fine Arts Department has requested the building for Hor Kham to be the Nan National Museum was established in the year 1974 and announced the establishment of the Nan National Museum in the year B.E. 1985. After the exhibition is completed, Her Royal Highness Princess Maha Chakri Sirindhorn has been graciously pleased to preside over the opening ceremony of the Nan National Museum for the public on August 14, 1987.

Evening **Dinner at the restaurant.**

19.00 Take you to check-in at **Khum Muang Min Boutique Hotel** or a hotel of the same level. (If you travel to Nan during Friday - Sunday, there will be a walking street at Kad Khuang in the city of Nan, next to Wat Phumin)

Day 2 Pua District, Sri Mongkol Temple (Kong)– Baan Huanam Mushroom Farm- Phuket Temple - Rong Ngae Temple

Morning Breakfast at hotel's dining room. Take you to Pua District. From Nan town, take Road 101 until reaching Pua District and travel to [Sri Mongkhon Temple \(Kong\)](#). It is located at Yom Subdistrict, Tha Wang Pha District, Nan Province. It is an old temple that has been granted Wisung Khamssi since 1852. The most famous monk of this temple is Luang Pu Kong. Behind the temple, there is an observation deck overlooking the lush green rice fields and mountains of Doi Phu Kha lined intricately. There are rest areas and Hug Nan



coffee shops in the rice fields. There is a bamboo bridge connecting from the temple where you can go down for a walk and take photos. The observation deck area of the temple has been made into kiosks and viewpoints for taking pictures at many points, including a coffee shop in a Thai atmosphere to relax. Inside the temple are interesting things, including Viharn Luang, with its magnificent murals mimicking the paintings of Nan Bua Pan, a Nan painter of Tai Lue descent. Then take you to [Baan](#)



[Huanam Mushroom Farm](#). It is located in Pua District, Nan Province. It is another accommodation suitable for inhaling ozone. You can see the vast rice fields in full view from the front of the accommodation in a private atmosphere. It is open as a restaurant as well. Most of the menu focuses on the mushroom menu. This

is because here is a mushroom farm that produces one of the largest and most comprehensive mushroom cultures in Pua District and Nan Province. Therefore, mushrooms are used as a component

of various menus. Those who come to Pua, even if they haven't stayed overnight, shouldn't miss it. Come try the famous mushroom dishes and pizzas here.

Noon **Lunch at the restaurant.**

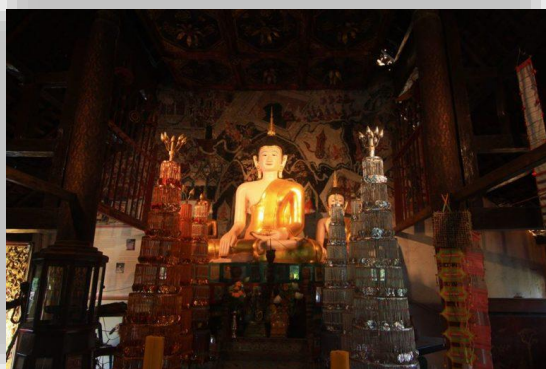
Afternoon Take you to [Phuket Temple](#). It is located in Wora Nakhon Sub-district, Pua District, Nan Province. Seeing the name, you might be a little surprised that the name of the temple is probably more in Phuket. Wat Phuket It was named after the village called Village Ket, but the temple is located on a hill, which in the north is called "Doi" or "Phu", so it was named "Wat Phuket", meaning Ban Ket



Temple on a mountain or mountain. Phuket Temple is a temple with beautiful landscape and view. The highlight of the temple is the balcony.

Behind the temple, next to a wide rice field with a mountain backdrop of Doi Phu Kha Forest Park in the morning is another beautiful sunrise viewpoint.

15.00 Take you to [Rong Ngae Temple](#). It is an ancient temple of Pua District. There is an



outstanding and beautiful old viharn with Thai Lue art. It has been registered as an old temple of Nan. Wat Rong Ngae was awarded under the Royal Patronage of Her Royal Highness Princess Maha Chakri Sirindhorn as an award for an outstanding building in art and architecture conservation in the category of sanctuaries and temples by the Association of Siamese

Architects under the Royal Patronage and received the 7th Thai

Tourism Industry Award in the category of outstanding cultural attractions. The appearance of the gable viharn is a thousand flora pattern. The sanctuary has a low roof. In the viharn there is the

presiding Buddha image in the attitude of subduing Mara. The back wall of the Buddha image has paintings on the history of the Buddha and the royal Jataka skill of local craftsmen. On the viharn pillars, there are golden patterns on a red background or unique words such as cones, flora and flower patterns, etc. In addition, you should not miss to see the traditional Lanna-style pulpit that is hard to find.

Evening **Dinner at the restaurant.**

19.00 Take you to back to the hotel.

Day 3 Phra That Chang Kham Worawihan Temple – Chae Haeng Relics - Bangkok

Morning **Breakfast at hotel's dining room.** Pack your bags to check out from the hotel.



Then take you to [Phra That Chang Kham Worawihan Temple](#). วัดพระธาตุช้างค้ำวรวิหาร It was built by Phaya Phu Khong, the ruler of Nan, over 600 years old and consists of a large viharn. Characteristics of Lanna Thai style architecture

Appearance inside the grand hall enshrines a large Buddha image with round cement columns sized by 2 people wrapped in stucco designs 1.50 meters high

above the level of the viharn floor, is a little Kanok pattern similar to the pattern of the pillars in the Viharn of Wat Phumin. In front, a pair of lions stand at the foot of the stairs. Inside the temple, there is a towering chedi with a half-elephant figure adorned all around. It looks like a base with 6 ropes on each side, a total of 24 ropes.



It is an art that has been accepted through the Sukhothai Kingdom. There is a unique beauty. After that take you to [Chae Haeng Relics](#). It is located at Ban Nong Tao King, Phu Pieng District, Nan Province, about 2 km from the city. It is a treasured relic and an important monument of Nan, over 600 years old, showing a beautiful example of Nan's architecture and art. According to history, it was said that Phaya Politika had been built in 1891 to contain the Buddha's relics from Sukhothai covered with brass. It is one of the most beautiful ancient sites in Lanna.

12.00 Lunch at the restaurant. Then depart from Nan to Bangkok would take around 8 hours 55 minutes.

21.30 Arrive at Bangkok safely.
