**Day 1** - Bangkok – Nong Bua Lam Phu– 150 Million Years Old Stone Shell Museum– Luang Pu Khao Analayo Museum

05.00 Depart from Bangkok to Nong Bua Lam Phu, and it would take around7 hours and 30 minutes.

Noon Arrive at Nong Bua Lam Phu. Take you to have to lunch at the restaurant. Then go to 150 Million Years Old Stone Shell Museum.

# Afternoon Arrive at 150 Million Years Old Stone Shell Museum or or "Million Year

Shells Cemetery". The 150 Million Years Stone Shell and Dinosaur Fossil Museum is located at Ban Huai Dua, Non-Than Subdistrict, Mueang District, Nong Bua Lamphu Province. It used to be a sandstone quarry where rock blasts formed high cliffs where ancient shell remains were found. Later the mine was abandoned, and villagers have found many stones that looked like beautiful shells, so they dug up and sold them. When the Department of Mineral Resources examined it, it was found that it was a double clamshell fossil in the late Jurassic period.





Later, this place has developed into a museum exhibits about the universe, the solar system, the world, the origin of life, the evolution of plants, animals, humans, dinosaurs, and paleontology. It is a museum that exhibits the knowledge of nature and geology of Nong Bua Lamphu Province, which is an important discovery and worthy of education for the youth of Nong Bua Lamphu Province. There are exhibits the story of the ancient fossil clam 150 million years old from the Jurassic period, the bivalve

clam discovered at Ban Hoi Dua which consisted of bivalve clams of different sizes, The knowledge about Nong Bua Lamphu Province, show information, pictures of attractions, and important places are divided into 6 districts in Nong Bua Lamphu Province: Mueang Nong

Bua Lamphu District, Na Klang District, Si Bun Rueang District, Suwan Khuha District, Non-Sang District, and Na Wang District. The inside exhibits dinosaur fossils, the story of dinosaurs, the story of the dinosaurs that were discovered, fossils in the Northeast, the stories of various dinosaur species, and the bones and footprints of dinosaurs discovered in Non-Than Subdistrict. Then take you to Luang Pu Khao Analayo Museum at Tham Klong Phen Temple. It is a famous temple of the province. It is assumed that this is the ancient temple in the nice and calm atmosphere. However, there is no evidence when it was built and it finally

became the abandon temple. On B.E.2501 (1958), Luang Pu Khao Analayo, the disciple of Luang Pu Mun Phurithatta came to stay at Wat Tham Klong Pen for meditation. He used the stone hall as the chapel. He died in B.E.2526 (1983). The important remarks here are: The museum displays the utensil of Luang Pu Khao Analayo. It was built from the marble in modern architecture style. King Rama IX donated his personal



budget 1,400,000 Baht for the construction. Thus, it is the valuable architecture and historical value. Luang Pu Khao Analayo human imagery Museum - the building is in the shape of three stones in order in the overturn bell-shape. The wax model of Luang Pu Khao Analayo in sitting posture is located inside for people to pay respect. Luang Pu Khao pagoda was constructed to contain the relics of Luang Pu Khao. It is on the stone yard near Luang Pu Khao Mundapa. At the temple, there is the cave where the two-sided drum and the Walking Buddha image embedded in the stone are located. Luang Pu Khao used to stay here for meditation. Currently, the museum collecting the utensil of Luang Pu Khao is constructed for people to visit and pay respect.

**Day 2** Ban Kut Kho Moei Archaeological Site – Ban Kut Kwang Soi Archeology Site – Phra Phutthabat Phu Kao Temple

Morning Breakfast at the hotel's dining room. Then take you to Ban Kut Kho Moei Archaeological Site.

**09.00** Arrive at Ban Kut Kho Moei Archaeological Site. It is located at Ban Thin Subdistrict, Non Sang District, Nong Bua Lamphu Province. Ban Kut Kho Moei Archaeological Site has been humans inhabited since prehistoric times. This community has cultivation, animal husbandry, jewelry making, and casting various forms. Evidence that appeared in the early days were Kut Kwang Soi and Kut Kho Moei archaeological sites that found human and animal skeletons, earthenware scraps, bronze jewelry scraps, and various



steel tools. It is a source of excavated objects, antiques, and art objects similar to the Ban Chiang culture. Ban Kut Kho Moei Archaeological Site is located in Kut Du Subdistrict, at the western foothills of Phu Phan Mountain. The archaeological site of Ban Kut Kwang Soi is located at the foot of Khao Phu Kao on the east side. The types of antiques that have been unearthed are human skeletons, pottery, bronze bracelets, and stone bracelets. Then take you to Ban Kut Kwang Soi Archeology Site or "Ban Non-Don Klang

Archaeological Museum". Ban Kut Kwang Soi is located at Village No. 2, Kut Kwang Soi Sub-district, Non Sang District, Nong Bua Lam Phu. In 1993, the village farmers excavated human skeletons and antiques by the Fine Arts Department by the Office of Archeology and

the 7th National Museum, Khon Kaen Province. The Fine Arts Department explored and declared to be a prehistoric archaeological reserve. General characteristics have excavated antique utensils and artifacts similar to archeological evidence in the Ban Chiang era. Evidence found were ancient utensils, pottery containers, various art objects such as bronze rings, tobacco pipes, crushed stone, etc. The Fine Art Department Unit 7 of Khon Kaen





excavated it in 1993. The 7th regional office of Fine Arts, Khon Kaen incorporation with Nong Bua Lam Phu Provincial Office of the Non-Formal and Informal Education, surveyed it in 1997. The characteristics of the archelogy site: a soil mound of 155x200 meters with 2-3 meters height from the ground. They found some evidence from the prehistoric era of Dvaravati and Lan Xang in the surrounding areas that are presumably age over 2,500 years and the Lan Xang archaeological evidence age around 23-25 B.E

## Noon Lunch at the restaurant.

Afternoon Take you to Phra Phutthabat Phu Kao Temple. Phra Phutthabat Phu Kao Temple is located in Nikhom Phatthana Sub-district, Non Sang District, Nong Bua Lam Phu, there is a footprint of Phra Phutthabat Praditsathan around 1 round of Wat Phra Phutthabat Phu Kao. It is an old temple located in Phu Kao District. Inside the temple are large human

and dog footprints carved into the rock. Moreover, there are Mim cave and Achan Sim Cave, the important archaeological site of the province, and has a beautiful viewpoint. Wat Phra Phutthabat Phu Kao is an ancient temple with large human and dog footprints carved into the rock related to the folk tale Phra Suphrom Wimokha and the nine-tailed dog. Inside the temple are Mim cave, and Achan Sim or Luang Pu Sim cave. There are color paintings and carvings on the walls. It is a prehistoric cave.




**Evening** Back to the Ruean Chorfa Hotel for rest.



Day 3 Phu Kao - Phu Phan Kham National Park – Non Yao Beach - Bangkok

MorningBreakfast, at the hotel's dining room. Pack your bags to check outfrom the hotel. Then take you to Phu Kao - Phu Phan Kham National Park.

**09.00** Arrive at Phu Kao - Phu Phan Kham National Park. Phu Kao - Phu Phan Kham National Park covers the area of three provinces: Nong Bua Lamphu Province, Khon Kaen Province, and Udon Thani Province, but most of the mountain ranges are in the area of Non-Sang District, Nong Bua Lamphu Province. The location of Phu Kao - Phu Phan Kham National Park Office is in Nong Bua Lamphu Province, which is far from the city on the



route Nong Bua Lamphu - Khon Kaen of about 53 km. In the past, the area of Phu Kao - Phu Phan Kham had fertile forests and many kinds of wildlife. But at present, the forests and wildlife are sparse because of encroachment and destruction. Therefore, the government declared the area of Phu Kao - Phu Phan Kham, which used to be the national forest reserve, to be a national park area to conserve natural resources, forests, and wildlife. Phu Kao consists of 9 mountains, which are Phu Fang, Phu Khum Pun, Phu Han, Phu Moei, Phu Kho Mor, Phu Sun, Phu Pera, Phu Luak, and

Phu Wat, therefore called "Phu Kao". Moreover, there are many stories

about Phu Phan Kham because this area is a rich forest with many wildlife. Phu Kao - Phu Phan Kham National Park has many beautiful caves such as Tham Phran Ma, which is an important cave because it is a cave that Luang Pu Khao Analyo, the famous Thera of Wat Tham Klong Phen had hiked to pray at this cave. Then take you to Non Yao Beach or "Pattaya Sam", located at Ban Non Yao, Khok Yai Sub-district. It is a beach on





the edge of a freshwater lake in Ubolrat Dam. You can see the beautiful view of the Phu Phan Mountains. Tourists like to swim here especially during the Songkran festival and have various restaurants to serve the tourists. Traveling from Nong Bua Lam Phu town to here, take Highway No. 2146 (Nong Bua Lamphu - Non Sang) to Non Sang District for about 45 kilometers, then travel from Non Sang District to Ban Non Yao, about 13 kilometers. Ask for more information at Khok Yai Subdistrict Administrative Organization.

Noon Lunch at the restaurant. Then take you back to Bangkok.

Afternoon Depart from Nong Bua Lam Phu to Bangkok, and it would take around 7 hours and 30 minutes.


