8 A.M. Depart from Bangkok to Pathum Thani Province in approximately 30 minutes.

9:30 A.M. Arrive at **Pathum Thani Province** Take you to **Wat Chedi Hoi**, a famous



temple in Pathum Thani province. It is located at Bo Ngoen Subdistrict, Lat Lum Kaeo District. This temple was just built in 1995 by Phra Kru Sunthon. Khun Tada or Luang Por Thongklueng Suntaro is the creator. The history of the temple is very interesting. Because it was born from the fact that Luang Por Than went on a pilgrimage in Myanmar to meet Achan Silbanta. One year later, he studied magic until he was shattered, so he went back to

Tham Ong Chuk, Si Sawat District, Kanchanaburi Province. It is the origin of the port to see that in the present place, 8 million years ago, it was a large city. Rattanaawadee city name And Luang Por Than himself is the governor of the city here. So, he traveled in search of visions until he found it and has an intention to build this land into a monastery area while digging a bog swamp as a reservoir to water medicinal plants. It made me come across a giant naked oyster buried under the ground and thousands of years old and finally brought. A giant oyster shell was discovered to build a pagoda and named it “Wat Chedi Hoi” until today. The highlight of this temple is the tall shell pagoda causing shock to many onlookers. There are 2 Buddha images, the first one is at the entrance to the temple. The second one is in the temple area. In addition, there are also agricultural attractions, Wan Ya herb garden. Museum of longboats and a large pond with catfish on the way of the temple.



There are many and turtle ponds beside the marshes. Visitors can buy food to feed the fish and



turtles. Then take you to a **1,000-mai house, cafe & farm**, a learning center for new generations of agriculture. Following in the footsteps of King Rama IX. It is also open as a restaurant and cafe. Under the shade of giant Jamjuree trees and arrange spaces and seating zones in style. It serves beverages, coffee, and a la carte dishes. Along with salads made from farm vegetables and homemade dressings. They also serve.

Inside the shop is like a kingdom of children playing. The front area is an activity zone for children such as rice cultivation, egg harvesting, gardening, planting of trees, salted egg



making, painting, kayaking, playing in the sand, as well as farming animals such as ducks and chickens. Know how to live with nature The middle part of the shop is the cafe section. This zone is suitable for sitting, chilling, relaxing, and eating. There is a large Chamchuri tree in the middle waiting for shade. There are stairs that you can walk up to, and around the area, there are several seating areas. Including many photo

angles, the innermost zone is the waterfront seating and various sitting corners, plus there is also a boat ride to visit Ing Nam Market, Sam Khok Temple. The service is provided in rounds. The price is 5 baht per person. After viewing the cafe atmosphere and taking photos, check-in and then take you to take a walk at **Ing Nam Sam Khok Market**. It is located at Sam Khok



District, Pathum Thani. It is a small market in an old community on the Chao Phraya River. The charm of this market is its simplicity. Friendliness of the villagers that still live a way of life. Along with the river and nature, Visitors will have a walk through the traditional old market. The merchants smiled brightly. There are many

delicious things to choose from. Including the agricultural products of the community to sell as well. For traveling to Ing Nam Market, Sam Khok Temple If driving, you can park your car. There are three parking spots, the old immigration, which is the closest. Wat Bang Toei Klang

and Bang Toei Nok have to walk into the alley for about 50 meters or take a boat from a 1,000-mai cafe, with a boat going around for 1 hour, costing 50 baht per person. The market is a bit quiet with not many shops. The atmosphere in the market is a small walking path of about 1 km. Along the way are the houses of the villagers who mostly bring their things to sell in front of their houses. There is a fair amount of stuff for sale. Both sweet and savory items such as noodles, pork knuckle, boiled crab, Pad Thai, fried clams, Chinese desserts, local vegetables, and various Thai desserts. There is a bridge across the canal to the other side of the market.



At noon **Have lunch and free time**

In the afternoon Take you to **Wat Bot or “Wat Luang Pho To, Big Buddha”**. It is located in Sam Khok District, Pathum Thani, built-in 1621 by Mon people who migrated from Hongsawadee, formerly an ancient temple in the Ayutthaya period. It is a temple with a sacred Buddha image, Luang Por Lue, regarded as the priceless monk of the city of Pathum Thani, the area around the temple has beautiful scenery. The location of Wat Bot is on the dragon's belly of the Chao Phraya River. Statue of Somdej Phra Buddhachan (Toh Promrangsi), the largest sermon in the Thailand temple of this church. It was originally an old temple since the Ayutthaya period, formerly known as "Wat Soi Nang Hong". It is believed to have been built by Mon people who migrated from Hongsawadee. Settled in this area, where the area of Sam Khok District is a



large group of Mon people. Who migrated to Thailand since the reign of King Narai the Great. And after that, there has also been immigration of Mon people to live in this area many times. until the Rattanakosin period, the important Buddha image of this temple is "Luang Por Lue" and is also considered a sacred Buddha image in Pathum Thani. Luang Pho Lue is an old Buddha image that has been with Wat Bot for a long time. It is a Buddha image in the attitude of subduing Mara, made of sandstone. Enshrined at the base of Chukchi in the church with a total of 12. After about 1964, when a thief came in to smuggle the head of the Buddha image inside the church. And only the Reverend Father was left, who had not had his head cut off. From the faith of the villagers, this Buddha image is called "Luang Father Left". According to the beliefs of the villagers. If you come to worship and cover with gold, the rest of Luang Por will escape from all disasters do whatever you want and have money and gold left over. Next to it is a pavilion that the temple provides for lighting incense and candles. And gilded a small statue-like Luang Pho To, which is enshrined in front of the large. Luang Pho To behind is the Dharma courtyard of Luang Pho To surrounded by a crooked temple. Which was built on the occasion of His Majesty the King His Majesty King Bhumibol Adulyadej's 80th birthday on December 5, 2007. There is a zone selling savory and sweet food from local villagers. That tastes delicious to welcome tourists. Take you on a journey **Wat Panyanantaram** is located at Khlong Hok Subdistrict, Khlong Luang District, Pathum Thani Province. Former abbot of Wat Chonprathan Rangsarit. It was founded and created to be a place of dharma and practice. The outstanding building is a replica of the Bodhgaya stupa from India. Another important highlight is the only 3D Dharma puzzle in the world displayed below the Bodhgaya Pagoda. Open to tourists to take pictures. Each image has a connotation of moral principles in the subject of the 4 Noble Truths. Open for free admission. If anyone has faith, they can drop the merit cabinet. All images are about the 4 Noble Truths. Courtesy, interpreting before drawing and installing. Actual operation from Luang Por Panyanantamuni (S.N.S. Suparo). Abbot of Wat Chonprathan Rangsarit and Phra Mahachaloem Piyadassi is the abbot of Panyanantaram Temple. Drawn by personnel and students of RMUTT, Thanyaburi, who can convey the story of the 4 Noble Truths. perfectly, harmoniously and in harmony with the atmosphere of the temple, which is the place where wisdom is born. There are 29 paintings in total, inserting the Buddhist teachings on the 4 Noble Truths because of access to wisdom to be aware of the suffering. That occurs in the daily life of the world. One must understand the Buddha's teachings about the noble truths of suffering, samudaya, nirodha, and the path. Visitors can experience the aforementioned works of art up close. create experiences together with pictures that invite you to think and realize the doctrine in a fun, fun, and not boring way. The overall



atmosphere of the temple is beautiful and shady, suitable as a place suitable for practicing dharma. There will be villagers and believers to join in various Buddhist activities organized by the temple. Buddhists have joined. Both traditions have been passed down for a long time and the Nekkhamma ordination activities every Saturday-Sunday or religious days according to the intention to act. After that, take you to **Wat Don**

Yai, built-in 1996 as one of the important Buddhist places in Lam Luk Ka Klong 8 area where Buddhists come to worship as a source of spiritual reliance. The temple has a wide area with a parking lot. Suitable for bringing family members to worship and pray for good fortune. Inside the temple, there is also an important monument of the King. King Naresuan the Great King Taksin the Great and Phra Piya Maharaj, within the temple are more than ten outside the temple grounds. There is also a fish pond for feeding fish. The chapel is silver and white reflecting the

glittering sunlight created. It is a square shape with 4 directions. According to the teachings of the Blessed One consisted of his Buddhist company which this chapel has white and silver colors that are pure the lotus petals around the chapel are golden. Since this chapel is in Pathum Thani province, it is called "Silver Chapel in Pathum Thong". Inside the chapel is enshrines a large white. Buddha image named "Somdej Phra Suwan



Pathum Phutthapojanawaraporn" or what many people call "Reverend Father Jaidee Wealthy Sri Suk". According to belief If anyone comes to this ordination hall and asks for blessings will make success in what they desire There is also an old ordination hall with a replica of Somdej Phra Buddhachan To enshrined in front of the chapel to pay respect. In addition, the temple also has an egg statue. People frequented to visit the temple to wish for good luck and a holy water bath for the gambler to prove his fortune. The temple is spacious with natural gardening. The atmosphere is shady, pleasing to the eye, and according to





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beliefs. Anyone who comes to pray at this ubosot will be successful in life. The viharn area of the temple still houses. Many other sacred things such as Luang Pho Don Yai, Luang Pho Dam, Phra Phikkhanet, Phra Phrom, Thao Jatukham, Ramathep, Thao Thep Thanjai, and also Build memorials for important monarchs.

In the evening Then take you out of Pathum Thani Province Return to Bangkok in approximately 30 minutes.
