Day 1 Bangkok - Thale Noi - Na Po Kea - Pa Phai Sang Suk

(-/-/-)

05.00 Assemble at the meeting point. The staff will welcome and facilitate you.

07.00 Depart from Don Mueang International Airport (Bangkok) to Trang by Thai Lion Air, flight SL 824. The flight would take around 1 hour 25 minutes.

08.25 Arrive at Trang Airport and pick up luggage.

09.30 Take you to Phatthalung would take around 1 hour. Then take you to Thale



Noi. It is a freshwater lake located in Nang Tung
Subdistrict and Thale Noi Subdistrict, Khuan Khanun
District, Phatthalung Province. A 2 km long Nang
Riam Canal connects Thale Noi and Songkhla Lake.
Thale Noi has been declared a non-hunting area for
Thale Noi wildlife, but people often call it "Talay Noi

Bird Park", which is the first non-hunting area of Thailand under the Department of National Parks, Wildlife and Plants, Ministry of Natural Resources and Environment. Due to the fertility of the area and the marine biodiversity makes "Khuan Khee Sian Peat" of Thale Noi

was declared as the first world's wetland or "Ramsar Site" in Thailand on September 13, 1998. Thale Noi is an area with a lot of biodiversities: ecosystems, wildlife, aquatic animals, plants, especially abundant birds. A highlight of Thale Noi is taking a cruise to see the "Red Lotus Sea" or "Talay Bua Sai", the most abundant lotus species. In the morning, the lotus will



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fully bloom. It is considered another beauty of the sea, but lotus flowers will bloom only in the morning. The lotus flowers will begin to bloom from mid-February to April. You can also see other interesting plants such as water hyacinth, jake, duckweed, various seaweeds, Krajood, Kong, Liphao district, Kok, and Samet that stand majestically in the terrestrial forest area, etc.

Noon Lunch at the restaurant.

Afternoon Take you to Na Po Kea. It is located in Makok Nuea Sub-district, Khuan



Khanun District, Phatthalung Province. It is a demonstration rice planting that is full of various local rice varieties, such as Sangyod rice, ancient kruam rice, etc. It is a learning center for Thai farmers, where tourists can experience rice harvesting, plowing the fields, raising buffaloes,

and digging

fish ponds. There

are also buffaloes for tourists to feed the grass and admire the cuteness. There are also coffee shops, restaurants, and shops selling agricultural and various local products. The walkway to each shop is connected





by a wooden bridge that

stretches through the green rice fields. You can see the scenery, take a walk, take photos with the rice fields, and get the cool breeze. Then take you to Pa Phai Sang Suk. It is located in Kwanjai Bamboo Garden, Khuan Khanun District, Phatthalung

Province, not far from Khuan Khanun Hospital. It is another quality area of Phatthalung

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Province that will bring happiness to the community and visitors. It's easy to get around, and you can have a picnic all day long. Kwanjai bamboo garden of Khun Kwanjai was a garden that cultivated bamboo and bamboo charcoal and has been a learning center for a long time but opened as a recreational attraction at the end of January 2017. It was born from the cooperation of Suan

and the Gin Dee Mee Suk Phatthalung to help create this market. Lessons found that are limitations in green marketing for the community to survive have been used as a guideline in creating this happy bamboo forest with the chic concept of "full, comfortable, happy is enough". There is a green bamboo forest at the Kwan Jai Bamboo Garden in

over 30 rai. It is an area to create happiness, which has divided into 5 main zones: Phai Sang Suk Market Zone, Sitting Area Zone, Activity Zone for Children, Learning Zone of the Kwan Jai bamboo garden, and the shadiest bamboo forest zone.

Evening Dinner at the restaurant. Take you to check-in at **Varni Homestay** or a hotel of the same level.



Day 2 Tainod Holiday Market – Paiwan Waterfall – Tham Nam Yen Kaochaison - Khaochaison Hotspring

Morning Breakfast at the hotel's dining room.

Then take you to Tainod Holiday Market. It is located at Village No. 4, Ban Channa, Don Sai Subdistrict, Khuan Khanun District, Phatthalung Province. It is a market under a palm tree or "ton nod" in the local language of the south. In the past, Tainod Holiday Market was just a place for children



and villagers to read books and exchange knowledge on art. Later, there was a local market



project for villagers to bring organic products and local food to sell. There are more than 100 stores ever. There are fresh vegetables, fresh fruits, local food, local desserts that are hard to find, and various handmade products which will be under the concept of "Eat Well, Have Happiness". However, the thing that makes this

market different from other community markets is the decoration of shops and market areas that focus on using natural materials to adapt and design to be modern. It also allows villagers

to participate in the creation of containers by using local natural materials to turn them into stylish containers to reduce the use of foam and plastic.

Then take you to Paiwan Waterfall. It is located at Khlong Chaloem Subdistrict, Kong Ra District,



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Phatthalung Province. It is considered the famous waterfall of Phatthalung because it is the largest waterfall in Phatthalung and is in a fertile forest. It flows down a cliff. You can swim. The important thing is that there is water flowing all year round. The Paiwan Waterfall has a total of 7 floors. The first floor can walk to visit and swim, but the other floors are no access path; it must have a gun on the cliff to go up. It is recommended that for safety, playing in the water on the first floor is better. The atmosphere here will be cool and quiet because there are large trees covering the surrounding area, making it very shady, suitable for relaxing.

Noon Lunch at the restaurant.

Afternoon Take you to Tham Nam Yen Kaochaison. It is surrounded by an abundance of trees and greenery with beautiful shady views. To visit the cave, tourists



will have to take a boat to see inside the cave, not climb into the cave like the other caves. There will be a boat waiting to serve tourists. Before getting into the cave, tourists will see many monkeys that live

here. Then the boats will take us along the river and into the limestone cave, where what tourists will surely encounter is a colony of bats clinging to the cave's walls. It is a small bat that isn't scary at all. The cave is dark, so you have to shine a flashlight up the walls. You will see the beauty of the natural stone inside the cave with various shapes and patterns. There are stalagmites and stalactites, when it reflects with the

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lights are more beautiful. Usually, the caves will be a name for the cave hall, which is named after the shape of the rock or cave hall. This cave also. Many beautiful and unusual stones stand out: one that looks like an elephant has proboscis, ears, and has black eyes. The stalagmites are shaped like shark teeth. There are sparkling stalagmites and stalactites. There are also stone mosaic tiles. The stalactite is goat's milk. Some stalactites are like jellyfish, etc. When taking a boat to cruise in, be a little careful because sometimes the ceiling of the cave is so low that we have to lie down with the boat if our head is up and it will collide with the ceiling. There will be lighting inside

the cave to make it look beautiful and enjoy
the view of the cave. We cruised to the end
and then came back the same way about
800 meters back and forth. It was very



worthwhile for the beauty and experience. If you like adventure, you must not miss it.



Then take you to Khaochaison Hotspring.

It is located in Khao Chaison Subdistrict,

Khao Chaison District, Phatthalung

Province. It is a popular tourist spot for

tourists who travel and treat diseases.

Legend has it that the Khao Chaison Hot

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Spring area used to be a large lake until a pair of grandparents rowed boats to fish, but the boat leaked, so Grandma prayed to the sacred things to save her life, and a miracle happened when the water in the lake suddenly dried up and the dirt and rocks beneath the lake came together until a mountain rises in the blink of an eye, and that mountain is "Khao Chaison". Khao Chaison Hot Spring has a hot spring from a basin adjacent to the foothill, about 4x5 meters wide, about 60 degrees Celsius, including cold and clear streams flowing from the cave, which is about 500 meters from Tham Nam Ron. Locals believe that this is a sacred basin that can be used to treat skin ailments, and the temperature of the water will rise greatly if it shook. It is divided into a foot bath, a

hand bath, which is a public area that anyone can soak in. If anyone wants privacy, they can use the shower room. There will be both private and family. To stay for a night here, they also have accommodation services, including foot massage, relaxing massage is ready to serve.



Evening Dinner at the restaurant. Then take you back to the hotel for free time.

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Day 3 Kyun Nok Ten- Prince of Phatthalung Palace Museum – Delong Garden

Morning Breakfast at hotel's dining room. Pack your bags to check out from the hotel.



Then take you to Kyun Nok Ten. This is regarded as a check-in point to watch the loudest morning mist of Phatthalung province because we can see the backdrop of nature, forests, and the horizon. It is another popular tourist destination that anyone who comes to Phatthalung must

check in here. There

is also a view that is

surrounded by rubber plantations, rice fields, and waterfalls, a beautiful natural beauty that the villagers help preserve. Anyone who has passed by has to stop and come down to take a commemorative photo. After that, take you to Prince of Phatthalung Palace Museum. In



the past, this palace was used as a government office and the residence of the governor of Phatthalung. It's beautiful and outstanding. It is now considered one of the province's



important historical attractions. Prince of


Phatthalung Palace is also known as "Old Palace
New Palace" because it consists of "Old Palace"

and "New Palace" located in the same area. The

"Old Palace" was built in the early Rattanakosin era

when Phraya Phatthalung (Noi Chantarojawong)

was the governor. "Wang Mai" located in the south,



next to the Lam Pa Canal, was built in 1889 by Phraya Abhai Borirak Chakrawichitpipitphakdi (Net Chantarojawong), the son of Phraya Phatthalung, who was the governor at that time. Current family heirs Chantarojawong has given this palace a national treasure and the Fine Arts Department registered it as an ancient palace on July 16, 1992, while the new palace was registered before on May 31, 1983. It is



ancient Thai architecture that is beautiful as a resident. The old palace is a Thai house that has a blend of styles between the central and southern regions. There is a big house in Thai-style twins in the middle. The new palace built later is a group of 5 Thai houses, divided into bedrooms and kitchens, where you can walk inside. There is also a Thai pavilion on the waterfront and a Phatthalung boat which is an old boat in the reign of King Rama V.

Noon Lunch at the restaurant.

Afternoon Take you to Delong Garden. It is located at Na Nod Subdistrict, Mueang Phatthalung District, Phatthalung Province. It is the newest check-in point in Phatthalung Province because it is a garden, including food, attractions, souvenirs, beautiful photo spots, and





convenient parking. "Sip coffee, take a plane, check-in rice terraces, connect with Saphan Rak, know processed agriculture" is the slogan of De Long Garden. The most striking thing that attracts tourists is the pond built in the middle of the park. The water in the pool was clear,

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turquoise water. There are also spinning boats to serve tourists. The highlight of this pool is the bridge that spans both sides. This bridge is called "Saphan Rak Khang Sangyod". In the middle of the bridge is a metal grid for lovers to bring a key to lock with their name engraved on it. It is believed that it will be true love for each other. If you go with your girlfriend, don't forget to invite them to come here.
