Day 1: Travel from Suvarnabhumi Airport (Bangkok) – Phuket – Old Phuket Town – Phuket Thai Hua Museum – Chinpracha House – Khao Rang Viewpoint – Patong Beach

07.00 Depart from Suvarnabhumi Airport (Bangkok) to Phuket By Thai VietJet Air, flight VZ 314 around 1 hour and 30 minutes to fly.

8:30 Arrive at **Phuket** Take you to **the old town of Phuket**, a city with a long history



of prosperity. One of the traces of Phuket's glorious past is Phuket Old Town. It is filled with Sino-Portuguese-style buildings along both sides of the street until it is unique. These old buildings are scattered throughout Phuket Town, where you can walk and watch. There are also delicious restaurants, chic coffee shops, and souvenir shops for you to enjoy shopping and sightseeing. Upon arrival in Phuket Walking around the

old city is, therefore, a tourist activity that should not be missed. For viewing Phuket Old Town, It is recommended that walking is the best. Because most of the old buildings are located along the road, along different lines, which are not very far from each other. From Thalang Road, Yaowarat, Dibuk, Phang Nga, and Thap Kasattri, it's fun to walk around and take photos and stop at this point. Because if you are driving, it will be quite difficult to find a place to park. the right moment If you want to walk and take photos of the building to get the most beautiful light, the best morning suggestion But if you want to take a walk, visit restaurants, coffee shops, and shops as well. Come in the late afternoon; it will not be very hot. And at night, Phuket Old Town is quite bustling, with many restaurants and coffee shops. They are located next to each other, so it is difficult to choose which restaurant to go to. If you like the atmosphere or want to eat any food, you can choose as you like. Most of the

restaurants focus on local Phuket dishes that are hard to find, such as southern food, dim sum, Chinese desserts, famous noodles, and desserts in Old Phuket Town. The old historical road This road is the center of tourism in Old Phuket with many old tenement buildings, including shops, restaurants, coffee shops, and souvenir shops. many many shops The building is decorated with arched window openings. in the neo-classical architectural style. It has beautiful patterns that emphasize nature, vines, leaves, and animal figures. The tenement houses in this area feature a prominent front door. It is an old wooden façade. The columns are as wide as the two towers combined, with the art of punching holes. Art Deco windows and stucco patterns are used in a harmonious and beautiful way, and many houses and buildings today have new paint but retain their original form. In addition, Thalang Road There is also Soi Rommanee, another small alley where tourists come to take photos because there are colorful buildings in various colors, such as pink, yellow, and blue, and there are coffee shops. There are many shops in this alley. including accommodation. It is another route that tourists should not miss.



Then take you for a short walk at [the Phuket Thai Hua Museum](#). It is a museum dedicated to the history and origins of the Chinese people. who migrated and migrated to Phuket. Let the children of Chinese and Thai people know the origin of their ancestors correctly. In order to realize their true self, tourists and foreigners have the opportunity to study and understand the way of life, behavior, and habits of

Phuket people, including being the center of educational research related to the history of Phuket. It is a 2-story building. The ground floor has 3 large low arches with round columns to support the curve. The pillar is decorated with a semi-ionic lotus pattern. and Corinthian the walls of the building are heavily gouged, a process called rustication. The upper floor has arches, 3 windows, and 2 window openings. The upper window frame is a Roman gable. Square wooden windows with geometric patterns Above the middle arch is a bat-shaped stucco gable.



Then take you to [the Chinpracha House](#). The Chinpracha House, built at the end of the reign of King Rama V by Phra Phithak Chinpracha (Tan Ma Siang), who built this house in the Sino-Portuguese style. It was the first house in Phuket. Also known as "Ang Mo Lao", the distinctive feature of the house is that it is a 2-story house.

The door of the house has Chinese characters lacquered with gold. Wooden windows are made of louvers that can be opened and closed. At the center of the house, there is a small pond, and it is open for ventilation. Italian floor tiles The wooden stairs have a beautiful pattern. Most of the furniture is inlaid with pearls brought from China. And most of the other materials in the house are imported from abroad. Due to the thriving boat trade from Penang Island to Phuket in those days, the house exhibits the history of Phuket through the objects used in the lives



of the people of Phuket over the past 100 years, such as antique kitchen utensils, photographs, and paintings. At present, Chinpracha House is the home of the "Tantavanich" family, whose owners have preserved the buildings and furniture in the house very well. with the aim of making the house a living museum.

Noon **Lunch at the restaurant**

Afternoon **Khao Rang Viewpoint** It is located on a low hill in the northwest of Phuket



Town. Formerly known as Khao Lang because of its location at the back of the city, This place is like the backyard of Phuket Town. While the area of Saphan Hin is the front of the house in Phuket because it is a hill with a good height. making it possible to see the city, sea, and mountains clearly Therefore, the municipality has

established a health garden and a public park for Phuket residents to relax, exercise, and enjoy beautiful views, especially in the evening and at night. The viewpoint on Khao Rang is divided into 2 parts: From the viewpoint at the restaurant Thung Kha-Coffee and Hall of Fame, 100 years of Thung Kha-Coffee Shop It is an old restaurant on Khao Rang that has been open for 40 years. The surrounding atmosphere is very shady, full of shade trees. There is a side of the balcony that extends out to give a 180-degree view of Phuket City and will be even more beautiful at night because the lights from Phuket Town will be sparkling. Very romantic. It has become popular with tourists and Phuket residents who want to change the

atmosphere. Eat delicious food with a beautiful view on the top of the mountain. Then take you to **Patong Beach**, located in Patong Subdistrict, Kathu District, Phuket Province. One of Phuket's



attractions the most famous one has it all. It is also a vacation destination, with many tourists all year round. And of course, this place has all the amenities, including hotels, restaurants, dive shops, and water sports equipment shops. In addition, there is also a 24-hour walking tour of Patong Beach. It is a curved beach-like U shape, about 9 kilometers long, with a mountain line between the head and the end. It helps to block the wind very well. Green, clear water It is very suitable for swimming in the sea. There are also marine activities such as jet skis, parachutes, speedboats, sailing, and many more. intended to accommodate tourists or if anyone can charter a long-tail boat to visit nearby beaches.

Morning **Have breakfast at the hotel restaurant.** After breakfast, take you to **Koh Hey**, a small island located at the southern end of Phuket. About 10 km from the coast of Phuket, it is another popular island in Phuket. That can travel easily by speedboat, only 10-15 minutes and by long-tail boat, about 45 minutes, which is quite convenient and the cost is not very high. "Koh Hae" is an island with a white sandy beach. There are also fertile shallow coral reefs, crystal clear waters, and many fish can





be seen swimming. The underwater world is on the west side. Brain coral lettuce coral Deer antler coral, plate coral, long line, and fish, big and small, colorful and beautiful, such as butterflyfish, nori fish, parrotfish, angelfish, etc., tourists can Snorkeling Using a diving mask and snorkel, you can see the beautiful underwater world. The back of the island also has a beautiful beach with clean,

clear water, suitable for those who want privacy. Things to do on Coral Island There are various water activities such as jet-skiing, banana boat, parachute boat, or snorkeling to see fish, coral, parasailing, sea walker, etc.

Noon Lunch at the restaurant

Afternoon Take you on a journey **Chalong Temple (Wat Chaitharam)** is about 8 kilometers from Phuket Town. The story of the great prestige of Luang Por Cham. It is a page of history that Phuket people will never forget. And today, both tourists and Phuket residents still travel to pay homage to his statue, including Luang Pho Chuang. Another famous guru is always seen at Chalong Temple, also



known as Wat Chaitharam. Tales of holiness The sanctity and virtue of Luang Por Cham This occurred in the days of fighting with the rebellious Chinese. Or known as "Ung Yi," which Luang Por Cham has provided assistance to the villagers. and gave a white cloth to be a morale and morale in the battle until finally won later later He was given the title of

Phra Bat Somdet Phra Chulachomklao Chao Yu Hua (Rama V) as Phrakhrui Wisuthiwongsachan Yanmuni, who has been revered by Phuket residents ever since. and in addition to Luang Pho Chaem, There are also Luang Por Chuang and Luang Por Kluam. which is famous for concocting herbs and treating diseases. which has always been respected by people. Even though these people have passed away, the faith of the people of Phuket has never weakened. In addition to the story of the faith of Luang Por Cham Inside the temple, there is also Phra Mahathat Chedi Phra Chom Thai Baramee, which according to history, the Abbot of Wat Samphothiham Sri Lanka gave the Buddha's relics which used to be in the chedi of Anuradhapura, the former capital of Sri Lanka, to Wat Chaitharam. and contained in this relic for the general public to worship. Then you can take photos and sip coffee at [Rawai Ceramic Cafe](#).



Evening Take you to see the sunset at [Promthep Cape](#), one of the most beautiful sunset viewing spots in Thailand. It is the southernmost cape of Phuket Island, approximately 19 km from the city. Surrounded by sugar palm trees that intersect The swaying grass on the right is Nai Harn Beach and Koh Man. On the left side, you can see Nai Ya Beach, which is a small beach in



general. In the evening, they come together to watch the sunset at Laem Phromthep. If you visit on a good day, the sky is open, there are few clouds, and the sunset at Laem Phromthep will be very beautiful. If you come in the

summer, there are fields. The golden grass was covered up, very beautiful. Overlooking Koh Kaew Noi Koh Kaew Yai and Kao Man in the rainy season will be It is green around Laem Phromthep, a large rock when the waves are strong, white bubbles can be seen. Hit the rocks. Very beautiful. Go up the hill to Laem Phromthep Distance up about 695 meters. There is a parking lot. From the parking lot, there are stairs going up to the hill to see the sunset view. Before sunset, tourists may take a walk on the top of the road or maybe go down to see the view at the tip of the cape. We have to walk down for about 1 km. The walking distance is quite steep. have to walk down caution In addition to the beauty of the setting sun, Laem Phromthep also has the Kanchanaphisek Lighthouse, another point of interest. Built to commemorate 50 years of his reign, this lighthouse is also used as a navigational mark. Because Phuket is considered one of the centers of important marine transportation routes in the Andaman Sea.

18.00 **Take you to dinner at the restaurant.** After the meal, take you back to relax at The Royal Paradise Hotel & Spa.

Day 3, Wat Phra Thong - Mae Zhu, souvenirs from Phuket Town - Bangkok

Morning **Have breakfast at the hotel restaurant.** After the meal, you collect your luggage to check out of the hotel, and they take you to [Wat Phra Thong](#), or "Wat Phra Phut," located not far from Phuket International Airport. It is also one of the most famous ancient temples in Phuket. There are also legends and sacred stories of the Big Buddha, who emerged from the ground with only half of his body. as well In addition, within the temple, there is also an exhibition of the local





museum at Wat Phra Thong Museum, which collects antiques. Many ancient Phuket appliances are but the temple does not allow photography inside. who likes history and would like to understand Phuket more must go see for yourself Then take you to buy souvenirs at Mae Zhu, a souvenir shop in Phuket town.

Noon Lunch at the restaurant

Afternoon Then travel to take you out of Phuket. Return to Suvarnabhumi Airport (Bangkok) by Thai VietJet Air, flight VZ 2303, with a flight time of around 1 hour and 30 minutes.
