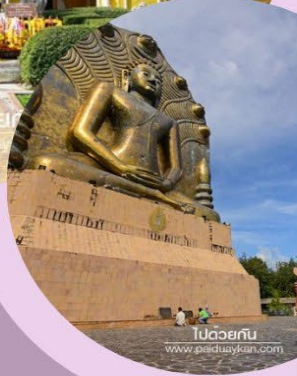


# PRAJINBURI

Day 1 - Depart from Bangkok – Prachin Buri Province – Lum Mueang –  
Monument to the Hands of the King – Phan Hin Archaeological Site –  
Kabin Chaloe Rat Park

06.00 A.M. Depart from Bangkok to Prachinburi Province travel by car. (Duration: 2 hours 30 minutes)

8.30 A.M. Arrive at Prachinburi Province, Take you to **Lum Mueang**. Ancient Ruins It is a strange archaeological site, there is no clear evidence indicating that this mysterious ancient site was built for what purpose? It has a diameter of about 0.40 meters, a depth of about 0.50 meters, arranged in a line similar to a Khanom Krok furnace.

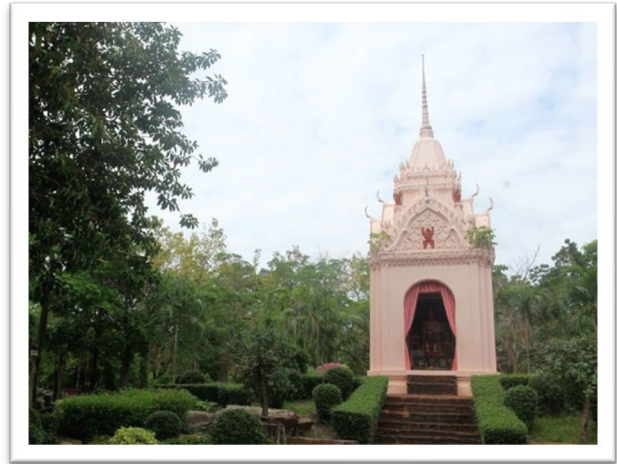


Each hole is approximately 1 meter apart, located in Nang Amornthewi or at Ban Khok Khwang. Si Maha Phot District Prachinburi Province. Proceed to **the handicraft monument**, Prachinburi province. It is a historical tourist attraction a



place that creates valuable and important memories for the people of Prachinburi Province. since the reign of 5 Monuments with handwriting. It is located in the Sri Maha Bodhi pattern park, Si Maha Phot District. An interesting thing is the laterite slab inscribed with the King's monogram. This is an ancient site The temple in the Lopburi period is around the 12th-13th Buddhist century, after the Fine Arts Department has registered the hand-painted monument. It was a national historic site

in 1981. Nowadays, only the laterite base remains. And a Mondop was built to cover it inside to enshrine the image of King Rama V as a monument that represents the handwriting of King Chulalongkorn from the Fine Arts Department.

**Have lunch and Free time**

In the afternoon Travel to **Phan Hin Ancient Site**. It looks like a large archaeological site made of laterite. The plan of this ancient monument, Phan Hin, is a square, 15.5 meters long and 15.5 meters wide, 3.5 meters high, with porches protruding on all four sides. The north porch has signs of pillar holes. Archaeologists and historians believe that it may be the wooden stair columns that rise the ancient buildings of Phan Hin on the top of the building was found a pillar pit, which was assumed to be a pillar of a shingled building, and found around laterite rod carved into the shape of an



alms bowl. The diameter is about 1 meter. Ancient ruins or relics look superficially like normal ruins. It's just an old brick and stone, but deep down, every part that makes up this ancient site is steeped in history. Invaluable culture and art cannot be replaced. Continue your journey to **Kabin Chaloeprat Park**. It was built to honor His Majesty the King on the 50th anniversary of his reign in 1996, located in the district Kabin Buri District, Prachin Buri Province, which has a large area. It is a recreational area for people in Kabinburi and nearby areas. Kabin Chaloeprat Park is both a sports field. At the gym, running, walking, family picnics, and is one of the must-see natural sights in Kabinburi District Because some parts of the Kabin Chaloeprat Park a large swamp which the villagers call Nong Pla Khaeng (The stingray is a type of freshwater

fish. It is believed that the name Nong Pla Khaeng is a swamp in Kabin Chaloem Rat Park. In the past, there should have been a large number of disgusting fish until it was called Nong Pla Khaeng) at Kabin Chaloem



Rat Park. When the sun is fading behind the horizon will shine a golden light that catches the eye Overlaid along the area by Roll It invites you to take your attention away from the surroundings to come and watch. At Kabin Chaloem Rat Park, it is one of the sunset viewing spots that our team is impressed with.

In the afternoon **Take you to The Green Residence Hotel, have dinner and relax.**

Day 2 – Emerald Pool Archaeological Site – Sri Mahosot Ancient Site – Melon House – Bangkok (-/-)

In the morning Have breakfast at the hotel room, and store luggage. After that we will take you to the **Emerald Pool Archaeological Site**. It is located at Wat Sa Morakot, Khok Thai Sub-district. It is a large group of Buddhist archaeological sites. That overlap many times starting before the 14th Buddhist century onwards until the 18th Buddhist century consists of laterite and brick buildings. Most



of the remaining are only the foundation of the building. During the excavation, a pair

of Buddha footprints were discovered. Carved on laterite his Majesty carved a Dharma Chakra embossed on both sides. And there is also a carved cross of ten mouths that is not as good as the eye sees. Come to Prachin without having to find an opportunity to experience the grandeur of important religious sites built from the 14th to the 18th Buddhist era, such as the 'Emerald Pool Archaeological Site' by yourself once. The place was named after the large pond in the area. But the highlight of this place is the two footprints of the Dvaravati to Lopburi era that were excavated as deep carvings on natural laterite slabs and with a total width of two feet of 3.10 meters and a length of more than 3 meters. That makes this pair of footprints considered the oldest and largest in Thailand. When observing on the King's feet, a bas-relief chakra appears. And there is a trace of a cross in the middle, presumably a groove for the king's tier. Not far away, there is a sacred pond with many Buddha images and relics in it. Looking at the surrounding buildings, you can see that they are influenced by ancient Khmer culture. Whether the emerald pool, which serves as a large reservoir looks like a bar of the Khmer. That is, a rectangle large enough to hold water all year round. The Fine Arts Department also takes care to have water as full as in the past. In addition, this place also has Sa Kaeo and Sa Kwan, an ancient pond used for rituals. Notice from the animal carvings on it. Laterite at the edge of the pool the Lotus Pond and Sri Mahosot Building are the venues for exhibiting knowledge about the ancient city of Si Mahosot and displaying artifacts excavated in this area. Moreover, we will continue our journey to [Ancient City of Si Mahosot](#). It is located at Ban Khok Wat, Khok Phip Sub-district, which is a large ancient city in the Dvaravati period, oval or rectangular with rounded corners. It has an area of approximately 276.68 acres. has the appearance of a city with a moat and the embankment of the city wall surrounds the moat, there are more than 100 ancient monuments, mounds, ponds, and wells scattered everywhere. It is assumed that it was built in the Dvaravati period. Most of the evidence found is related to Brahmanism or Hinduism, such as the oval shape of the ancient city of Dvaravati. Most of the evidence found in this city is often associated with Brahmanism or Hinduism, such as devaluing, idols, lingams. Because of the important ancient sites that were found, including the ancient city center Age around the 18th Buddhist century as a group of temples laterite base brick top Behind there is a well made of laterite. Antiques that have been excavated include various idols and pottery fragments from the Lop Buri, Sukhothai, Ayutthaya, and Rattanakosin periods. The Golden Mountain is around chedi that looks like an onion, Dvaravati

period. Archaeological site number 25 is a temple, the foundation of the building is a rectangular shape. laterite Around the 11th-12th Buddhist century, Sa Kaeo archaeological site is an ancient pond. Pond dug into layers of laterite nature. It is located in the southwest outside the city of Si Mahosot. The vowel is a square shape. There is a way down to make a ladder on the wall on all sides of the pool. There are bas-relief carvings in the form of animals such as elephants, lions, pigs, Kinnaree, and python snakes. These animals are noble creatures, presumed to be sacred pools used for religious ceremonies. Age around the 6th-11th Buddhist century.
