**Day 1 Travel from Bangkok - Ratchaburi - Wat Muang - Street Art Ban Pong - Naboon Beef Garden - Alpaca Hill – Pong Yup Hutayun (-/-/-)**

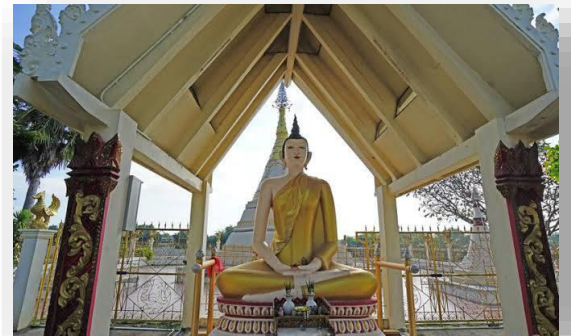
**08.00** Depart from Bangkok to Ratchaburi The travel time is around 2 hours.

**10.00** Arriving in [Ratchaburi](#) led you to [Wat Muang](#). This temple is regarded as the



center of the Thai Raman heart of the Mae Klong River basin. It is an old temple that is over 200 years old. What is remarkable is the Mon chedi located on the waterfront, visible from far away from the Klong River, including the old temple, beautiful with stucco patterns, carvings, and paintings that decorate the gable area and

surrounding windows, including the walls of the front and rear doors. These are all very valuable to preserve for children to study and appreciate very much a large pagoda in the Mon style, flanked by a swan pole, symbolizes the national identity out of the swan poles found in Mon temples often face the direction of the location of the city of Hongsawadee. Hair is a fiber that can be used to make clothing. Major Mom Rajawongse Peeranupong Phanuphan has initiated the breeding of alpacas in Thailand. The species is derived from Australia. He has established Alpaca

Hill to be the first and only breeding farm in Thailand in Suan Phueng District, Ratchaburi Province, on a green area of over 250 rai in the land of good weather all year round. Tourists who visit Alpaca Hill find You will be able to get up close and personal with the rare alpacas from Australia, be able to feed them the food provided by the farm, and take pictures. There will be a kiosk for tourists to visit. Alpacas are peaceful, friendly creatures. Therefore, it can be compatible with people of all genders and ages. It is an animal that lives in its natural environment. Therefore, tourists who come to see Alpaca Hill (Alpaca Hill) should refrain from making loud noises. Refrain from taking pictures with flash and feed the animals provided by the farm. Refrain



from feeding food from outside. Alpaca Hill also has other cute and friendly animals such as dwarf kangaroos, giant rabbits, and guinea pigs. It is also a breeding ground for good alpacas. best as well and take you to [Pong Yup Hutayon](#), a wonderland that nature has created. Visit the strange beauty and wonder. Pong Yup is a strangely shaped gorge of land, nicknamed "Pong



Yup" from the word "Pong", is wet ground with mineral salt mixed with wildlife that likes to fall down. Come to dig and eat, and "collapse" is the subsidence of the ground in that area. Therefore, the villagers collectively called it "Pong Yup" due to the nature of the land in that area. Pong collapse is caused by the collapse of the land. caused by the action of groundwater, including wind and rain erosion. The hard soil became a pillar of soil and a curtain of soil, causing a strange shape of gorges. the collapse of this ground continues to happen all the time. Similar to "Phae Mueang Phi" at Phae Mueang Phi Forest Park, located in Mae Lai Subdistrict, Nam Cham Subdistrict, Thung Hong Subdistrict, Mueang District, Phrae.

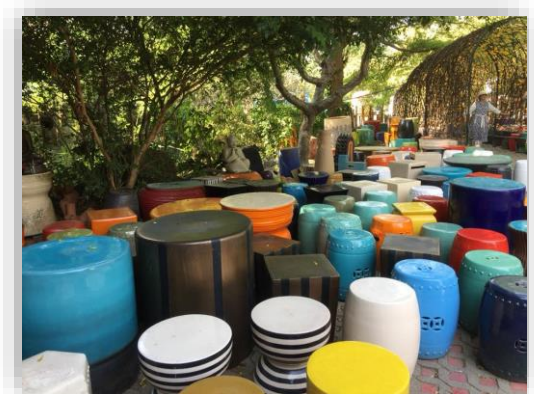

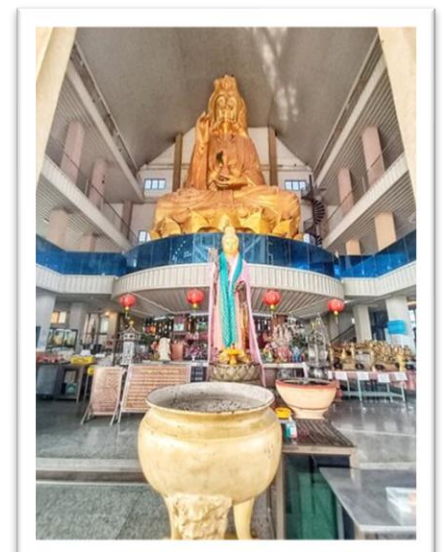
**Afternoon**      take you to [Wat Nong Hoi Forest Park](#) Wat Nong Hoi is a temple built in 1873,



located in Khao Raeng Subdistrict, Mueang District, Ratchaburi Province, approximately 12 km from the city center. The Bodhisattva Guan Yin is 16 meters tall and has a lap width of 9 meters.

"Khao Chao Mae Kuan I'm, Wat Nong Hoi, which is located on the top of Vulture Hill and on

the other side of the mountain (Khao Big Buddha), enshrines the Rattanakosin Maha Muni Buddha image. (Luang Por Yai) is a temple where many believers come to worship Buddha images. At present, Wat Nong Hoi is known to the general public. both in the province and upcountry. It is rumored to be very sacred. No matter



what you ask, you will be satisfied. There will always be people coming to worship each other. Especially on festival days or holidays, for the Kuan Yin Vihara, there will be two Viharas located close to each other with a face full of mercy. The small temple will enshrine the goddess statue in the same way as the main viharan but there will be only one.



and take you to [Khao Nag Stone Park](#). It is a stone park and a forest plantation located at Tambon Koh Phlaphla, Amphoe Mueang. Originally, it was an important rock blasting and crushing site in Thailand since the early Rattanakosin period, because it is good quality cement. Within this, Khao Ngu Stone Park There are many archaeological attractions. There are three caves on the mountain: Tham Rishi, Tham Fa

Tho, and Tham Chin-Cham. These caves are found with carved Buddha images. These Buddha images are carved in stone on the walls of the cave. They are Buddha images from the Dvaravati period. Each cave is not far from the other. But you have to walk up the stairs to climb the mountain quite high. In the cave in Khao Ngu Stone Park (Pralamphadhasana), his right hand is in the posture of preaching the Dharma. His left hand is placed in the shaft (Witakamutra). On the other side of the cave wall is a standing Buddha image in the posture of descending from Daowadung. There are also many other Buddha images in the posture of meditation. Tham Fa Tho finds a reclining Buddha image in the attitude of nirvana, with a light and stucco pattern depicting a sal tree. Above there is a picture of Thep Chuam. On the opposite wall, there are images of two disciples, a Chinese cave, two carved Buddha images, a meditation posture, and a hand showing wisdom. There are traces of plaster over it. The amulet near the mouth of the cave is broken and incomplete.
