

Day 1 Don Mueang International Airport - Sakon Nakhon Airport - Phra That Choeng Chum Temple - Chaloe Phrakiat Lotus Park- Tha rae Village (/_/_)

05.00 Assemble at Nok Air check-in counter, 3rd floor, Domestic Terminal, **Don Mueang International Airport**. Our staff will welcome and facilitate you.

07.00 Depart from **Don Mueang International Airport** to Sakon Nakhon Airport by Nok Air, **flight DD360**. The flight would take around 1 hour 15 minutes.

08.15 Arrive at **Sakon Nakhon Airport**. Pick up your luggage.

Then take you to **Phra That Choeng Chum Temple**. It is an important sanctuary of Sakon Nakhon. The top

of the tier above the relics is made of pure gold. There are footprints of 4 Buddha images. It is a sacred land, as the saying goes, “Is a time that will benefit more than worshipping the relics that cover the footprints




of 4 Lord Buddhas?” It is believed that the virtue of worshipping Phra That Choeng Chum will bring prosperity, prosperity, and harmlessness to oneself and family.

Noon **Lunch at the restaurant.**

Afternoon Take you to [Chaloem Phrakiat Lotus Park](#).

It is located opposite Bueng Nong Han, Muang District, Sakon Nakhon Province. There are more than hundreds of different types of colorful lotus flowers. It



is the largest lotus park in Thailand. This is a place of study and research for students and the general public. It is also a place for recreation and tourist attractions of the province. The highlight of the lotus park is the large lotus pond with a long red wooden bridge to walk to see the beauty of the lotus flowers around the pond. There is a pavilion in the middle of the lotus pond for relaxing.



Then take you to [Tha rae Village](#). It is commonly known as the village with the largest Christian population in Thailand. It is an old village that is over 100 years old. The tourists will see the beauty of ancient houses, which most were built in the style of European-style cement buildings in the French-Vietnamese architectural style.

Evening **Dinner at the restaurant.** After that, check in at **Dusit Hotel**.

Day 2 Tham Pha Daen Temple - Pha Phaya Tao Ngoi - Siri Mangkala, Tao Ngoi Temple - Kramsakon

Morning **Breakfast at hotel's dining room.**



Take you to **Tham Pha Daen Temple.**

It is one of the places that should not be missed in Sakon Nakhon.

The highlight is the large serpent statue carved on the rock cliff, unique and exquisite. Pha Phaya Tao Phu Pha Daen is beautiful. The temple is located on a high mountain amidst shady nature.

There is a garden with colorful

flowers, various plants and a simulated

waterfall. There is a coffee shop to experience the shady nature and can see panoramic views of the green mountains as well.

Noon **Lunch at the restaurant.**

Afternoon Take you to **Pha Phaya Tao Ngoi.** Pha Phaya Tao Ngoi is not just the name of the famous song of Mr. Jintra Poonlarp. Tao Ngoi that we are familiar with is Pha Phaya Tao Ngoi, the symbol of Tao Ngoi District, Sakon Nakhon Province. The image of Pha



Phaya Tao Ngoi was sculpted to become a sacred object that was revered by



people in the district and in nearby provinces. It is believed that if anyone comes to worship, it will bring back longevity and good fortune. Then take you to [Siri Mangkala, Tao Ngoi Temple](#) The temple is located along the road opposite the Pha Phaya Tao Ngoi statue. It is the sacred temple of the local people. In front of the temple are a nameplate and two serpentine statues surrounding it. Next to the label is Pha Phaya Tao Ngoi Chedi, which is a replica of Phra That Phanom. Inside, the chedi contains the Buddha's relics to pay homage to for auspiciousness.




After that, take you to [Kramsakon](#). It is a famous shop that sells indigo-dyed cotton products from hand-woven and natural colors. They transform indigo fabric into various products such as clothes, scarves, hats, bags, shoes, dolls, keychains with garden design, modern, easier to use in daily life. There is also a workshop for everyone to make indigo fabric as well.

Evening

Dinner at the restaurant. Then back to **Dusit Hotel**.

Day 3 Achan Fan Acharo Museum - Museum of Venerable Mun Bhuridhatta Thera –
Phra That Narai Cheng Weng - Sakon Nakhon Airport - Don Mueang International Airport

Morning **Breakfast at hotel's dining room.**



Take you to [Achan Fan Acharo Museum](#) at Wat Pa Udomphon. It is a temple where Phra Ajahn Fan Ajaro, a famous guru monk who practiced Vipassana meditation, used to live in the Buddhist Lent. His Majesty King Bhumibol Adulyadej came to lay the foundation stone in 1982. The museum building is located within the garden. The museum is the beauty of the

unique building in the shape of a three-tiered lotus-leaf round pagoda. Inside, there is a life-sized statue of Phra Ajahn Fan, sitting with his feet hanging down and holding a cane in his hand. There is a glass cabinet containing the ashes and displays the artifacts of him and his history as well.

Noon **Lunch at the restaurant.**

Afternoon Take you to Museum of Venerable [Mun Bhuridhatta Thera](#) at Wat Pa Sutthawat. The

museum is constructed in a modern architectural style built with clay tiles. Inside the museum, there is a statue of Phra Ajahn Mun in meditation posture. There is a glass cabinet containing his ashes transformed into white crystal glass raised on a marble base. There is a cabinet showing the state's belongings. There is also show Ajahn Mun's history.





Then take you to **Phra That Narai Cheng Weng**. It is an important historical site of

Sakon Nakhon Province. It is a relic built of sandstone with a Khmer prang style. The base was made of large laterite. The chedi is rectangular with arches on each side under the upper arch engraved with the image of Narai Bantomsin decorated with Kanok on

the opposite side. The four corners of the

Phra That are in the form of a five-headed Naga.

After that, take you to **Sakon Nakhon Airport**.

17.45 Take you to **Don Mueang International Airport** by Nok Air, **flight DD369**. The flight would take around 1 hour 15 minutes.

19.00 Arrive at **Don Mueang International Airport** safely.
