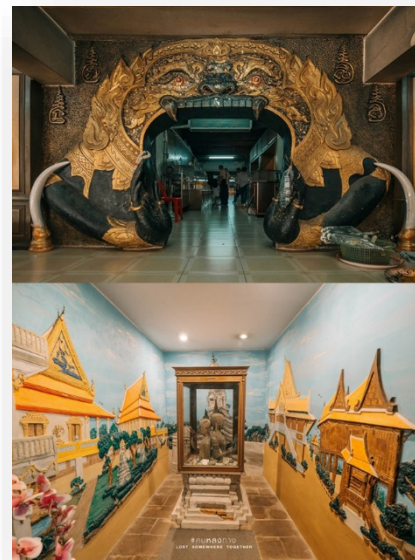

8.00 A.M. Depart from Bangkok to Samut Prakan Province The travel time is approximately 30 minutes.



9.30A.M. Arrive at **Samut Prakan Province**, take you to **Sakhla Temple**, located in Na Kluea Subdistrict, Phra Samut Chedi District. Samut Prakan Province. It is a temple that is ancient. It is the center of the mind of the community in the area. The highlight of this temple is that there are Phra Prang En and Luang Por To in the chapel. The lower part of the chapel There will be a pass through the popular Rahu because it seems to be

bad luck here, which will have both the son of Nimit Ek, the ancient Buddha image, and the Twin Buddha images facing each other. that have recently been excavated "Prang Lean" as we see it. It is an old pagoda. It is located along the canal in the past, it wasn't leaning like what we see today. Until more than a hundred years ago had a flood caused the ground to float on the mud that collapsed so the prang was tilted to the west by about 15 degrees, but after that time it did not tilt further. So, it was left to lean as a symbol of Ban Sakhla. As for the surrounding pagodas, there will be a glass wall around the 4 corners. On each side of the glass wall, there will be an arch as the entrance to the prang and the important tradition here is to cover the prang. There will be a red cloth parade around the community along with



a ritual sacrifice, to worship the prang and put that cloth up to cover the slanted pagoda. In addition, inside Wat Sakla, there is a museum under the church building and vihara. This is where locals and tourists use it to pass under the Viharn and Luang Por To's base. to enhance auspiciousness Because it is believed to bring good luck and escape from various obstacles and can also walk inside the museum. After that take you on a journey to **Phra Samut Chedi Temple**. It is located on Suksawat Road Pak Khlong Bang Pla Kot Subdistrict in the Phra Samut Chedi Temple on the bank of the Chao Phraya River. It can be said that this is the most important place of worship. When Phra Samut Chedi is the seal of Samut Prakan Province, which the townspeople call in another name. "Phra Chedi Klang Nam" was originally located on an island surrounded by water but later the river became shallower until the land was connected. And it is also an important chedi that will take up to 3 reigns until the construction is completed. In the past, Somdej Phra Buddha Loetla Napalai, King Rama 2, graciously commissioned King Rama IX of Muen Jetsadabodin and Chao



Phraya Phra Klang (Dis Bunnag) to be the mother of the building of 6 fortresses, after 3 years, it was completed. Graciously build a pagoda on the sandy beach at the end of the Phi Phi Samut Fort to commemorate and commemorate the name "Phra Samut Chedi", but died before it was finished. When Her Royal Highness Princess Maha Chakri Sirindhorn ascended the throne as King Rama III, he was graciously pleased to continue the construction until the completion. It is a square chedi with twelve wooden indented corners, 20 meters high in 1828. Later, King Mongkut Rama IV ordered a technician to model around chedi in Ayutthaya to wear it over the former chedi. Until it reached a height of 39.75 meters and also brought 12 Buddha relics from the Grand Palace to be packed instead of the original ones that were smuggled. Including graciously To build more places, such as the Chinese Pavilion, Tiananmen Tower Western building bell tower decorated with murals on the history of Samut Prakan and Phra Samut Chedi Including the viharn enshrined Buddha images in the



sea. The loss of royal assets in the construction of 588 weighs or 47,240 baht. At that time, it became an important center of Thai, Chinese and Western architecture. The Fine Arts Department announced that Phra Samut Chedi was registered as a national historic site in 1993. Samut Prakan residents will celebrate this national monument on the 5th day of the waning moon of the 11th lunar month with an annual ceremony to worship

Phra Samut Chedi. A large red cloth was invited to be placed on the Busabok. parade around

the city and cruise the Chao Phraya River to Phra

Pradaeng District then the parade came back to perform

the Thaksinawatra ceremony. Then take the Phra Samut

Chedi blanket. Including the people will pay homage to

King Rama 2 monument which is enshrined inside as well.

After paying homage to the Buddha image, then bring you

to travel **Erawan Museum** “History is the compass and

weighs 150 tons, towering over around building, totaling the height from the floor of the

building until the elephant's head is 43.60 meters, or about a 14-17-storey building. Its

monstrous black color and enormous size, and terrified to be seen from both the ground and

the air. In addition to the size of the elephant, inside the building is a collection of antiques.

The fine arts and fine arts of Thai art are equally large collections divided into 3 floors along

the Triphum, namely Suvarnabhumi in the basement. It shows the history of the museum and

collects various antiquities. The middle is the world. It is a dome-shaped building like the

entrance to Phra Sumen. It combines Western art and artisan craftsmanship from across the

country, such as a Western-style world map-shaped stained-glass ceiling, Benjarong,



alternating patterns with the colors of Nakhon Si Thammarat craftsmen, and the statue of the Gurud people and the serpent of the craftsman of Mueang Phet. The last one is the universe. located on the top floor inside the elephant's belly. It is enshrined relics and Buddha images from many eras. It is also decorated with tempera paintings on the ceiling telling the story of the solar system and on these 12 plots of land as a Himmapan forest park. It is magical floating sculptures from Thai literature inserted in rare flora from all over the country.
