First day Suvarnabhumi Airport (Bangkok) – Satun Province – Satun National Museum – Satun Street Art – National Geopark Committee – Thungwa Stagodon Museum – Le Stegodon Cave

07.00 departing from Suvarnabhumi Airport (Bangkok) to Stun Thai VietJet Air flight VZ 320 takes 1 hour and 30 minutes to fly.

08.30 Arrive at [Satun Province](#), take you on a journey [Satun National Museum](#) It is the building of the Kuden Mansion. It was built by Phraya Phuminatphakdi or Ton Ku Baharuddin Bin Tammahong, the city governor during the reign of King Chulalongkorn. It is colonial



European architecture. It was built to serve as the residence of King Rama V during his reign in the south. but he did not stay The appearance of the building is a two - storey building, characterized by an architectural style that combines beautifully with art, namely the western building. Doors and windows are arched according to Roman architecture. The roof uses clay tiles in the shape of banana cladding. The vent in front of the stairs is decorated with stars, which is a Muslim architecture. The building is 100 years old, it is the oldest

building in Satun. Later, it was used as an important place such as a residence and Satun City Hall. used as the Japanese Army Headquarters used as the Satun City Hall is the district office of Mueang Satun It is now a school and is the Office of the Internal Security Operations Command (RACC) with its historical significance and outstanding architectural style. The Fine Arts Department has announced the registration of Kuden Mansion as a National Historic Site. and has made improvements to the building to be used as the National Museum of the city collect information and exhibits the city's history and traditions.

vertebrae and molars. Pieces of ancient stone axes, more than 5,000 years old, and most importantly, there has been an important discovery of evidence of elephant stegodon. extinct for billions of years The discovery of the stegodon elephant in the Satun area is considered the discovery of the remains. Primitive is the first and only in the southern area. In addition, Banana Cave has the beauty of stalagmites and stalactites. The atmosphere inside the cave had a wind blowing through it. and was as wide as the dwelling place of ancient humans. By this cave, the locals in the area call it Tham Le. It is about 2 kilometers long. The end of the cave can penetrate the Andaman area. By traveling by kayak or rubber boat and from the excavation of a large number of fossils. Thungwa Subdistrict Administrative Organization has established an elephant museum. primitive It is the only local geological museum in Thailand that operates in this field. to collect Fossils and ancient artifacts as a learning center open to the general public.

Afternoon arrive at [Le Stegodon Cave](#), a cave nestled in a long limestone mountain range.



looks like a tunnel under a mountain. The distance from the mouth of the cave to the exit is about 4 kilometers, takes about 2-3 hours to see. Beautiful with stalactites and stalagmites, and is a cave with the fossilized jaw teeth of "Elephant Stegodon" that must be kayaked to the end of the cave. Then change to a motor boat ashore at Ban Tha Aoi Pier. There will be officials and villagers watching. Flashlights and life jackets are available. Clothes should be ready to get wet. You must

contact in advance before visiting, due to sea level checks and visit times each day. "Le Stegodon Cave" is a place to visit Satun in the style of adventure. The cave is in a limestone mountain range, winding road, about 4 kilometers distance from the cave mouth to the exit. Fossils of Stegodon elephants were found. The way to visit is canoeing through the caves. See glittering stalactites and stalagmites. Then there will be a complete mangrove forest area to see as well.



15:00 Take you to check in and stay at Seesea Resort, invite you to leave your luggage and check in to your room. Free time.

Day 2 The Time Traveller's Bridge – Thungwa Natural tie dye – Khuankhong Garden –
Phu Pha Phet Caves

Petra National Park, Satun Province, which is a mountain called

sea. On the northeast side is a sandy bay that curves into the land and is the location of Mu Ko
Petra National Park. There is a pedestrian bridge
from the Mu Ko Petra National Park office along the
eastern cliffs. It then curves west through the

Therefore, the material obtained from the mangrove forest was used to make color, which is mainly used in the tabun tree. Because the Tabun will be effective. The fruit of the Tabun has a white resin. The white rubber when chemical reaction turns the rubber brown. Can be used to dye the fabric with a

pattern according to your imagination. With a simple 5 steps process 1.Choose a pattern, 2.tie the fabric, 3.Dip the paint, 4.Drop in the lye and 5.Dry it in the sun, it will result in a unique work in word Even those who destroy the same as us When the results come out, there will be more or less differences. in order to have a link with Satun Geopark At present, the natural dyeing cloth group, Ban Tha Aoi, has created various patterns such as ancient horseshoe crabs. ancient sea snails Primitive sea squid, etc. For agencies, people and students who are interested in creating imaginations. Then take you to [Phu Pha Phet Caves](#), located at Village Moo. 9, Ban Pa Phon, Palm Phatthana Sub-district, Manang District, Satun Province. It is beautiful, with high ceilings. Inside the cave looks strange and wonderful. Filled with stalagmites and stalactites, the interior is



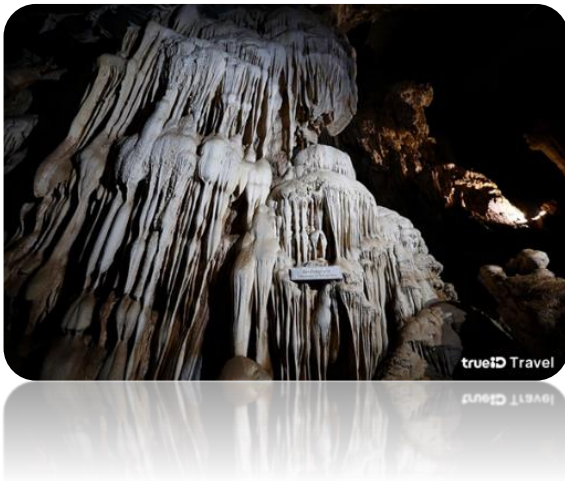
divided into no less than 20 rooms. Experience the wonders of the 4th largest cave in the world, located in Satun Province. Discovery of Phu Pha Phet Cave It happened when archaeologists of the Office of Archeology and the 10th National Museum of Songkhla province explored the cave area according to the legend of Phra Thudong named " Luang Ta Pang " who discovered this cave. After completing the survey have found archaeological evidence that presumably Tham

Phu Pha Phet is probably inhabited by prehistoric humans about 3,000 years ago, where ancient human bones were found in the skull. fragments of clay pots coated with a rope pattern At the bottom of the container there is a clinging shell. And since then, it has been developed as a tourist attraction. showpiece of the province The miracles in this cave appear through stalagmites and stalactites. with sparkling sparkles that look like many diamond scales Inside the cave were allocated up to 20 different rooms. There is a wooden bridge leading the way through the cave and lighting is installed. The interesting rooms such as " Phu Pha Phet Room " are considered the most important highlight of the cave ever. With the stalagmites and stalactites in this room sparkling like sparkling diamond scales. When it hits the light, it will look beautiful, magnificent beyond description. " Light Room " Emerald deep inside the cave with a distinctive feature at the ceiling of the cave in that area chimney Let the natural light shine through and hit the green stalagmites and stalactites. This made the courtyard of this room become a beautiful, exotic emerald green. The light will pass through the chimney into a beautiful beam of light during May and June around 15.00 -15.20 hrs. It is a highlight



that everyone wants to come and experience. “ Man Phet Room ” has a cluttered appearance, the curtains are hung in a gap “ Nak Room ” has stalagmites.

The body resembles a large snake or a serpent. “Coral Room” contains stalagmites and stalactites similar to corals in the sea. In addition, if observed from the types of stalagmites (Stalagmite), there are 31 types of different names according to the shapes found, such as mushrooms, arches, diamond rings, diamond rivers, and heads. There are 4 types of stalactites, namely, dome-shaped serpents, serpents, Buddha heads, inverted lotuses, and stalactites. A jellyfish and a curtain for a monolithic type (Column in cavern), which is a part of stalagmites



and stalactites converge to form a still ceiling in the cave. There are as many as 14 caves and the monolithic types also have different characteristics, known as diamond pillars or stalactites or solar pillars. As for the step wells, it looks like the edge of a limestone waterfall that is layered like steps. Within the Phu Pha Phet Cave, there are 5 places, each of which is found in a different shape, such as a staircase, a basin, a concert stage. Walking inside is quite

comfortable. due to the high ceiling of the cave And there is also the construction of a wooden bridge to make walking easier. Traveling to this cave can be visited in every season. But the period to be able to see the beam of light passing through the cave in the Emerald Room is in the period from May to June around 15.00-15.20 hrs. depending on the weather conditions.

Day 3 Tarutao National Park - Bangkok

In the morning Have breakfast at the hotel restaurant. After food, you can store your luggage for Check out from the hotel and then take you to Tarutao National Park By taking a boat at Pak Bara Pier, which is the pier to pass through Tarutao National Park. It takes about 1 hour and 30 minutes by boat to Tarutao National Park. It is the first marine national park of Thailand. famous

for history and the beauty of nature Located in the Andaman Sea About 40 kilometers from the city of Satun, Tarutao National Park. Thailand's first marine national park Famous for the history and beauty of nature. It has also been praised by UNESCO. to become (ASEAN Heritage Parks and Reserves) as well.

Tarutao National Park Consists of 51 large and small islands, 7 large islands, namely Koh Tarutao, Koh Adang, Koh Rawi, Koh Lipe, Koh Klang, Koh Batuang and Koh Bissi, divided into 2 large islands, namely the Tarutao Islands and the Adang - Ravi

Islands For Koh Lipe, it is becoming more and more popular quickly. The island is more prosperous than other islands, which will have boat services to take tourists from Koh Tarutao to Koh Lipe and other islands. The beauty of Tarutao National Park is complete, both in the sea, sandy beach and in the forest, you can see the beauty of the beautiful scenery, see the underwater world, wildlife, plants and impressive atmosphere at various attractions and activities. interested
