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Day 1: Bangkok – Sing Buri Province – Phikun Thong Temple - Retro Thai market, Ban Bang Rachan -Wad Pho Kao Ton - Heroes' Park Bang Rachan Camp - Wat Phra Non-Chak Si Worawihan – Wat Na Phra That – Singburi Retro Market, 130 R.E.

6 A.M. Depart from Bangkok to Singburi Province, using the estimated travel time

2 hours.

8 A.M. Arrive at Singburi Province. We traveled to Wat Phikun Thong, located on



the eastern bank of the Noi River, about 16 km from the city of Singhaburi. It is a large temple on the banks of the Noi River. One of the importance of Singhaburi, the villagers call it Wat Luang Pho. Because it is a temple of Luang Pho Phae Phae's Buddhist Lent Phra Kechi Dang. Who died in 1999. Inside the temple, there is a museum of

Luang Pho Phae. show a story about the History and Attributes of Luang Por Phae from the past to the present. In addition, on the other side of the temple is a Buddha image in the posture of giving blessings. The largest one in Thailand is Phra

Phutthasuwanmongkolmahamuni, the size of the lap is 11 wa, 2 cubits, 7 inches, 21 wa, 1 creep, 3 inches in height. It is reinforced concrete. Decorated with natural gold mosaic 24 K. Around the main temple there is a sanctuary that enshrines Buddha images in various daily postures and there is also a Dharma Garden and interesting buildings





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Surrounded by a peaceful and shady atmosphere. Traveling from the city of Singburi take Highway No. 3032 towards Amphoe Khai Bang Rachan. Passing Wat Phra Non-Chakrasi Worawihan about 5 km. There will be a road along the irrigation canal on the left and turn into the road until passing Wat Wihan Khao for about 1 km, you will arrive at Wat Phikun Thong, the principal Buddha image of Wat Phikun Thong, a small Buddha image enshrined



on a multi-tiered base. To suit the size of the chapel, we will see a very small Buddha image. This Buddha image has the name Phra Buddha Sri Wiriyasopit, Reverend Father Si Kesaro, a teacher in the science of Luang Por Phae have abandoned the buffalo to Luang Pho Phae Luang Pho Phae wax figure. There is a royal wreath in the museum. In front of the building, there are many rows of chairs. For people who come to pay respect and worship Luang Pho Phae. Then

take you to a **retro Thai market in Ban Bang Rachan** Sing Buri, a legendary place of Ban Bang Rachan community, is located inside Wat Pho Kao Ton. This market highlights the traditional Thai way of life, emphasizing the atmosphere of the ancient market, along with many activities that Thai people can enjoy. Complemented by the service of carrying a saloon to watch the market for those who are tired. The highlight of this place is for those who like to take photos with the service of renting Bang Rachan dresses to walk others in a retro atmosphere, ready to shop and taste rare ancient sweets together. Anyone who likes it can

buy some souvenirs to bring home for grandparents and grandparents. Then take you to **Wat Pho Kao Ton or Wat Mai Daeng**, located at Mu 8, Bang Rachan Subdistrict, opposite Khai Bang Rachan Monument, Khai Bang Rachan District, Sing Buri Province. The highlight of Wat Pho Kao Ton is the symbol of the temple wall that was built as a replica of the camp wall because today it was the base. The stronghold of Bang Rachan villagers. Originally, used to be a place where Bang





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Rachan villagers used to be a stronghold against the Burmese army that attacked Ayutthaya in 1765. There is a Viharn of Phra Ajarn Thammachot Rangsi enshrined a statue where Phra Ajarn Thamma is located, Chote has been worshiped by the people of Singburi for a long time. Because he is the mascot and power of the villagers of Bang Rachan, the heroic people fight to defend the enemy and win. The area of Phra Achan Thammachot's cubicle is a place where people come to worship and pray for blessings on the very sacred shrine. There is a sacred pond where people often come to pray or ask for whatever they want. They will come to pay homage by carrying the amount of water on top to make vows when they wish. As I prayed, Phra Ajarn Thammachot is a monk with excellent magic and expertise in herbal medicine. Phra Ajarn Thammachot is the mascot and encouragement of the warriors of Bang Rachan camp. Phra Ajarn Thammachot originally stayed at Wat Doem Bang Nang ordained in Suphanburi. There was a war with the villagers of Sri Bua Thong, with Mr. Muang who invited him to come to Wat Pho Kao Ton at this time when the Burmese army came in. People escaped to survive and came together at Wat Pho Kao. A large number of trees caused a lot of diseases and ailments. The need for herbal medicines and holy water of Phra Arjarn Thammachot increased because Phra Arjarn Thammachot did not have a container that was large enough to meet. The needs of the villagers, especially those warriors who needed holy



water for encouragement in the battle. The teacher, therefore, poured holy water into a large pool to meet the needs of the villagers. The water in the pool is sacred until now. Finally, no one knows whether he died in Wat Pho Kao Ton if he escaped directly. Across Wat Pho Kao Ton, there is also a monument to the heroes of Bang Rachan Camp for future generations to pay homage to and also develop an area to build a museum showing the history of the 8 heroic battles of Singburi heroes.

At noon

Have lunch at restaurant.

In the afternoon Take you to see the Khai Bang Rachan Heroes Park, 15 kilometers from the city on Highway No. 3032, with an area of approximately 115 rai. Sing Buri is a



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province that has many historical attractions because there are many old temples and is a strategic city in the war. An important Ayutthaya period war with the most famous stories. This locality is the heroic deeds of the Bang Rachan villagers who had long resisted the Burmese army, so a monument to the heroes was erected to commemorate the event.

Important include Khai Bang Rachan Park as well as a historical tourist attraction that is currently being built as a recreational facility and has a museum to visit and study here, 15 kilometers from the city on Highway 3032 with an area of approx. 115 rai, His Majesty the King opened this monument on 29 July 1976. It is an arboretum with a beautiful atmosphere. Upon arrival, you will see a monument to the heroes of Khai Bang Rachan, a handsome sculpture of 11 leaders of Bang Rachan camp built by The Fine Arts Department appears prettier and dignified in Khai Bang Rachan Park. It is of great historical importance. In the 3rd month of the Year of the Rooster, 1765, the villagers of Bang Rachan joined forces to fight against the Burmese army, which was huge in number. Moreover, the Burmese army attacked this village 8 times, it took up to 5 months to overcome on the second waning moon of the 8th lunar month, 1766 B.E. It can be said that the villagers had resisted the army for a

long time with little strength for the current Bang Rachan camp simulated. Based on the style of the camp in ancient times, and within the area. There is also a building at the Center for Studying the History of Khai Bang Rachan Heroes, which has always organized an exhibition room, divided into different rooms as follows: the first room shows the story of Bang Rachan Camp, ancient



appliances, Noi Nang Yai River kiln source. The second exhibits the heritage of Sing Buri, the third room shows the way of life of the people of Sing Buri and the good things of Singburi. Then take you to Sih, **Mueang Sing Buri District**, Sing Buri Province, away from Sing Buri city, along the national route number 3032 (Sing Buri, Suphan Buri) distance of about 4 km. It is assumed that this temple was built before Ayutthaya as a royal capital. The large reclining Buddha image is the largest and longest Buddha image in the country, it was built a long time, so old that it is not known exactly what its history is. It has a very beautiful



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Sukhothai style Buddha image with a total length of 1 line, 3 wa 2 elbow 1 creep, and 7 inches. Face facing north, head facing east, right arm extended forward, not bent up to receive the head like in Thai style. There is also Phra Kaew Phra Kan as a Buddha image. Sitting in gilded lacquered stone and a sacred diamond and Buddha image cross-legged.

There is a large Sallangka tree, an important tree in the history of the Buddha, always blooming. Inside the temple there are still sacred things to pay respect to Worship in many places, including a large statue of Luang Por To at the entrance of the Viharn of Chao Mae Kuan Im before reaching the entrance, there are various kinds of souvenirs from Singburi. He gave a miracle to Asuraindra Hu who was a giant to reduce the view of Asuraintrahu who was considered to have a larger body than a human, therefore the Buddha created a body larger than a giant. "Luang Pho Phra Non" is a large and long Buddha image built by Thao U Thong has 3 lines, 3 wa, 2 cubits, 3 creeps, 7 inches (47.40 meters). The head points to the east, facing the north. Very beautiful. There is a legend that Singha Phahu has a father who is a lion. When he knows the truth. He thinks he is ashamed of his friends that his father is a beast. So, he kills the lion. After being afraid of sin and very sorry, he builds a Buddha image

by using gold bars. Growing a long handful, 1 line is the axis of the Buddha image. It was salvation and the Buddha image existed for Buddhists to worship for many generations until the reclining Buddha image collapsed into a mound long ago. Later, Thao U Thong led a merchant cart through this path and



found a gold core buried. Being in a mound and knowing about Singha Phahu having faith. And seeing benefits for Buddhism, he persuaded the merchants to construct this Buddha image by using the gold bars found as the core of the Buddha image until 1754 and B.E. In 1756, His Majesty King Bhumibol Adulyadej of Ayutthaya came to worship and repair the Buddha image, as well as build a new viharn, ubosot, and various sanctuaries. The fifth of Rattanakosin came to worship and on October 9, 1976, His Majesty King Bhumibol Adulyadej came to worship with the royal family. "Luang Por Phra Non-Chakkrasi" is a sacred object that holds precious miracles as a refuge and has historical significance. Then



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take you to **Wat Na Phra That.** Originally, the villagers called this temple Wat Hua Mueang. Later, in the reign of King Rama IV, it was renamed Wat Na Phra That. It was assumed that this area would be the location of the old city of Sing Buri. The importance of this temple is the 8wa high pagoda made in the shape of a demon garuda holding. A mace adorned above the altar



floor after it was added to the architecture in the early Ayutthaya art style by masonry added as a charonam arch on all four sides from the laterite base. Up to the east side of the prang is made of bricks with recessed corners, a prang made of bricks. The west is the Phra Viharn Luang and the west is the chapel and has several round chedis, a characteristic of late Ayutthaya-era architecture. The Fine Arts Department has formed. Registered as an ancient monument on March 8, 1935.

In the evening Take you to Singburi Retro Market. It is located in front of the Sing Buri Provincial Hall, R.E. 130, Mueang District, Sing Buri Province, held regularly on the first Friday of the month, the atmosphere is a retro-style Thai style of Singburi people to preserve Thai traditions by inviting vendors and visitors to dress in traditional Thai costumes, emphasizing retro dishes. Singburi's famous gourmet food and long drum dance performances are showing the battle of Bang Rachan villagers on Walking Street, R.S. 130, selling traditional Thai food, both savory dishes and traditional desserts by merchants and vendors. Unite to wear ancient clothes in the Ayutthaya and Rattanakosin periods such as the Tabengman dress and speak with. The ending the word "Chao", selling OTOP products and products in the 9101 projects to follow in the footsteps. Father under the royal umbrella to



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develop sustainable agriculture as well. In addition, there are more than 200 shops to sell, which has a lively atmosphere.





7 P.M. Take you to check in at **Chai Saeng Villa** or equivalent, invite you to store your luggage in the room and relax.



Day two: Phra Prang Muni Temple, Amphawan Temple, Kudi Thong Temple - Suan Phak Cafe - Bangkok (-/-/-)

In the morningHave breakfast at the hotel restaurant after meals, collect yourluggage to check out from the hotel, then take you. Travel to Wat Phra Prang Muni, located

in Muang Mu Sub-district, opposite Singburi Agricultural College. It is an old temple that is believed to have been built in the late Ayutthaya period. It is characterized by a tall, rectangular prang, which is assumed to be the origin of the temple's name. As for the principal Buddha image that is enshrined in the golden ubosot, named "Phra



Phu Khao Thong, Phra Prang Muni Temple was a model developed temple in 1993 and was an outstanding development temple in 1994, close to the Buddha image. Prang is a viharn that has enshrined sacred objects of the temple for a long time, namely Luang Por Yen, Luang Por Nak, and Luang Por Khao. Especially Luang Pho Yen, an ancient Buddha image. One of the pilgrims came to pray in the temple and took the holy water from Luang Por Yen, who at that time had but the head does not have a name. It is used to treat various diseases for the villagers to receive peace and happiness, so they are later called "Luang Por Yen". Until



now, besides the viharn, there is a sacred pond, an old amulet that the temple has dug. The soil in that area erases the viharn. Inside beautiful murals are showing the story of Hell, Heaven, Buddha history, and Buddha Jataka. Written around the year 1919 by Mr. Peng, a Laotian person. The back wall and on



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the opposite side of the main. Buddha image is a painting of the Buddha's life. The sidewall above the window writes about the 5 lives of the Tachachat on each side, while the sidewall between the window writes about Phra Malai and Hell Landscape in the back of the viharn. The Sri Maha Bodhi tree at the base of the tree has a Buddha image. Then take you to **Wat Amphawan**, located at Tambon Phrom Buri along Highway No. 36 Km 130. It is a famous temple in the practice of Vipassana meditation. Because of the reputation of Luang Por



Charanthit Thammamo or Phra Ratchasuthiyamongkol. As a monk who has made many contributions to Buddhism, this makes Wat Amphawan a center for meditation practice. There will be many people who are interested in studying the Dharma who come to practice the Dharma. Inside the temple, a large

almshouse has been prepared to prepare fresh food for those who are truly interested in the Dharma. The temple has existed since the Ayutthaya period by the Chinese, who traveled to trade during in Lop Buri stopped the boat. In front of Wat Amphawan and built a church for one after which a royal request was made. Two stone covers from King Narai the Great to be placed in the church and now a new church has been built, developing the area within the temple until it has been regarded as a model developed by the Department of Religion.

At noon

Have lunch at restaurant.



In the afternoon Take you to pay homage to the Buddha image at Wat Kudi Thong, located at Mu 3 in Bang Nam Chiao Subdistrict, about 400 meters from the city of Singburi. Clean bathrooms, two meditation halls, along with being a model developed in Singburi province, inside the temple there are also interesting things for tourists to visit, namely a mondo that looks like a twelve wooden



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recessed chedi built around 1900 by the Reverend Father Panya Utamaphichai. He has placed the Buddha's relics on top for people to pay homage to, and inside the Mondop is also a replica of the Buddha's Footprint. A metal replica of the Thai Phuan Folk Arts and Cultural Center, a cultural learning center that conveys the way of life of the villagers in the past through various antiquities such as Occupational tools, clothing, accessories, as well as various old vehicles. Then take you on a trip to take photos and sit and chill at **the vegetable garden cafe**. For anyone who likes to sit in a cafe that gives a homely feel, must be introduced to this vegetable garden cafe because just looking over the white fence with A large shop sign will reveal an old wooden house that is not heavily decorated, surrounded by plants and flowers. As soon as you enter the shop, you will be able to feel the aroma of coffee that permeates the exotic drink menu. New to eat, especially dessert menus, such as butterfly pea cake, young coconut, cookies, ice cream, orange tart, or fruit tart with custard cream. The menus are different each day. You can visit the shop page. I believe that anyone who comes will definitely fall in love with this style of cafe.
