Day 1 Bangkok - Surin - Chang Mop Temple- Phanom Sawai Forest Park – Surin National Museum
– Huay Saneng Reservoir (-/-/-)

05.00 Depart from Bangkok to Surin would take around 6 hours.

11.00 Arrive at [Surin](#). Take you to [Chang Mop Temple](#). It is a famous temple of Luang Pho Puan Kechi and an important place of Surin. It is beautiful and natural, suitable for

practicing Dharma and dharma tourism. Surin people and tourists popular worship Phra Phimon Phatthanathorn or Luang Pho Puan Woramankhalo (Waramankhalo abbot of Wat Chang Mop) (Wat Mongkhon Khacharam), Kap Choeng District, Surin, which is a famous monk who has the Brahma Viharn and a monk who makes benefits to the

people of Surin. He is a famous monk teacher of the

southeastern part of Thailand. He is merciful and always helps people who are in trouble. He always teaches people to adhere to the principles of Dharma, to be good at work, competent in honest occupation, and use economically. Even though he was already 87 years old, his body began to get sick with age and continued to receive treatment. Luang Por Phuan was still able

to practice religious activities on a daily. People

still believe in the strict observance of Luang Por.

They have to pay respects, pray and ask for

protection from him and it is believed that if one is

blessed and holy water from him will be lucky and

get what you want.

Noon Lunch at the restaurant.



Afternoon Take you to [Phanom Sawai Forest Park](#). It is mountains on the plain of Surin province. There are Phanom Phon, Phanom Phrao, and Phanom Sarai. All three mountains together became Phanom Sawai Mountain. It is a beautiful and peaceful small forest not far from Surin town. The visitors to Khao Phanom Sawai will worship nine sacred things respectable for their fortune. There are



Yai or Phra Phuttha Surinthamongkhon Buddha images, the ashes of Luang Phu Dul Atulo, the

black Buddha image, Luang Phu Suan, a replica of the Buddha's footprint, Kuan Im Shrine, Sacred Turtle, and the holy pool. On the top of Khao Chai enshrined "Phuttha Surinthamongkhon" Buddha image. It is a Buddha giving boons and the Buddha image of Surin.

Then take you to [Surin National Museum](#). Fine Arts



Department has received cooperation from local experts to help research and collect. The exhibits are divided into five themes: natural history, archaeology, urban history, ethnology, and the outstanding heritage of the province. There are exhibits about natural science in various fields.



History of archeology from prehistoric times to the Ayutthaya period History of the city from Ayutthaya to the present and outstanding heritage in elephant raising. Upstairs exhibits stories

about the ethnicity of Thai people of Khmer descent, Lao descent, Kui descent, Korat people who live in Surin, and outstanding heritage in handicrafts and folk performing arts.



After that, take you to enjoy the view at **Huay Saneng Reservoir**. It is a reservoir that collects water for agricultural, planting assistance, and it is also an important water source the provincial water supply production. The water in the basin came from Huai Saneng, which came from Phanom Dong Rak mountain, the



south of Surin. Moreover, this dam is also a recreation place for Surin people and tourists from near provinces. Most of the tourists will come to swim and



go for a walk at Rim dam, which is the ridge of Huay Saneng Reservoir. There be a wide ridge similar to a cape. Here is the location of the residence of Somdej Phra Srinagarindra Boromarajonani and many royal family members.

Evening **Dinner at the restaurant.** Then Take you to check-in at **Slive Hotel** or a hotel of the same level.

Day 2 Statue of Phraya Surin Phakdi Srinarong Chang Wang - Surin City Pillar Shrine -Buraparam Temple - Ban Tha Sawang Silk Weaving Village - Elephant Study Centre

Morning **Breakfast at hotel's dining room.** Then take you to the Statue of Phraya Surin Phakdi Srinarong Chang Wang. Phraya Surin Phakdi Si Narong Changwang is an important person of Surin people. He was the first governor and the founder of Surin. The people of Surin have great



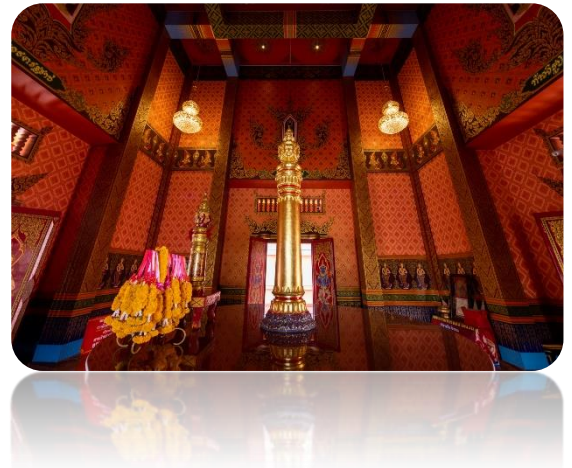
respect for him. It is a monument of the first governor of Surin flanked by large white ivory statues that indicates the relation between the people of Surin and the elephants for a long time.

It also shows his ability to control war elephants, and it is a sign shows that Surin has been an



ancient city of elephants. The statue with double swords on its back represents a warrior and courage, which are qualities of the Surin people. After that, take you to [Surin City Pillar Shrine](#). In the past, Surin City Pillar Shrine is a court that does not have a city pillar, but there has holiness and has been worshiped by Surin people for over 100 years.

Later, Surin province has renovated the City Pillar Shrine style by combining Khmer and Thai art. These made the City Pillar Shrine is beautiful. In the past, there was an amazing event that happened at the City Pillar Shrine, when it was a chasm on the road, then people dig down and find Naga Buddha images and ancient sacred objects such as pottery amulets and ancient bracelets, and prehistoric



pottery that is about 1,500 - 2,000 years old, so the villagers have brought them to worship at the City Pillar Shrine. Take you to [Buraparam Temple](#). It is the old temple in the city center,



which is the spiritual center of the Surin people. It is an important temple of Surin Province because it enshrined Luang Pho Phra Chee (Luang Por Prajee), the sacred Buddha image of Surin. It is the attitude of subduing Mara Buddha image. There is no evidence of when it was created but

assumed that it was built with Wat Burapharam and enshrined in the tetrahedron. It is a sacred object that the Surin people highly revere.

Noon Lunch at the restaurant.

Afternoon Take you to **Ban Tha Sawang Silk Weaving**

Village. It is the only silk handicraft tourism village in

Thailand. It is a village that people have skilled in weaving ancient silk that is unique to Surin.



They use the ancient technique of weaving the gilt cloth combined with exquisite patterns, so weaving each piece of cloth required a lot of weavers and took several months to weave. There is a uniquely detailed, beautiful pattern, and soft so that it was chosen to be a weaver of ancient gold silk to give to APEC leaders in 2003, and it became an important

handicraft attraction in Surin. The highlight of Ban Tha Sawang Silk is "Noi Silk", which is delicate and soft and very difficult to weave until it fades away. Hardly anyone knew that weavers of Ban Tha Sawang can weave Noi Silk until Her Majesty the Queen in the reign of King Rama IX had



a royal wish that "In the past, Thai silk was soft, smooth, very firm, how do you get that kind of fabric back?". Her vassals searched for it until they found Noi silk at Tha Sawang. They presented to the Queen, and she was satisfied, so she bestowed her money to build a weaving factory in the style of the ancient royal court at Ban Tha Sawang. When you



enter the village, you will find silk shops lined along the road. There are sarongs, shirts, bags, and pants. The starting price is thousands to tens of thousands. Then take you to [Elephant Study Centre](#) or Ban Ta Klang Elephant Village. It is a place where tourists can walk to see the way of life, the relationship of people and elephants, including their tradition and culture. The villagers in each household have their own elephants and live together. The elephants like a part of their family cause a stronger relation between people and elephants. Ban Ta Klang,



Surin Province is known as the largest elephant village in the world. people and elephants live in the same area. It's a very amazing way of life. No matter where we walk, we can see elephants almost everywhere. Each of these elephants are intelligent, cute, not fierce, and can easily get



along with people. Moreover, you will also see the livelihood of Suai people, and you can meet and talk to who elephant's doctor who has experience in giving birth to elephants many times. You can also visit the area at the Chi River and the Mun River flowing together which is only 3 kilometers away, there are

beautiful scenery to relax and can study in terms of nature.

Evening **Dinner at the restaurant.** Then take you to back to **Slive Hotel.**

Day 3 Kuncheing 5 Star Shop Branch 1 – Prasat Chiang Pi - Ban Buthom Basketry Village

Morning Breakfast at hotel's dining room. Pack your bags to check out from the hotel.

Then take you to [Kuncheing 5 Star Shop Branch 1](#). It is the first and oldest souvenir shop in Surin. It started when grandfather came to Surin to make Chinese sausage and opened a shop selling Chinese sausage products and processed meat in Surin. The name of Kow Kee Hiang is the name of Grandfather himself. But later, Khun Nuttthanakorn took over the shop and wanted the brand to be better known and easier to remember. Therefore, the new name was changed to Kuncheing 5-star and used this name until the present. All other products that the shop produces are named 5 stars. The products of the shop are



outstanding and unique

because the shop has a unique recipe, delicious taste, good quality, and fresh ingredients for consumers. In addition, the variety of products that are different from other Chinese sausage shops gives consumers more choices to buy as a souvenir or choose to eat by themselves. Many products



from the shop will invent patterns and formulas by themselves. It can be said that many of the products at the shop have only one place in Thailand, such as pork kae, the famous product that the shop is the manufacturer and came up with the name for the first time, seafood, pork cutlets, sushi rolls stuffed with seaweed, Chinese sausage mix between chicken and pork, golden pork noodles, pork with Chinese medicine then bake until the color is beautiful. After that, take you

to [Prasat Chiang Pi](#). It is a Khmer castle of the Arokya Sala type. Khmer art in Bayon style in the 18th century. It consists of the Pratan castle in the middle of the southeast. There is a Bannalai surrounded by the wall. Copura is on the east side, outside the wall. On the northeast side there is a pond. Pratan castle is made of laterite. The diagram is twelve wooden recess squares with a portico extended. On the east is the entrance, the door frame is made of sandstone. There is one-way entrance. The others 3 sides are fake doors. The glass wall was built with laterite



surrounding the castle. Bannalai has a Copura or arch at the entrance. In front of the Pratan castle. Between Copura and the Pratan castle is a walkway built of laterite. There is also an ongoing excavation of traces that comprise the Copura. There are many villagers from different countries who have heard the news and come to visit.

Including many immortal monks came to inquire and ask to see the excavated ancient artifacts. Then go to see the ancient artifacts preserved at the temple.

11.30 Lunch at the restaurant.

12.30 Take you to [Ban Buthom Basketry Village](#). The highlights of Ban Butom rattan products is all work is done by hand. Using the traditional pattern is the grille pattern, which is unique that makes the product beautiful and strong because the whole rattan tree is used, and suitable for use. It was traditional pattern developed into the

international market use a thin rattan (rat's tail rattan) that is tough and oily, which is easy to find in Surin.



14.30 Depart from Surin to Bangkok would take around 6 hours.

20.30 Arrive at Bangkok safely.
