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Day 1 Travel from Bangkok - Tak Province - Shrine of King Taksin the Great - Mani Banphot Worawihan Temple - Ban Chin Community

04.00 Depart from Bangkok to Tak Province It takes around 5 hours and 30 minutes to travel.

O9.30 Arrive at Tak take you on a journey
The Shrine of King Taksin the Great is located on
Jarodwithi Thong Road near the Tourism Authority
of Thailand. This shrine was originally located at
Wat Doi Khao Kaew, opposite the city. Later, in
1947, a new court was built by commissioning the



Fine Arts Department to design it. They built the shrine as a square pavilion with a large statue of King Taksin the Great. In his posture while sitting on the royal throne, he is slightly taller than the real King. In addition, the general public will pay homage to the image of King Taksin

the Great. Nearby are the Twelve Zodiac gardens, which



are shady for relaxation, and can also make merit with this twelve zodiac statue as well and continue to Wat Manibanphot Worawihan This temple is a monk's royal temple in the province Inside the temple, there is a Buddha image in a posture enshrined in front. There is also a Buddha image. Another interesting place is the Buddha image of Saen Thong, which is an ancient

Buddhist image in Chiang Saen, an ancient and inhabited city of Tak. Since ancient times, there has also been a Thai teak house inside which is enshrined. An ancient Buddha carved in the style of Burmese art from stone light. It contains Phra That Chedi, which is over a hundred years old. the Buddha's relics as well. For those who are tired from traveling, they can visit Thai massage while the temple is open for service to relieve fatigue.



Noon Lunch at the restaurant

Afternoon Take you to the alley of Ban Chin, located in Mueang Tak District, on Taksin Road, not far from the 200-year-old Rattanakosin Bridge. is Tak's trading center since In the early Rattanakosin period, because it was next to the Ping River, it was possible to unload. It was convenient to ship goods. Even during World War 2, the Chinese house alley was affected

by the bombing. It has been lonely since then.

Until more than 10 years ago, the villagers in the community cooperated. Restoration and repair of old houses have finally improved to become an important tourist attraction in Tak. There are many interesting places, such as a large wooden house with the Democrat Party sign at Dan Nai, a library, and the Blue House of the Sophanoton family, which was used to welcome guests in the past.

Day 2 Lan Sang Waterfall - Taksin Maharat National Park - Doi Muser Market and Muser Hill Market - Doi Luang Tak, Ranong Ngao (-/-/-)

by to swim or take in the view and lead you all to one another at Taksin Maharat National

Park is the origin of many important creeks, such as Huai Tapukhea, Huai Yau, Huai Samun

Luang, etc., which these creeks will flow together to form Huai Mae Lamao and eventually flow into the Mae Ping River. It is an interesting natural study site, with highlights such as the large Krabak tree with a diameter of over 16 meters and a height of 50 meters, which is considered the largest Krabak tree in Thailand.



Anyone who has a chance to visit, don't forget to stop by to take photos. The route may be a bit adventurous, but the view is worth it.
