Day 1: Bangkok Province – Bueng Kan Province – Sawang Arom Temple (Wat Tham Si Thon) - Wat Ahong Silawas - Kaeng Ah Hong

4 a.m. Depart from Bangkok to Bueng Kan Province Using a journey time of about 10 hours 40 minutes to eat. Your first meal has arrived. On the way, we will have snacks for you on the bus.

At noon Have lunch at a restaurant.



In the afternoon You will arrive at Bueng Kan Province and take you to Wat Sawang Arom Wat Tham Si Thon (Wat Tham Si Thon) is a temple with beautiful scenery, full of large and small stones and quiet, with a church on a large rock. The cave below is where the Buddha image is enshrined. reclining nirvana,

the room at the top of the pagoda will represent the

Daowadung heaven with a Buddha image instead of the Lord Buddha enshrined among the angels in the heaven's top atmosphere. The wind blows all the time, very cool. The view that looks out to the end across the Mekong to the country for our home Another important

highlight of Wat Tham Si Thon is the bell tower made of thousands of jars that are strung together into amazing structures with different sizes of dragon jars, merging with the creator's ideas, creating a unique work that is worth watching.

Take you to Wat Ahong Silawas Located in Ban Ahong area, Mueang Bueng Kan District, Bueng



Kan Province, approximately 21 kilometers from the district center, located on the banks of the Mekong River. Kaeng Ahong area is a large basin from From the Thai side to the Lao side, which is about a hundred meters long, Wat Ahong Silawas is one of the major tourist attractions in Bueng Kan Province. Due to the beautiful scenery, the area adjacent to the



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
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Mekong River is a line. The long arc is accompanied by a continuous story. Come about the belief in the Naga, making tourists popular to visit Wat A Hong and Kaeng Ah Hong uninterruptedly. It is believed that the front of the temple is the deepest point of the Mekong River with a depth of 200 meters. In this area, the water will flow turbulently until it forms a cone-shaped hole if there are wood

chips, leaves, or small objects. Stuck will be swirled into a cone for about 20-30 minutes. Then slip away and move to another place, when there was a strong current again will form a new cone, alternating throughout the day. Therefore, it is believed that this is the point of the navel of the Mekong River from March to May of every year, one can see Kaeng Ah Hong. The rocky rapids in the middle of the Mekong River appear above the water. The rock group is named after the nature of the rocks, such as Hin Tong, Naga, Hin Pla Khe, and Pla Sawai

Cave. In addition to being a resting place and a tourist attraction, the surrounding villagers also live in fishing. Take you to see the view at **Kaeng Ah Hong**, the rocky rapids in the middle of the Mekong River. In front of Ahong Temple Silavas at Baan Ah Hong, Hor Kham Sub-district is considered the point where the Mekong River is the deepest. The water flows around Kaeng Ah Hong in the rainy season and has a whirlpool in the form of water. A large cone, which locals believe to be the "Mekong navel". The Mekong River at



Kaeng Ahong is about 300 meters wide in the low season and 400 meters wide in the flooding season.

8 p.m. Have dinner at the restaurant

Day 2: Photharam Temple - Living Community Museum - Sam Wan Hin Phu Sing - Phu Thok - Tham Phra Waterfall (-/-/-)

In themorning Have breakfast at the hotel restaurant. Take you out to Wat

Photharam, a temple with sacred Buddha images in the city. which is the center of the mind of the people of Bueng Kan Province and the people of nearby provinces. Including in Lao PDR in the Mekong River Basin. When entering the temple, you will find the ubosot, when



looking inside, you will see the Big Buddha enshrined inside the ubosot. Big Buddha It is a Buddha image in the form of Mara, plastered with a lap width of 2 cubits 1 creep (5 feet 4 inches). Originally, it was a beautiful bronze Buddha image. But the plaster was plastered on it, which is assumed to be a camouflage from the events of the war. The Buddha image

seen in the present enshrined at the same place since its discovery has not been moved at all. There was only the restoration of the plinth to make it more durable. Most of the people who come to ask for blessings tend to get their wishes to come true. Until someone brings gold to paint the Buddha image as beautiful as you see and often light fireballs to offer to each other regularly but worshiping in the ubosot Only males can enter. As for women, they can pay their respects



in front of the ubosot or a replica that is enshrined next to the Ubosot Wat Photharam has a shady atmosphere. The doctrine of following a tree is to be read as a cautionary tale. And the temple area is next to the Mekong River, there is no temple wall between the temple and the Mekong River. Therefore, people who come to the temple can walk and see and also get a cool breeze blowing up from the Mekong River, making their minds more peaceful. Take you to **Street Art Tourist Village and Living Community Museum.** It is located in the village of Cassia Yai So Phisai District, Bueng Kan Province It is a quiet village surrounded

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by nature still retains its traditional culture and way of life. Both the unique dress by wearing a sarong, carrying a kratip, offering alms to monks with sticky rice for building a street art village is opened to the whole village by combining traditional culture with modern art, the initiator is Khun Khab, a famous food stylist. World stage award winner and also a volunteer of the Royal



Project Foundation for more than 14 years. That intends to return home to develop the community as a sustainable tourist destination using private capital. It gets the cooperation of people in the community as well as support



from the government. It private sectors to build street art villages, paintings, and paintings in the colors of the serpent. The Living Community Museum to open a cultural display area to convey the local way of life for the new generation to visit in a more accessible way.

At noon Have lunch at a restaurant.



In the afternoon Take you to Hin Sam
Wan Phu Sing, it is said that it is over 75
million years old. It looks like 3 huge stones
arranged in a row. Looking at it from a distance
or aerial photographs, it is shaped like a whale.
Parents and children are swimming like Have
fun, so it is called "Hin Sam Whale". It is a
beautiful viewpoint that stands out on the east

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side of Phu Sing. It is a point to watch the sunrise in the morning. You can stand and watch the scenery of Phu Wua Forest, Huai Bang Bat, Kaeng Sadok, the Mekong River beach, and Mt. Muang Pak Klang, Lao People's Democratic Republic, where we can walk up and stand on whale rocks. But must be



careful. Take you to **Phu Thok**, the location of Wat Jetiya Si Wihan (Wat Phu Thok) located in the territory of Ban Kham Khaen, Na Sabang Subdistrict, Bueng Kan Province, with Phra

Ajarn Juan Kulchetto as the founder. In the Isan language, it means A lonely mountain, Phu Thok has 2 children, Phu Thok Yai and Phu Thok Noi. Part of the pilgrims and General tourists can visit is Phu Thok Noi. As for Phu Thok Yai, far away, it hasn't opened yet tourists watch. This is the starting point for walking up to the top of Phu Thok. The highlight of Phu Thok is the wooden bridge and stairs to see the scenery around Phu Thok. Only laborers build the stairs, circling the



Phu Thok in 360 styles, which has a total of 7 floors. It took 5 full years to build. From the 1st to the 7th floor, there will be a wooden staircase for you to walk in style. Straight



stretches to the highest point of Phu Thok, and from the 3rd floor onwards, tourists can walk through a circular bridge around the mountain, which will see different perspectives all the time. Stairs leading up to This peak of Phu Thok is like a dharma path that leads the faithful from the world of mundane. The world of Lokutra or the world of liberation with perseverance and determination. Phu Thok is

closed for tourists from 10-16 April of every year. And take you on a trip to visit **Tham Phra Waterfall**. There is a monastery near the waterfall quiet and shady on the back stone courtyard, there is a wide valley in the shape of a pan basin, where you can swim. Tham Phra



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Waterfall has 3 levels. Big popular to swim in the 2nd-floor area because there will be a wide field, many types of wildflowers blooming in beautiful bouquets.



In the afternoon Have dinner at the restaurant and take you back. The One Hotel invite you to relax at your leisure.

Day 3: Souvenir shop, Bueng Kan 32, Pradong - Bangkok
