Day 1 Bangkok – Trat– Trat City Pillar Shrine – Yothanimit Temple – Monrak Ban Na – Black Sand Beach

05.00 Depart from Bangkok to Trat would take around 4-5 hours.

10.00 Arrive at [Trat](#). Then take you to [Trat City Pillar Shrine](#). It is located on Lak Muang



Road near Wat Yothanimit. The difference between this shrine and other City Pillar Shrines is the building is constructed in the style of a Chinese

canopy. The City Pillar Shrine of Trat is important to the people of Trat. It is the center of the minds of both Thais and Chinese people who have lived in the province for a



long time. After that,

take you to [Yothanimit Temple](#). It is a temple that has a very beautiful Ubosot that is famous and used to be a place of holding water until the reign of King Rama III.

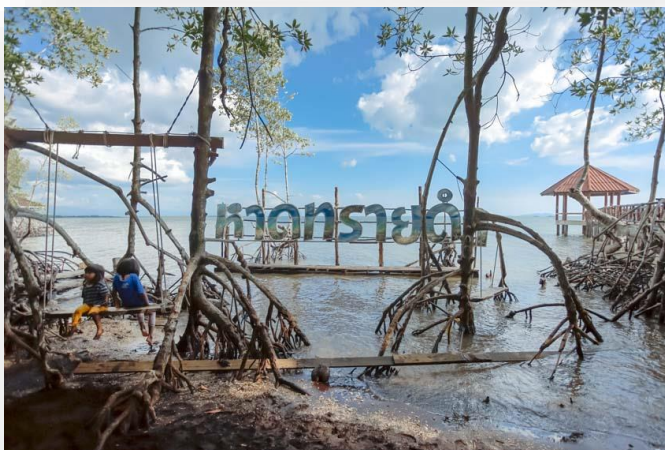
Inside the old ubosot, mural paintings are telling the



story of the Vessantara Jataka and various antiquities, such as the Buddha's footprint, water-laid cabinets, etc. Although this vihara has been restored, it still maintains its original shape.

Noon Lunch at the restaurant.

Afternoon Take you to Thai café [Monrak Ban Na](#). This restaurant is located in the middle of a rice field. It focuses on drinks, desserts, and Thai food. The design and serving design are very appetizing. Recommended drink menus are iced green tea, iced Thai tea, lemon tea, strawberry fresh milk, orange juice, iced cocoa. Recommended cakes are coconut cakes, pandan cakes, green tea cakes. La carte menus are salad decorated with beautiful flowers, Yum Khanom Jeen set with fried mackerel fish, and Khanom Jeen served in a cute Krathong.



Then take you to [Black Sand Beach](#).

The black sand beach is intermingled with the trees of the mangrove forest

and many animals, whether big or small, birds, macaques, and shellfish make this area. There is an abundance and biodiversity. The beach will look like a sandbar stretching for about 1 kilometer along the line filled with fine black sand. It is a miracle that occurs naturally. And found only 5 places around the world: Taiwan, Malaysia, Hawaii, northern California, and Thailand in Trat Province. The sandy beach here is not very big but tourists can walk down to touch the sand, or you can walk on the sandbar to feel the fine grains of sand as well.



Then take you to relax, take a walk, take photos and watch the sunset at [Satire Poor Reservoir](#)

(Rakam Mountain lower part).



Evening **Dinner at the restaurant.**

19.00 Take you to check-in at Toscana Trad Hotel or a hotel of the same level for leisure time.

Day 2 Pai Lom Temple – Trat Museum Trat Province- Buppharam Temple - Na Trat souvenir shop - Bangkok

Morning **Breakfast at hotel's dining room.** Pack your bags to check out from the hotel.

Then take you to [Pai Lom Temple](#). It was built in the year 1783 is an important temple in Trat



Province. There is a Chedi Sam Than Chao Khun which is a two-storey inverted octagonal bell-shaped chedi covered with beautiful mosaics from Italy. The chedi containing the Buddha's relics is located within the

Buddhadhamma Park. It is a sacred place where locals and tourists come to pay their respects.

It is also open to the general public to use as a place of dharma practice. After that, [take you to](#)

[Trat Museum Trat Province](#). It is located at Santisuk Road, Mueang District, Trat Province.

This city museum uses the former city hall building as a museum as learning center for the

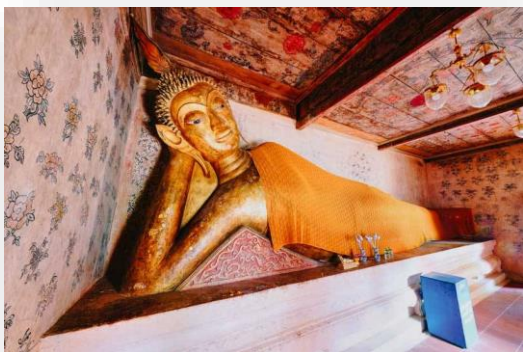
history, culture, lifestyle of Trat, and being a center for learning, promoting, disseminating the nation's cultural heritage, and being a cultural attraction. The National Museum of Trat is organized as a learning center for history, Trat culture, and way of life. It is a city museum using the original city hall building built in the reign of King Rama VI. Lakshadha is a



colonial architecture building built as a wooden house with cement pillars raised under a hip roof. In 2004 the building was burned down, Trat municipality allocated a budget for the Fine Arts Department to renovate the building according to the original style and make it a museum.

Noon **Lunch at the restaurant.**

Afternoon Take you to **Buppharam Temple** or Wat Plai Khlong. It is the oldest temple in



Trat province because it was built since the Ayutthaya period by Phra Kru Khun Saraphisut (Luang Por Ho), the former abbot. During the reign of King Rama V, initiated various renovations, including paintings, and Thai-style small townhouses. Now, the Museum of Wat Buppharam

has been established. This temple has become the center of Buddhists. Then take you to buy souvenirs at [Na Trat souvenir shop](#).



14.00 Depart from Trat to Bangkok would take around 4-5 hours.

18.30 Arrive at Bangkok safely.
