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Day 1 Travel from Suvarnabhumi Airport (Bangkok) – Hat Yai – Betong (Yala Province) – Halabala Bridge – Betong Mongkolrit Tunnel – Post Box

07.00 Depart from Suvarnabhumi Airport (Bangkok) to Hat Yai International Airport. By Thai AirAsia, flight VZ 320 around 1 hour and 30 minutes to fly.

08.30 Arrive in Hat Yai, then take you to Yala Province (Betong), which is around 4 hours and 30 minutes.

Noon Lunch at the restaurant

Afternoon Arrive in Yala then take you to Betong, a large district in Yala. It is the southernmost district of Thailand. with the appearance of a spearhead extending into Malaysia. It is located in the Sankara Khiri Mountain Range. It has an area of approximately 1,328 square kilometers. It is about 140 kilometers from Yala town and about 1,220 kilometers from Bangkok. The terrain of the Betong District is mostly high mountains, so Betong has good weather. and fog all year round. As for the district's motto, "City in the Mist, Beautiful Flowers, Southernmost Siam, Beautiful Border Town," then let us take you on a

journey. Hala Bala Bridge. This bridge is the main thoroughfare to Betong and is also a very popular viewpoint. It is recommended to stand in the middle of the bridge to see a large water inlet as far as the eye can see. Both sides are embraced by the lush greenery of the evergreen forest that is still rich in abundance. Before entering Betong city, we stopped to stop and take a few photos. You will definitely get beautiful pictures with a beautiful atmosphere.





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


Then takes you on a journey Betong Mongkhonrit Tunnel is the first mountain car tunnel in Thailand located in Betong District, Yala Province. It was built to facilitate commuters. It is constructed of reinforced concrete, 9 meters wide, 7 meters high, and has a length of approximately 273 meters throughout the tunnel that was officially opened on January 1, 2001. Highlights of the Betong Mongkhonrit Tunnel are all day. There will be cars driving through and out. And inside the tunnel, there is a walkway that you can walk around as well.



At certain times, the tunnel will be lit up. This makes it a beautiful highlight of Yala that you have to check in to and take photos of. which in the evening You can see that many tourists come to take photos in front of this tunnel. For anyone who is already visiting Betong, they were able to walk through this tunnel to the clock tower and a large post box. Then take you for a walk to see the postbox, the former location of the

southernmost postbox in Thailand and also the largest. Built-in 1924 before the Second World War, 2.9 meters high, the purpose of its building in the first place was to be used as a broadcasting station for people in Betong to hear from the radio embedded in the upper part of the cupboard. But now a new postbox has been built, larger than before. with a height of about



9 meters, located at the community hall for tourists to take beautiful photos.

Day 2 Ayer Weng Sea of Clouds – Betong Hot Spring – Tae Pu Su Bridge – Suan Muen Buppa – Piyamit Tunnels – Stadium in the middle of the valley – Betong Walking Street (-/-/-)



Morning Have breakfast at the hotel restaurant. After the meal, take you on a journey to see. Ayer Weng, Sea of Clouds Located in Ayer Weng Sub-district, Betong District, Yala is a popular sea mist viewpoint in Betong that is easy to reach by car. And there is a sea of mist to watch all year round. Ayer Weng Sea of Clouds It is located about 40 kilometers from Betong District in the area of Khao Microwave. With a height of 2,038 meters above sea level, it is a



large and beautiful sea of mist. In the morning, this viewpoint becomes a paradise on earth, open to tourists to enjoy the sea of clouds. There is fresh air and a beautiful view of Microwave Peak. Ayer Weng Sea Mist Viewpoint. Able to travel on a day trip, there are 2 viewing points, which are the 1st viewpoint and the 2nd viewpoint, which are located next to the food selling point. But during the holidays, on Saturday and Sunday, there will be many tourists coming to see the sea of mist.

Tourists are quite crowded at Viewpoint 1, which is the highest viewpoint. Most of the time, before sunrise, they head here first. which has a relatively narrow space and is limited For coming up to see the sea of fog, viewpoint 1 cannot bring a car up. Must park the car at the

parking area and walk up about 500 meters. As for the viewpoint at the second point, the car can go up to park at the viewpoint because right here is the food shop area. The viewpoint is a terraced terrace offering 5 views. Each point has a sign and a beautiful angle for taking pictures, and you can see the sea of mist up close at eye level. They then take you on a journey to Betong Hot Spring Located in the village



of Chara Prai Ta No Mae Ro Subdistrict, Yala is a large natural hot spring. It has an area of approximately 3 rai, with hot water springing up from the underground. It contains many



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minerals. The temperature of the water is about 80 degrees Celsius at the point where this water boils, able to boil eggs until cooked within 10 minutes. Yala province has improved the landscape surrounding the hot springs. to be beautiful but still natural to make it suitable for recreation and promote health tourism. Inside Betong Hot Spring There is also a large pool. for retaining water from hot springs for the people and tourists used to bathe or play with feet which each zone is designed to meet hygienic standards, including large hot springs, a new hot spring bath, and the hydrotherapy building. It is believed that this mineral water is able to alleviate various diseases as well, such as aches and pains, beriberi, skin diseases, etc., as well as a building for overnight stays with complete comfort and convenience. It is open to visitors every day from 9:00. - 5:00





Then take you to Tae Pu Su Bridge, a wooden suspension bridge located between the fire department. Subdistrict Administrative Organization Ayer Weng with the headman's office, Village No. 2, Ban Km. 32, Ayer Weng Subdistrict, Betong District, Yala Province, with a



width of 1.8 meters, a length of more than 100 meters across the Pattani River. In the past, Ayer Weng sub-district headman, Mr. Museng Taepu Su, father of Mr. Montien Taepu Su, Ayer Weng sub-district headman (ret. 2017), father of Mr. Akradet Taepu Su, village headman KM.32, the current person), to help mobilize energy and contributions from the villagers together with the



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government. That is not enough because you have to order a sling For attaching bridges from Japan, which at that time was a very big deal, can help ease the hardships of the villagers on the other side of the river. which at that time had to use bamboo rafts to cross - make villagers, especially children have to die every year When moving agricultural products or sick people, it is very difficult. Construction of



the Taepusu Bridge by working together, Therefore, is like a symbol of the struggle of KM 32 people to defeat nature and the love and unity of the people in the community. Because of the bridge, It is located near the sea of mist, Aiyer Weng, and Rama IX Waterfall, as well as on Highway 410, so tourists often take pictures. to commemorate until popular It is a new landmark that should not be missed when visiting Ayer Weng Sub-district, Betong District, Yala Province. It is not surprising that the place has been ranked among the most popular attractions in Ayer Weng Subdistrict in the past 3 years (2016- 2018)

Afternoon Take you to Suan Muen Buppa, also known as the "Betong Cold Flower



Garden", located in Piyamit 2 Village, Tanomaer Subdistrict, Betong District, Yala, the only winter flower garden in the south. Because Betong has the right weather conditions. The terrain is at an altitude of about 800 meters above sea level, so the weather is cool all year round. enough water system, Therefore, it is suitable for planting various types of winter flowers. This flower



garden is among the mountains. in projects under the Royal Initiative of Her Royal Highness

Princess Maha Chakri Sirindhorn Her Royal Highness Princess Maha Chakri Sirindhorn with

a variety of flowers in full bloom to invite visitors. The beauty of flowers planted lined up in rows attracts tourists. and experience a climate with lower temperatures than other areas of the South before entering the area of the flower garden. You will find a greenhouse planted with many beautiful chrysanthemum flowers, including yellow, purple, white, and pink. Then enter the flower garden. It is



divided into outdoor flowerbeds, such as gladiolus, amaranth, marigold, salvia, rakhi, tuberose, hollyhock, butterfly, peacock, gold necklace, Chinese asters, guava splinter, etc. It has a Dutch wind windshield. The bridge in the garden and the name of the flower garden $\vec{\eta} \not \vec{p}$ stand on top. Opposite the outdoor flower garden is the flower garden in the greenhouse. colorful flowers such as lilies, asters, chrysanthemums, roses, peacocks, gerbera, gladiolus, angel earrings, and many more species. But lilies can be seen only during the winter and during the Betong Flower Festival, which is in January, the garden of ten thousand blossoms.



It is another tourist attraction that allows you to experience the atmosphere of the city of flowers, along with the cool weather of Betong then take you on a journey. The Piyamit Tunnel, located at Baan Piyamit 1, Tanomaro Sub-district, Betong District, Yala Province, is an earthen tunnel built by the former Malayan Communist Theft Movement (JCC) as a base for political action. but later came back to develop the Thai nation. The Piyamit Tunnels, built-in 1976, were used to

dodge air raids and collect supplies. At present, it is open as a tourist attraction for tourists who are interested in learning about the history of the past. At the entrance, there is a large



statue of Guan Yin for worshiping and praying. Walking further, you will see an arch with a nameplate. full of the flavors of Chinese culture and ready to welcome tourists at all times.

Visiting the Piyamit Tunnels has to be a walk in It takes about half an hour to reach the tunnel. By creating a walking path with stairs along the path, under the shade of plants that shelter the sun as well. Walking might be tiring. Along the way, there will be various stops. There are several entrances to the tunnel called Tunnel 1, 2, 3, 4, 5 6, with a total of 6



exits spread out at different points. You can choose to visit any tunnel and exit at any point but it is recommended to go out at the exit of Tunnel 1, which is the closest path for walking to see the thousand-year-old trees. This tunnel was built in 1976. The construction took 40-50 people to dig into the mountains. And it took only 3 months to complete. The tunnel is 50-60 feet wide, about 1 kilometer long, can hold almost 200 people, and has 9 entrances and exits, all connected. Currently, there are 6 channels left. Inside, there is a radio station for CM, a bedroom, and a storage room. There are nooks and corners to turn around. Above is a forest covered with many large trees. It was difficult to find and was discovered by government soldiers. There are electrical installations throughout the tunnel. The air inside is cool but not uncomfortable. Throughout the tunnels, traces of life can still be seen, such as bedrooms with earthen beds. On the wall, they built combat equipment and tools for trekking, including the battle command room, which can hold up to 200 people outside the tunnel, which used to be a field for troops' training. But now there are exhibitions and museums of history. for educating tourists There is also a sacred shrine located near the museum. Walk until the end of the path takes about 15 minutes to find a thousand-year banyan tree. which is another highlight of the Piyamit Tunnel tour that takes you on a journey through another highlight of the Piyamit Tunnel. Betong Mountain Stadium: Located in the city area of Betong Municipality, Sukyang






atmosphere and is the stadium located at the highest altitude in Thailand. They are also ready to support national sports competitions. Every morning, the atmosphere is cold. Some days you will see a faint fog during the evening hours. Before dusk, the weather will be cold as well. Here, it will be popular for people to go for a walk. Riding bikes, children run around the edge of the

field. Together, we kick the ball together in the field, as well as take the family to sit and relax a lot In addition to being a public place, it also makes Betong people popular for exercising every day. And most importantly, when on the edge of the field, you will see a very beautiful view of Betong City. The atmosphere at dusk is made more beautiful by seeing the lights all over the city.

19.00 It's time to take you back to rest at Garden View Betong Hotel.

Day 3 Betong - Wat Chang Hai - Hat Yai - Bangkok

Morning Have breakfast at the hotel restaurant. After the meal, you collect your luggage for **check out** from the hotel. After that, you will depart from Betong, Yala to travel to Wat Chang Hai, which takes about 3 hours.

11:00 Take you to Wat Chang Hai, located at Ban Pa Rai, Thung Phla Sub-district, along the Hat Yai-Su-Ngai Kolok Railway. Between Na Pradu Station and Pa Rai Station, 31 kilometers from the city, is an old temple built more than 300 years ago. Inside the viharn there is a statue of Luang Pu Thuat, whose real body is enshrined. There is also the architecture of the stupa, chedi, mondop, chapel, and bell tower that is extremely beautiful. Through the Na Ket Intersection Go straight along Highway No. 409, Pattani-Yala Line. through the community of Na Pradu Municipality and Vocational Training Center (Wat Chang Hai), to the junction. To enter Wat Chang Hai for another 700 meters, Luang Pu Thuat stepped on freshwater, Chang Hai Temple was a person who had the ability to study the teachings of

the Buddha Dharma and had a high degree of compassion. It is said that when he traveled to Ayutthaya by boat, junk, On the way, a storm until food and waterfall into the sea. The crew was very thirsty. Luang Pu Tuad then showed mercy and dropped his feet into the sea. It appears that the water in the area has become fresh and drinkable. Since





then, his name has been known. Later, Luang Pu Tuad passed away in Malaysia. and brought the body back to Wat Chang Hai. And there is an event to bathe the ashes of Luang Pu Thuat every year on the first day of the waning moon of the 5th lunar month.

Noon Lunch at the restaurant

AfternoonThen travel to take you out from Wat Chang Hai. to board the plane at Hat YaiInternational Airport It takes around 1 hour and 30 minutes.

16.00 Arrive at Hat Yai International Airport then take you on the plane Return toSuvarnabhumi Airport (Bangkok) by Air Asia, flight FD 3109 takes approximately 1 hour and30 minutes.

17.30 Arrive at Suvarnabhumi Airport (Bangkok) safely...
