EXTRA TOPICS

VISUAL SUPPORTS (2 HRS)

Learn how to use pictures or visual tools to help children with developmental delays. We'll cover different types and how they help.

AUGMENTATIVE COMMUNICATION SYSTEMS (3 HRS)

Learn about tools that help learners communicate when they can't speak easily, like picture boards or speech devices. We'll explain what it is, how these tools work, and why they're useful.

ACCOMMODATION AND MODIFICATION (3 HRS)

This session discusses changes made in classrooms or at home to help children with developmental disabilities succeed. It also covers how to make these adjustments easier.

FLEXIBILITY AND UNEXPECTED SITUATIONS (3 HRS)

This session explains how to help children with developmental disabilities handle changes in their routine and unexpected situations without getting upset.

TOKEN SYSTEMS (2 HOURS)

Learn how to use a reward system where kids earn tokens or points for good behavior. We'll explain how it works and where it can be used.

Training Topic Information



Our in-house supervisors, all certified by the CARD Institute, conduct training services for school staff. Currently, we provide training for teachers and teaching assistants at private schools, as well as deliver lectures at universities and medical institutions.

SCHOOL SETTING

PURPOSE OF SCHOOL SHADOW (2-3 HRS)

This session covers what a school shadow is, why it helps a child, and how the shadow supports the child to do well in school. It also explains how the shadow's role gradually decreases over time.

USING REWARDS IN THE CLASSROOM (2-3 HRS)

Learn how to use rewards effectively in the classroom to increase good behavior.

TEACHING SKILLS



5. THEORY OF MIND (3 HRS)

Theory of mind means understanding that other people have thoughts and beliefs different from yours. This training will explain how to teach children to share perspectives and use behavioral methods to build this skill.



6. PLAY SKILLS (3 HRS)

This session focuses on the different types of play and how they develop in children. It will show how to teach play skills to children with developmental delays using behavior-based methods.



7. SOCIAL SKILLS (3 HRS)

This session explains what social skills are and how they develop. It will cover ways to teach social skills to both children and adults with developmental delays.



8. ATTENTION AND FOCUS (3 HRS)

This training will talk about different types of attention and common attention problems in children with developmental delays. It also teaches methods to help children improve focus.



9. ADAPTIVE SKILLS (3 HRS)

This session outlines various everyday skills children need to learn and how to teach these skills to children with developmental delays.



10. COGNITIVE SKILLS (3 HRS)

This training will explain what cognition is, the thinking problems common in children with developmental delays, and how to teach them using behavioral methods.

CORE TRAINING TOPICS

1. BEHAVIOR MANAGEMENT (3/6/12 HRS)

Learn how to manage problem behaviors at school, home, or in the community. We'll talk about why these behaviors happen and how to teach better behaviors.

2. USING BEHAVIOR PRINCIPLES FOR DEVELOPMENTAL DELAYS (2-3 HRS):

Learn about ABA (Applied Behavior Analysis) and how it helps people with autism and developmental delays. We'll also look at research on how effective it is.

3. UNDERSTANDING WHY BEHAVIORS HAPPEN (2 HRS)

Learn to figure out why certain behaviors happen and how to choose the best way to manage them.

4. CREATING A POSITIVE LEARNING SPACE (2 HRS)

Learn how to set up an inviting and enriching space that helps children with developmental delays learn and build social skills.
