6. Assignments

There will be 3 activities: 2 individuals & 1 group presentation project. The details of each activity will be described below:

1. Message & audience (30%)

Students will be assigned to present a topic to different groups of audience, choose the right message or statement, and the communication method to communicate with audience effectively.

2. Impromptu speech (20%)

Students will select a topic and prepare to give a short speech in front of the class. This assignment is an individual assignment. The students will have 2 minutes to prepare for the speech after they know what topic they get and 2 minutes to give a speech.

3. What will you be doing after you graduate? (20%)

Students are required to deliver a 2-minute individual presentation on where they see themselves after they graduate. In the presentation, they are expected to describe their life/career plans and how they will achieve them.

4. Mock Presentation (5%)

Students will be divided into three groups to deliver mock presentations under the topics similar to the three activities they will be tested in the following weeks.

5. Visual aids assignment (10%)

To be announced by guest lecturer.

No reading while presenting. The student who reads while presenting will get **ZERO mark for that activity.**
