



IV Fluid

Equipment			
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Procedure	
0	Preparation of tools, sterile gauze gauze, tweezers, rubber bands, gloves, scalp vein needles, size 18-21G. (Do not use needles smaller than 21 and should not use a needle larger than 20G Disinfectant solution bottle with saline hose)
1	Want to replace the water because they can't eat.
2	Requires a large amount of fluid in the event of severe blood loss
3	Blood collectors wash their hands thoroughly. Connect the saline hose to the aqueous bottle and allow the fluid to flow until the saline hose is full. to expel all the air
4	Choose obvious black lines. (Most popularly, puncture the cubital vein or vein on the back of the hand)
5	The piercer wears gloves on both sides (for the purpose of preventing contact with the patient's blood only). not intended for sterilization)
6	Secure the area above where the blood was drawn with a rubber band around the arm. to see the veins more clearly
7	Apply 70% ethyl alcohol to the puncture site from the innermost to the outer periphery twice. Wait 30-60 seconds or until the ethyl alcohol evaporates completely.
