



Nuchal Cord

Procedure

0	Place your fingers around the baby's neck to check for the presence of an umbilical cord around the neck. Be careful not to forcefully press or pull the umbilical cord.
1	Estimate the number of turns around the baby's neck 2.
2	Assess the firmness of the wrap around the baby's neck. By trying to insert your hand under the umbilical cord.
3	Use two long arterial forcep or kocher clamps to clamp the umbilical cord approximately 3 cm apart.
4	Place your hand under the navel to be careful of injury to the baby and then cut it off.
5	Loosen the umbilical cord from the baby's neck and perform anterior shoulder delivery immediately
6	Record the information on the umbilical cord wrapped around the neck in the birth certificate. For the follow-up of postpartum roots, especially Hypovolemic Shock/hypoxia.
