Procedure

0	treating patients Introduce yourself to the patient Ask for the patient's name, tell them how to treat, and ask permission for treatment. Communicate with patients periodically Treat patients politely and gently.
1	Helping the patient to get up from the sleeping position Have the patient sit on a bed or chair with no walls to lean against.
2	Align the patient's chest posture to the front, 2 hands on the waist Help support the patient's right arm or Teach the patient to use his left hand to hold his right hand on the waist.
3	Choose the right clavicular splint size.
4	Unwrap both sides of the splint. Place a triangular backplate. The back of the patient faces the flat side against the skin. There is a loop on the outside.
5	Pass the spongy strap through the front of the bone. the collarbone and passes under the armpit
6	Insert the strap into the loop on both sides to balance the length. pull tight and attach the gecko's feet together
7	Complications and duration of treatment pressure sores, numbness, swelling of the arms
