



# History taking on Alteration of conscious in elderly

## Equipment

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## Procedure

0	Greeting patients and introducing themselves and ask permission to ask about history
1	Symptoms come on suddenly or slowly and gradually. How many hours and days have you had a fever or fever before?
2	Have you had a headache or vomiting before? have limb weakness previous accident history
3	Environment found next to you, such as pill bottles, toxins, vomit marks, bedwetting previously complaining of burning urine
4	Are there any washing symptoms? or have a history of epilepsy Daily life history such as eating, walking, excretion, vision, hearing
5	Congenital diseases, diabetes, high blood pressure, liver disease, kidney disease, blood disease, hypothyroidism, paralysis
6	Drinking alcohol or other drugs, the amount used or stopped for how many days
7	What medications do you take on a regular basis, such as steroids antidepressants, AEDs, psychiatric drugs, sleeping pills, diabetes medications?
8	Before being a patient who lacked regular medication or not? Before becoming a patient, did you take any medications other than the ones you take on a regular basis?
9	Before being absorbed, did the patient have severe vomiting or diarrhea? History of drug allergy? preliminary with reason
