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Procedure			
0	greeting the patient and introducing himself Permission to ask about history		
1	Swelling of the whole body or localized swelling Swelling, pressing the dent?		
2	Swelling only with hot pain, redness, fever or not, when is it very swollen when morning, evening and night?		
3	Swollen eyelids? Big belly or not?		
4	Are you pregnant? Need to take a history, headache, blurred vision, tight tongue		
5	Feeling breathless, unable to lie down, get up and pant at night		
6	Low urine output, paleness, nausea and vomiting, history of kidney disease, jaundice, yellow eyes, hepatitis, heavy drinking		
7	Cold, swollen, frequent sleepy, accident history, local swelling, or insect bites		
8	If one leg is swollen, watch out for DVT, swollen inguinal lymph nodes.		
9	Congenital diseases, drugs that are used regularly, such as ACEI, NSAIDS, steroids, pills, history of drug allergy		
10	Providing a preliminary diagnosis with reasons
