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Procedure			
0	greeting relatives, introducing yourself, asking permission to ask about history		
1	How long have the symptoms appeared suddenly? or slowly		
2	Signs of limb weakness, drooping face, slurred speech, headache, surge of vomiting, convulsive seizures or history of epilepsy		
3	Environments found next to him, such as medicine bottles, toxins next to the patient, vomit marks, urinating and defecation.		
4	History of daily life such as eating, walking, excretion, vision		
5	Accident history Now you have a fever or fever before, nausea, vomiting, diarrhea, severe liquid diarrhea before. Weight loss, fatigue, loss of appetite, stress, anxiety, insomnia, psychiatric disorders		
6	congenital diseases, diabetes, high blood pressure Hyperlipidemia, liver disease, kidney disease, blood disease, thyroid disease, paralysis Heart disease, cancer, family disease, cancer		
7	What medications do you take regularly or other non-essential drugs such as steroids, antidepressants, AEDs, psychiatric drugs, sleeping pills, diabetes pills		
8	bottles of pills that you take regularly? Who gave the pills to eat? Is it okay to eat according to the doctor's orders? Ask to see all of the patient's medications.		
9	Do not drink alcohol, smoke, use other drugs, history of drug allergy, preliminary diagnosis		

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
