



Guidelines for primary care of a patient with a needle thrust into the left index finger

Equipment			
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Procedure			
0	Introduce yourself (name and surname), ask for first and last name. Inform the purpose of giving advice and advice Open the door to ask questions, listen, use words that are easy to understand, do not interfere, do not use medical terminology.		
1	Take a history of the day, month, year, time of the accident, place of the accident. (Do what, how) Do you wear protective gear? (gloves, robes, goggles)		
2	Actions after being stabbed with a needle (washing, wiping alcohol/providine, squeezing out blood)		
3	Congenital diseases, medications used regularly, marital status, risk behaviors (used to receive blood, intravenous injection, number of sexual partners)		
4	Tell the chance of getting infected with AIDS 0.3%, hepatitis 3%, hepatitis C virus 30%.		
5	Blood test on the day that the needle was stabbed, AIDS, hepatitis B, C, CBC, liver function		
6	Ask for permission to penetrate AntiHIV and sign a consent form. supervisor report		
7	Take 3 antiretroviral drugs for a period of 4 weeks, immediately or no later than 72 hours after being stabbed with a needle.
