The Masterclasses are available for free, and we encourage students to get involved along with trying our fantastic activity programme.

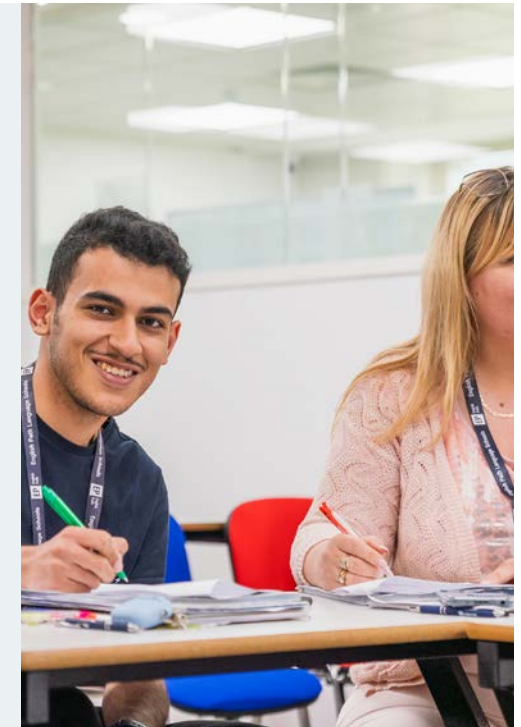


Study Clinics & Tutorials

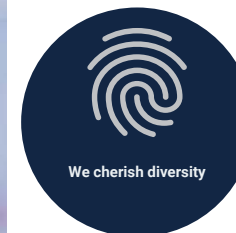
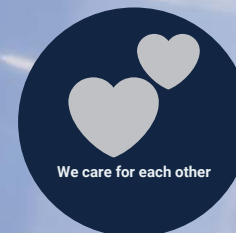

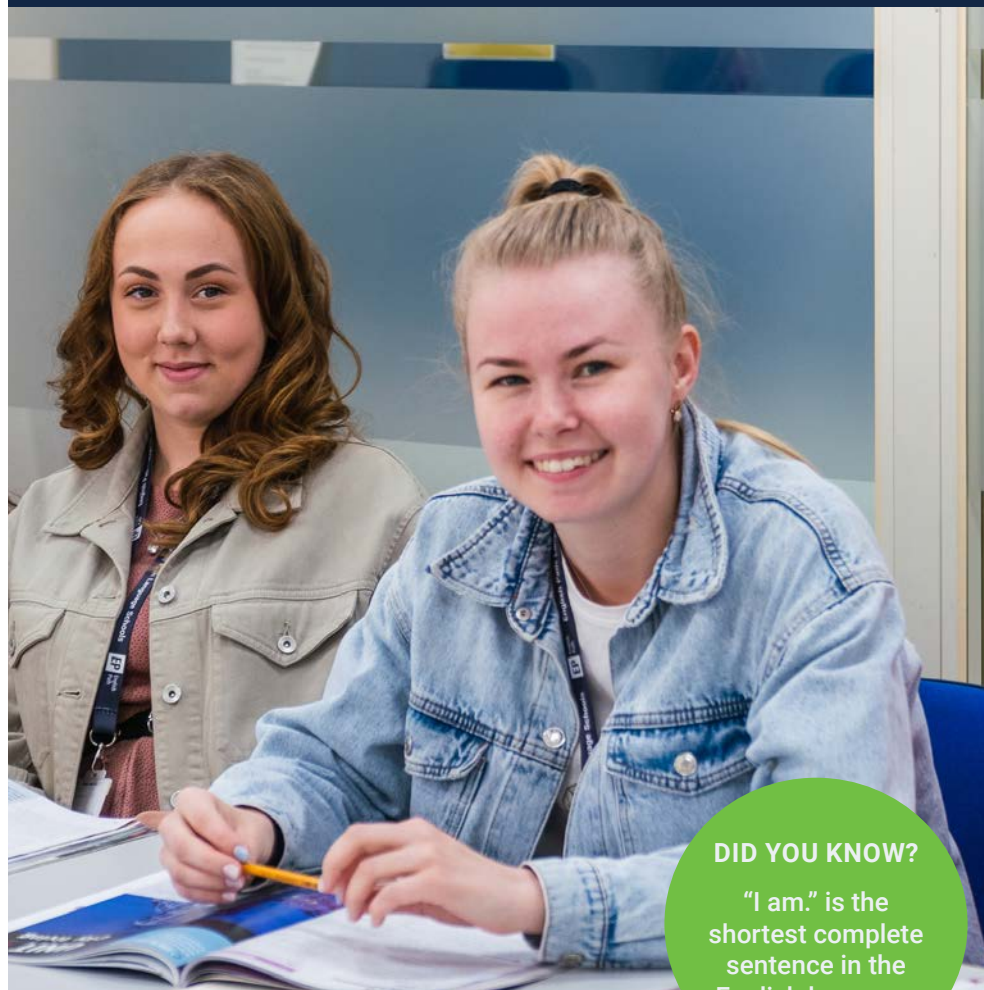

Dubai is the biggest and most populated city in the United Arab Emirates home to one of the fastest-developing economies anywhere in the world. Oil once accounted for 50% of GDP, but major investments in other sectors mean that figure has remarkably dropped to under 1% today. Travel and tourism are the biggest drivers of Dubai's current economy, as heavy investment continues across Dubai to maximise current successes in the sector.

The number of attractions in Dubai is nearly endless, with Burj Khalifa being the biggest on the list towering over the city skyline. The building stands at just over half a mile in height, with the world's highest restaurant and views that stretch as far as the Iranian shoreline.
