

Announcement from Princess Chulabhorn Science High School Pathum Thani Subject: Declaration of Intent and Policy on No Gift Policy in Relation to Duties

The Minister of Education has declared the intention to combat corruption and has issued a No Gift Policy for the Ministry of Education on International Anti-Corruption Day (Thailand), under the theme "The Ministry of Education: Transparent and Intolerant of Corruption" (MOE TRUST & Zero Corruption) for the fiscal year 2022 on December 15, 2021. This initiative aims to raise awareness, encourage a sense of integrity, and promote a stance against accepting and tolerating corruption among Ministry of Education personnel, as well as to enhance the Ministry's positive image.

In accordance with this intention, Princess Chulabhorn Science High School Pathum Thani, recognizes the importance of fostering an awareness of and intolerance toward corruption. We have established measures to prevent corruption and misconduct, and to strengthen the values, attitudes, integrity, and behavior of our personnel to avoid actions that could affect their discretion or decision-making in their duties, which might lead to favoritism or conflicts of interest. Therefore, Princess Chulabhorn Science High School Pathum Thani, announces the following:

- 1. Administrators, teachers, and educational staff are prohibited from accepting any gifts or tokens from external individuals or entities and from giving any gifts or tokens to external individuals or entities during all festive occasions and special events.
- 2. Administrators, teachers, and educational staff must not seek to obtain gifts, tokens, or benefits that are not legally permissible.
- 3. For conveying congratulations, best wishes, greetings, or condolences on various occasions according to traditional practices, it is recommended to use greeting cards, condolence books, or social media instead of giving physical gifts.

This announcement is made for general information and adherence to the guidelines is mandatory.
