COVERAGE

• 300 ml. cartridge/3 m. (1x1 cm. joint)

PACKAGING

- 300 ml. cartridge.
- 600 ml. tube.

STORAGE

• 1 year from date of manufacture if stored in unopened original packaging in dry condition.

- · High elasticity.
- Joint size: 5 to 50 mm.

CHARACTERISTICS

- Can be painted with emulsion paint.
- Grey, White.

DESCRIPTION

A single component polyurethane sealant.

USES

- Interior / Exterior.
- Movement joint, expansion joint.
- Substrates: concrete, stone, brick, tiles, metal, wood, glass, PVC.

WORK INSTRUCTIONS

Surface Preparation

- 1. Damage concrete must be repaired prior to application by using LANKO 731 REP STRUCTURE or a mortar mix with LANKO 751 LATEX.
- 2. Surface must be clean, dry, free of dust, oil grease and any contaminations that could harm bonding.
- 3. Use a metal brush to clean a concrete substrate.
- 4. Backing rod can be used to reduce joint depth.
- 5. Use an adhesive tape to maintain the alignment.

Primer Preparation

1. Use primer if the substrate is very porous.

Application

- 1. Use sealant gun and squeeze into the joint.
- 2. Compact the sealant into the joint by using putty knife. Smooth the joint with figure and soapy water.
- 3. Remove the adhesive tape before the sealant cures.









PRECAUTIONS

- Temperature range for use : 5°c to 35°c.
- Do not contact with black rubber, bitumen, asphalt and solvent paints.
- The substrate must be dried before application.
