1.2 Usage Guidelines

- DO NOT USE AN EXTENSION CORD TO CONNECT THE CHARGER TO ELECTRIC SUPPLY; PROVIDE A PROPERLY LOCATED GFCI OR RCD RECEPTACLE. THE CHARGER SHOULD BE PLUGGED INTO THE GFCI OR RCD RECEPTACLE BOX.
- The pool vacuum must be installed and operated as specified. See safety and warning manual for more information.
- Clean the filter canister after each use.
- Do not use the product in your pool if the water temperature is above 95°F (35°C) or below 55°F (13°C).
- Use ONLY the battery charger provided with the appliance. Improper use may cause electric shocks, overheating or leakage of corrosive liquids from the battery.

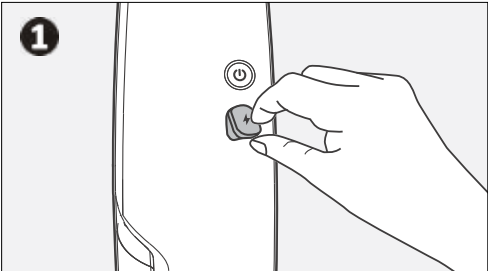
Section 2. Product Usage

2.1 Charging the Pool Vacuum

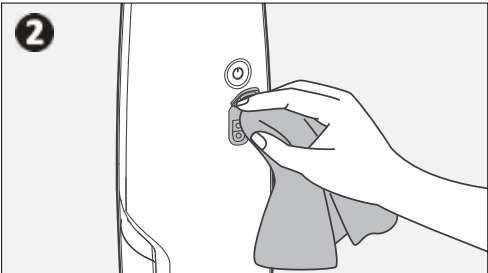

The pool vacuum takes up to 2.5 hours to fully charge (LED is solid blue). Always charge the pool vacuum indoors. Ensure that the pool vacuum and the water in the Filter Canister are completely drained before charging.

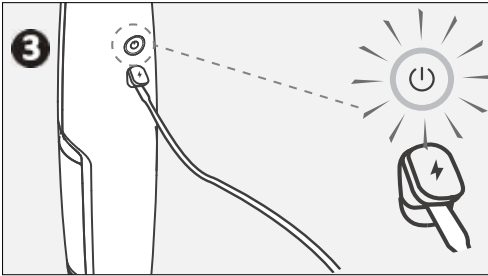
Charge the Pool Vacuum:



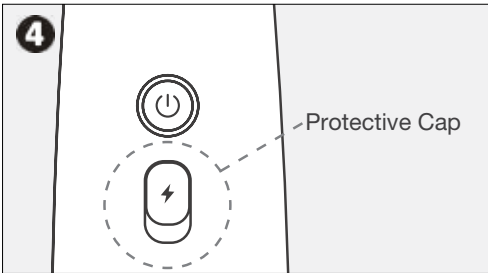
Open the charging port protective cap.



Dry the area in and around the charging port to ensure the charging port is dry.



Plug the charger into an indoor electrical outlet at least 3,5 m (11 ft) away from pool edge. Insert the charging plug into the charging port. LED will blink Blue while charging, and solid Blue when fully charged.



Press and tightly secure the plug before immersing the pool vacuum.

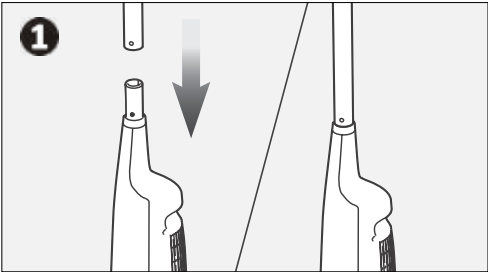

2.3 Using the Pool Vacuum

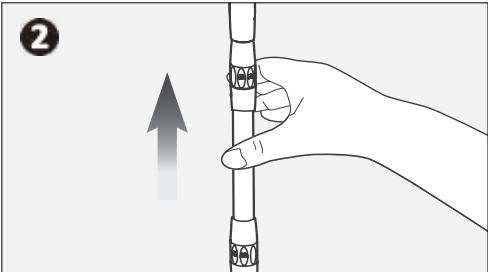
CAUTION

Charging port protective cap must be tightly sealed before immersing the pool vacuum in the water.

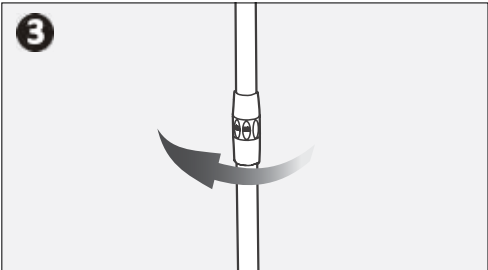
Attach the Extension Pole and Start Cleaning:



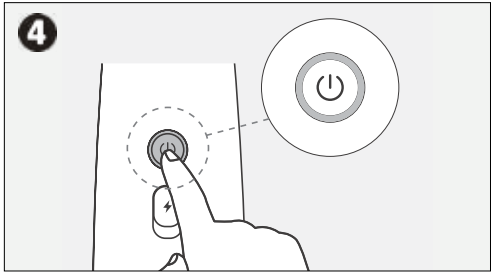
Insert and secure the extension pole into the socket on the top of the pool vacuum.



Loosen the handle of the extension pole to lengthen.



Tighten the handle to secure the extension pole at the desired length.



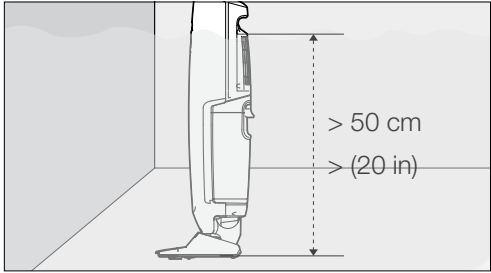
**Press and hold power button for 2 seconds to turn on. Immerse the pool vacuum in water within 30 seconds to initiate vacuum suction cleaning.**

**Press and hold power button for 2 seconds to turn off after cleaning.**

## 2.4 Cleaning Modes

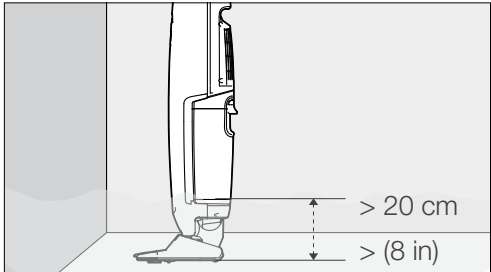
### Using in Deep Water Mode (default)

After turning on, the pool vacuum by default will be in Deep Water Mode (LED is solid blue) and is ready to start cleaning. Deep Water Mode is designed for areas with water depth above 50 cm (20 in).



### Switching to Shallow Water Mode

To switch to Shallow Water Mode, press power button once (LED flashing green for 20 seconds). The pool vacuum is ready to clean once LED is solid green. Shallow Water Mode is designed for pool areas with a water depth above 20 cm (8 in).

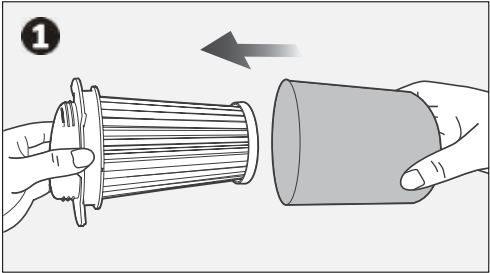


## 2.5 Using the Filter Sleeve

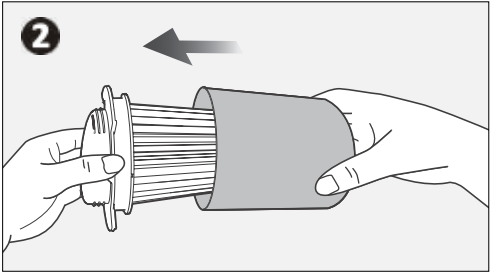
The filter screen can only filter large particles, such as coarse sand, leaves, stones, etc. The filter sleeve is designed to filter fine particles, such as fine sand, dust, etc. It is prone to clogging and may require frequent cleaning.

**NOTE:** The filter sleeve is a consumable material and should be replaced monthly for optimal performance.

### Install the Filter Sleeve:



**Insert the filter sleeve into the narrow end of the filter.**



**Push the filter sleeve until it fully covers the filter screen.**



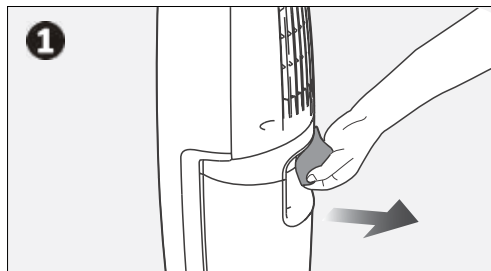
**Reassemble the filter.**

## Section 3. Maintenance

### 3.1 Cleaning the Filter Canister

**NOTE:** For optimal suction power, be sure to clean the filter thoroughly. The filter screen can only filter large particles, such as coarse sand, leaves, stones, etc. For fine particle filtration, use the included filter sleeve.

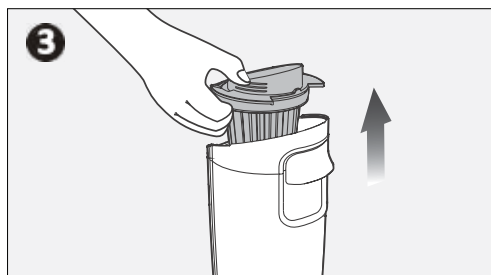
#### Remove and Clean the Filter Canister:



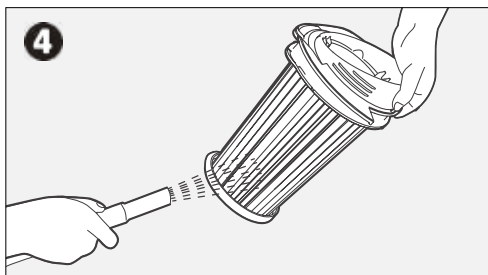
Pull the Filter Canister release handle, remove the Filter Canister from the side.



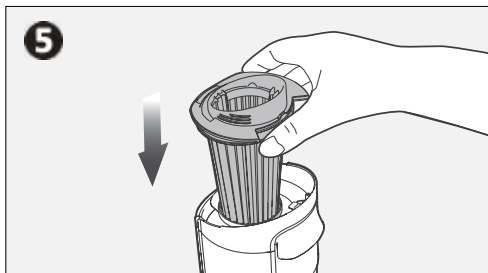
Immediately invert the Filter Canister to quickly drain any water.



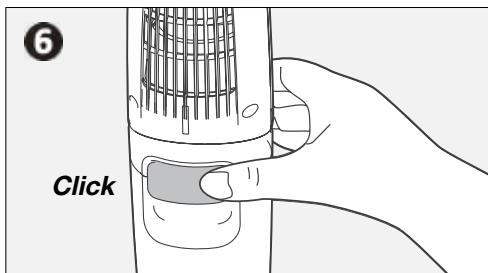
After draining, pull out the filter by lifting it upward.



Rinse the surface of filter with water and dry it.

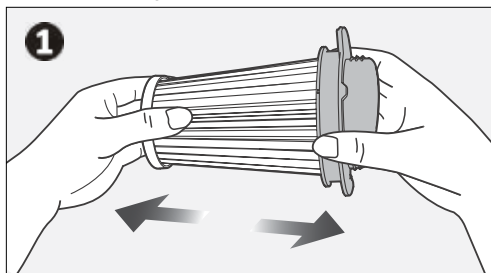


After installing the filter, put the Filter Canister back into the pool vacuum.

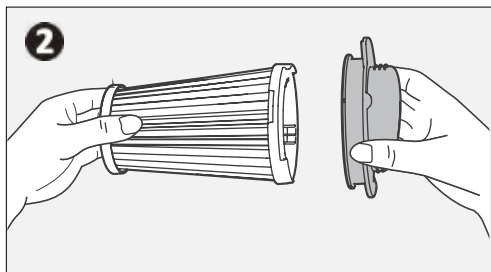


Push the Filter Canister until you hear a *Click*, indicating that the Filter Canister is properly secured in place.

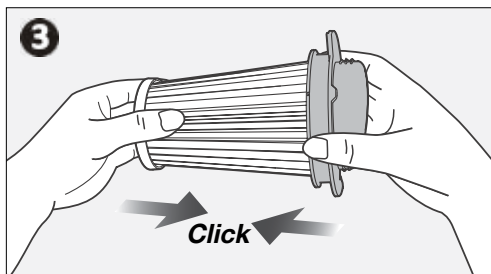
### 3.2 Replacing the Filter



**Firmly grip both ends of the filter and pull outward to remove the filter screen.**



**Insert the wide end of the new filter screen into the filter cover.**



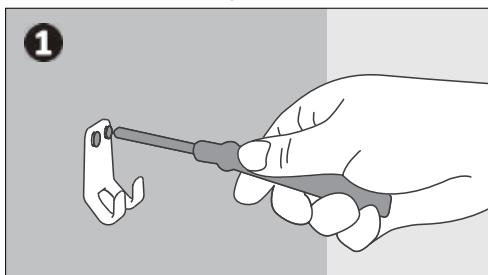
**Push until you hear a *Click*, indicating that the new filter screen is assembled.**

## Section 4. Storage Guidelines

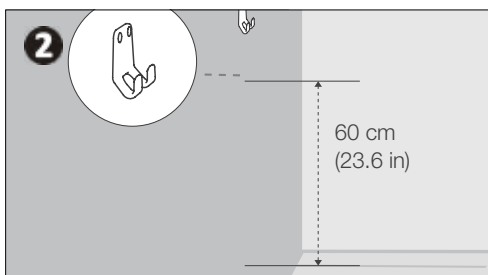
During off-seasons, such as winter or long vacations, when your pool vacuum isn't in use, follow the recommended storage procedure:

- Fully charge the pool vacuum before storing it. Ensure that the pool vacuum is turned off and disconnected from the charger before storing.
- Thoroughly clean the entire pool vacuum, to remove any dirt.
- Dry the pool vacuum with a soft cloth, and ensure the charging port cover is properly closed.
- Hang and store the pool vacuum in a cool, dry, and well-ventilated place.
- Recharge the battery every six months to maintain its health.

### 4.1 Mount the Storage Hook

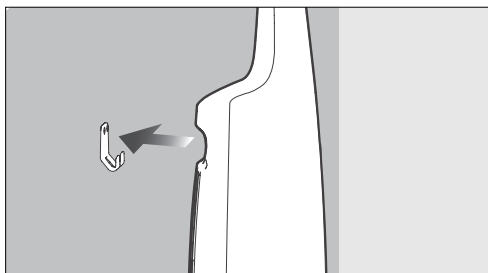


**Install the hook on the wall with 2 matching screws.**



**Position the hook 60 cm (23.6 in) above the ground. Ensure that the hook is securely mounted before storing the pool vacuum.**

### 4.2 Hang and Store the Pool Vacuum



**Hang the pool vacuum on the hook.**

## Section 5. Troubleshooting

### 5.2. General Troubleshooting

The following list provides some helpful hints for troubleshooting common challenges when using the cleaner.
