ITINERARY:

DAY 01: BKK-Bali (Denpasar) arrive by SL258 at 13.25-18.30 (local time) (-/-/D)

ARRIVE Bali, Dinner at Jimbaran Beach with Sea food menu and enjoy with sunset.

Check in at Hotel & Overnight stay.

DAY 02: Bali-Yogyakarta by domestic flight at QZ8440 at

07.20-07.50 (B/L/D)

Arrive and leads you to the 9th century Hindu temples at Prambanan. The UNESCO World Heritage Site contains shrines dedicated to the Hindu Trinity, known as Brahma, Vishnu, and Shiva. The temple compound is located less than 10 miles outside of Yogyakarta and was erected as Bandung Bondowoso's proof of love for Princess Loro Jonggrang. A mystical ambiance sweeps through the stone figures, emanating from the textured towers looming above the grounds.

The Borobudur Temple Compounds is one of the greatest Buddhist monuments in the world, and was built in the 8th and 9th centuries AD during the reign of the Syailendra Dynasty. The monument is located in the Kedu Valley, in the southern part of Central Java, at the centre of the island of

Java, Indonesia. And then next visit Candi Pawon ,Candi Mendut

DAY 03: Yogyakarta-Bali by domestic flight at 08.00-10.30

Arrive Bali ,visit PruaUlundanu Bratan and visit rice terrace.

Dinner at O/N stay

DAY 04: PurTertaEmpul-Shopping -Kintamanee tour-Pura Besakih (B/L/D)

Day 05: Bali-Swing - Pura Tanah Lot-Shopping at Krisna Shop.

Depart to BKK by SL259 at 19.40-23.05

A land that does not seem to belong anywhere, Bali is steeped in its unique culture of Animism, Hinduism, Buddhism and a reverence for nature. Balinese honor not just the legendary warlords and mythical *devas*(deities) but also the land, sea, food and arts.

Myths, legends, and folklore are still alive and evident. Relive the *Ramayana* (the Hindu epic of the eternal battle) through shadow plays and fire dances; hear the many folklore stories that Bali has to tell through its temples, sacred grounds, and monuments, each set within the scenic landscapes. Experience Taman Ayun, the beautiful temple on the lake, the sacred monkey forest, and the sunset at the mysterious Tanah Lot. Continue on to the temple on holy

springs in Gunung Kawi, the picture-perfect Uluwatu that is perched on the cliff, and ancient palaces that are surrounded by statues of warriors, guardian, and courtesans.

As you travel, many colorful ceremonial parades will cross your path. Be mesmerized by the *Barong* and *Kecak* dances, the intricate crafts, bamboo weaving, jewelry making and batik painting, an age-old art held dear to the heart of Bali. Have your fortune told by the medicine man, his knowledge of the divinity passed down through generations. Indulge in local cuisine with the layers of spices and long-held traditions; cook a Balinese feast in a Balinese home and foray into the countryside and its villages. Discover its arts, crafts, galleries between the nooks and crannies in Ubud's colorful streets. Pamper yourself with traditional spa treatments using age-old *jamu*, a natural concoction of herbs and fruits

Enjoy Bali's natural beauty as you coast along cliffs to find a secluded bay in Jimbaran. Dine by the sea, in the terraced rice fields as the sun sets. Walk along the rice fields in Ubud and its countryside to view the majestic Mount Batur volcano, said to be built by a giant and gorgeous with its glistening crater lake. Find flocks of elegant birds return en masse and the sacred grounds where monkeys play and laze. Swim with sharks, lay with turtles, and cross the sea with dolphins in serene Sanur. Enjoy thrilling moments in the sea as you parasail and fly fish, and enjoy immense family fun on banana boats and donut boats before you relax by the beach as the sun sets in Jimbaran. It won't take long for you to believe that Bali is indeed the Land of Gods.
