

Pearl Lanka Tour,Sri Lanka

Kandy ,Colombo,Sigiriya,Dambulla and Anuradhpura

ITINERARY:

DAY 01: BKK-Colombo arrive by SL230 at 07.30-09.30 (local time)
- Kandy (-/L/D)

ARRIVE Colombo,Proceed to Kandy (3.30 hours drive)

Arrive Kandy, Our first stop will be the Temple of the Tooth Relic. Legend has it that one of Buddha's teeth was taken from him as he lay on his funeral pyre. It was then smuggled into Sri Lanka in 313AD. It now attracts daily pilgrims who come bearing lotus flowers and frangipani.

And visit Gem Museum

Dinner and O/N stay

Day 02 : Kandy- Spice Garden-Dambulla Cave-Sigiriya-Anuradhpura
(B/L/D)

Breakfast at hotel and check out to Colombo

Visit spice garden in Matale, to see the different herbs and spices, which Sri Lanka is famous for. You will be introduced to different spices and shown how some of these spices are grown and processed.

And visit Dambulla Cave Temple. Dambulla is thought to have been a place of worship since the 1st century BC, when King Valagamba (also known as Vattagamani Abhaya), driven out of Anuradhapura, took refuge here. When he regained his throne, he had the interior of the caves carved into magnificent rock temples. Further paintings were made by later kings, including King Nissanka Malla, who had the caves' interiors gilded, earning the place the name Ran Giri (Golden Rock).

This process of retouching original and creating new artwork continued into the 20th century. Remarkably, the overall impact is breathtakingly coherent.

After lunch visit Sigiriya. **Sigiriya**, also called **Lion Rock** or **Lion Mountain**, site in central Sri Lanka consisting of the ruins of an ancient stronghold that was built in the late 5th century CE on a remarkable monolithic rock pillar. The rock, which is so steep that its top overhangs the sides, rises to an elevation of 1,144 feet (349 metres) above sea level and is some 600 feet (180 metres) above the surrounding plain.

Proceed to Anuradhpura (2 hours drive)

Arrive and O/N stay

Day 03:

Anuradhpura - Colombo

After breakfast city tour Anuradhpura. Tread on sacred ground. Come to the place where one of the greatest civilizations of the ancient world flourished. Anuradhapura was the first capital of Sri Lanka founded in the 4th Century AD and it is one of the oldest continuously inhabited cities in the world.

This UNESCO World Heritage site is a historical marvel with its well preserved ruins of this ancient civilization. Amongst the masterpieces of this golden era are the many towering stupas (Dagabos), wonderful rock carvings, huge stone pillars, and ruins of royal palaces, monasteries and bathing tanks along with some of the most complex irrigation systems in the world, all of which demonstrates the architectural, engineering, hydrological and irrigational skills of this golden era.

Let the shade of the 'Sri Maha Bodhi', (a sapling of the sacred Bo tree in Bodh Gaya in India) give you peace and solace. The 'Sri Maha Bodhi' is believed to be the oldest human planted tree in the world.

After lunch check out to Colombo

visiting the local bazaar and a gem museum we take a Tuk Tuk ride up into the surrounding city.
and visit Gangaram Temple.

Dinner and Overnight stay.
