

## Highlights of Myanmar Tour (BKK-Yangon//Mandalay-BKK)

### By Bangkok Airways (4 NIGHTS / 5 DAYS)

#### ITINERARY:

- DAY 01:** **BKK-Yangon-BAGO-Kyaikhtiyo by PG at 08.50-09.40** **(-/L/D)**  
DEPARTURE TO Yangon BY Bangkok Airways (PG) ,ARRIVE Yangon ,  
Proceed to an ancient capital Bago  
ShweThaLyaung Reclining Buddha (55 meters long),Shwe Maw Daw Pagoda,  
KalyaniSima (Ordination Hall), 28 Meter high huge image of Kyaikpun Pagoda and  
the place of King Bayinnaung are some of the places of interest.  
Start the trip to Kyaikhtiyo Pagoda known as “Golden  
Rock” about 04 hours driving from Yangon. Regular car or coaches can  
reach only Kingpun Base Camp at the foot of the hills, from there takes  
an open truck up to the top of the mountain. When you reach the main  
pilgrimage site, you will see the sacred boulder covered by gold leaf is  
balance precariously on the very edge of cliff and enjoy sunset from this  
unforgettable site. The 9000 candle lighting festival is also a popular  
among the events in Myanmar.  
Dinner and overnight at hotel in Kyaikhtiyo
- DAY 02:** **Kyaikhtiyo (Golden Rock) - YANGON** **(B/L/D)**  
After breakfast drive back to Yangon **Kyauk Htatgyi Buddha.**  
Visit Botahtaung Pagoda and pay homage to AhmatawMya Nan New or whisper  
angle, a devotee to the Pagoda. She was known to be a Dragon guarding the  
Pagoda.  
Visit the world famous Shwedagon Pagoda. Witness the golden dome light up  
sunshine at the sunset. Overnight at Yangon.
- DAY 03:** **Yangon-BAGAN (BY DOMESTIC FLIGHT)** **(B/L/D)**  
We will transfer you to the airport to take flight to Bagan in early morning  
Upon arrival, you will be transferred to the hotel and check in hotel. We will start to  
to discover Bagan - the home to the largest and densest concentration of Buddhist  
temples, pagodas, stupas and ruins in the world with many dating from the 11th and

12th centuries. The sightseeing starts with most distinctive pagodas such as Shwezigon Pagoda - a massive reliquary to enshrine a collection of relics, including the Buddha's frontal and collar bones, Gubyaukgyi Temple - it is opined that the monument belongs to the early 13th century depending on judging by its architectural style and fine frescoes; Ananda Temple - one of the masterpieces surviving and remaining in Bagan and considered to be in the Mon architecture style; Thatbyinnyu Temple - the tallest temple in Bagan with two storey. Emerging yourself in romantic scenery when the sunset over the Ayeyarwaddy River from Shwesandaw Pagoda (or Bupaya).

Dinner at local restaurant and back to hotel.

**DAY 04: BAGAN-MINGMANDALAY (BY DOMESTIC FLIGHT) (B/L/D)**

In early morning, you will be transferred to Bagan airport to take a domestic flight to Mandalay - the old capital of Burma. Arrival, visit some famous monastery such as Atumashi - "Incomparable Monastery", Shwenandaw Monastery is well known for its teak carvings of Buddhist myths, which adorn its walls and roofs. In late afternoon, we will visit Kuthodaw Pagoda - known as the world's biggest book for its stone slabs of Buddhist scriptures and visit Mandalay Palace.

After lunch explore Mingun Pahtodawgyi Pagoda, a massive unfinished pagoda along the Irrawaddy river

Marvel at the Mingun Bell, the largest ringing bell in the world

See the all-white Hsinbyume Pagoda, dedicated to Princess Hsinbyume, the White Elephant Princess

Dinner at restaurant and back to hotel.

**DAY 05: MANDALAY - BKK (B/-/-)**

After breakfast check out and drive to Amarapura, the name means "City of Immortality" although its life as Myanmar's capital was all too brief.

Then you will visit Mahagandayon Monastery - the magnificent monastery with more than 3000 monks living and studying here, where you can see hundreds of monks wait in long queues for their Swan in every morning. Continue to visit the oldest Teak Bridge built in 1782 - U Bein Bridge.

Transfer to the airport for departure flight.
